Sunday, October 17, 2021 — Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

We hear in the readings today differing perspectives on what God's mercy may entail. But what I also want to speak about is the concept of how it is that we see ourselves. In the Gospel, two brothers, James and John, see themselves in a rather opportunistic way, asking our Lord to grant them whatever they ask. But there is still a lesson for these two disciples to learn. Granted, the others see them as rather omnipotent in how it is that they ask our Lord for positions, one at the right and the other at the left of our Lord. Maybe the question could be, why would they ask such a thing?

In how it is that we see ourselves, would we ask in like manner? I think that what Jesus sees here is another opportunity to teach what our faith entails as a process, servitude. Last week we heard Jesus tell the young man to sell everything and give to the poor. This is an act of servitude, but it is also a lesson that certain things could impede our relationship with our Lord. Some of those impediments can be our unwillingness to learn because we think we deserve something. Let me follow you or let us sit here and there. The actions of faith involve good works! Hence what we hear today is about servitude, helping others who are less fortunate. We are not called to be proud or haughty, but we are called to greatness by how we serve others.

I want to take a moment to thank everyone here who volunteers or helps out with their time and talents in anyway. From what I have experienced in the short time I have been here is quite remarkable. I've seen various groups put together programs where we as church can be involved in being good servants. I am so grateful as I know many others are as well.

I'd like to see our parish council get together and take a look at the needs and various projects that will help make our wonderful parish the faith-filled community we all need it to be. I'd like to see programs to help educate parents in the faith so that they can be the very best of faith teachers to their children. They are the first educators of the children. As families become more involved with their faith, it helps our parish grow.

The process of stewardship is very, very important. It is very much like what Jesus asks of us, to be the good servants, the good stewards of our church and our spiritual environment. One of the things we pray in the Our Father is: "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven..."

Let's get together and explore how we can continue this request of our Lord.

Por supuesto, los demás los ven como bastante omnipotentes en cómo le piden a nuestro Señor posiciones, una a la derecha y otra a la izquierda de nuestro Señor. Quizás la pregunta podría ser, ¿por qué preguntarían algo así?

En cómo es que nos vemos a nosotros mismos, ¿preguntaríamos de igual manera? Creo que lo que Jesús ve aquí es otra oportunidad para enseñar lo que implica nuestra fe como proceso, la servidumbre. La semana pasada escuchamos a Jesús decirle al joven que venda todo y se lo dé a los pobres. Este es un acto de servidumbre, pero también es una lección de que ciertas cosas pueden impedir nuestra relación con nuestro Señor. Algunos de esos impedimentos pueden ser nuestra falta de voluntad para aprender porque creemos que merecemos algo. Déjame seguirte o déjanos sentarnos aquí y allá. ¡Las acciones de fe involucran buenas obras! Por lo tanto, lo que escuchamos hoy es sobre la servidumbre, ayudando a los menos afortunados. No estamos llamados a ser orgullosos o altivos, pero estamos llamados a la grandeza por la forma en que servimos a los demás.

Sentido de la Humildad Cristiana

Digamos de entrada, hermanos, que Cristo no condena el deseo de ser importante ni habla mal de quien quiere tener el primer puesto. Por lo menos en el evangelio de hoy no es ese su propósito.

Más bien se trata de mostrar en dónde radica la verdadera "importancia" y cuál es el "primer puesto" al que hay que aspirar. Esto es muy importante para poder entender en qué consiste la humildad cristiana: no es tanto "hacer de cuenta" que no me interesa lo que en realidad sí me interesa, sino encauzar ese interés según la mente de quien mejor me conoce y ama, que es Dios.

La Grandeza del Servicio

Por otro lado, ya en la primera lectura Dios nos empuja a cambiar nuestros parámetros. Grande es el que hace algo grande. La grandeza no está en lo que cada uno dice de sí mismo, ni en lo que obliga a otros a decir, sino en las obras, en la realidad, en los hechos.

2.2 Por eso el Siervo de Yahvé, en la primera lectura, es presentado como un modelo de dolor, pero sobre todo como un modelo de fecundidad, y es esto lo que se enfatiza: "verá su descendencia", "prolongará sus años", "por medio de él prosperarán los designios del Señor". En ningún caso es una actitud de "el dolor por el dolor". No hay aquí una actitud de complejo ni de cobardía, como calumnió Nietzsche, sino más bien una conciencia del precio que tiene el bien futuro, y de la inmenso fruto que brota del amor cuando es consecuente.
