THE WEDDINGS OF CANA

We recently ended the Christmas season, and now we are within a short time of transition, because in just eight weeks we will begin Lent with Ash Wednesday.

Today's Gospel, Sunday, is a beautiful story that shows us Jesus doing his first miracle. With this miracle, it is possible for his disciples to believe in him. What makes this first miracle of Jesus special is not that it was His first, but that other details also occur:

- 1- This miracle happens at a wedding party. A wedding is a happy occasion where the newlyweds share their happiness with the guests. Where everyone celebrates for the love of the spouses.
- 2- It seems that a happy occasion can be a shameful occasion for newly married spouses. The wine has run out. There is no longer to continue toasting.
- 3- The one who notices that the wine has run out is Mary, the mother of Jesus. And it is her who asks her Son for his help, even though Jesus seems to be resisting, because it was not yet his hour.
- 4- Jesus honors his mother by granting to the couple the wine that is lacking, offering the best possible wine.
- 5- The secret of this miracle is in the words that Mary says to those who serve: "do what He tells you."

Maria knows well that the secret of our happiness is that we never run out of love. The love that is shared with everyone. The best love possible. Obtaining this love and making it strong resides in doing in our lives what Jesus asks of us, living the Gospel. The Gospel of Jesus shows us that the love to God and the neighbor is translated into actions that manifest service to others in their needs.

El evangelio de hoy domingo es un hermoso relato que nos muestra a Jesús haciendo su primer milagro. Con este milagro se hace posible que sus discípulos creyeran en Él. Lo que hace especial a este primer milagro de Jesús no es que fuese el primero, sino que otros detalles también ocurren:

1. Este milagro sucede en una fiesta de boda. Una boda es una ocasión feliz donde los recién casados comparten su felicidad con los invitados. Donde todos celebran por el amor de los esposos.
2. Parece que una ocasión feliz puede ser una ocasión vergonzosa para los esposos recién casados. El vino se ha agotado. Ya no hay con que seguir brindando.
3. Quien se percata de que el vino se ha agotado es María, la madre de Jesús. Y es ella la que solicita a su Hijo su ayuda, a pesar que Jesús parece resistirse, pues aún no era su hora.
4. Jesús honra a su madre concediendo a los esposos el vino que falta, y ofrece el mejor vino posible.
5. El secreto de este milagro está en las palabras que María dice a los que sirven: "hagan lo que Él les diga".

María sabe bien que el secreto de nuestra felicidad, está en que nunca se nos acabe el amor. El amor que se comparte con todos. El mejor amor posible. Obtener este amor y hacerlo fuerte reside en hacer en nuestras vidas aquello que Jesús nos pide, vivir el Evangelio. El Evangelio de Jesús nos muestra que el amor a Dios y al prójimo se traduce en acciones que manifiestan el servicio a los demás en sus necesidades.

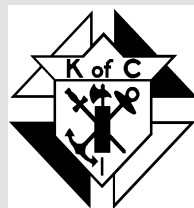
Ayudo a que sea lo que es.

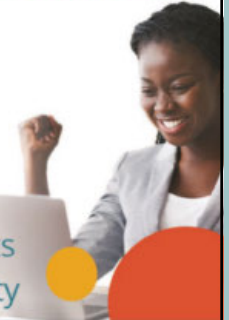

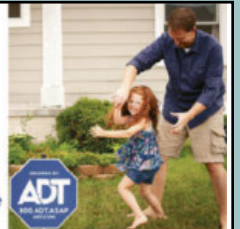
