ABOUT TODAY'S SUNDAY GOSPEL

Lk 1, 1-4; 4, 14-21

Today's Sunday Gospel goes so far as to say that when Jesus was in the synagogue: "the eyes of all in the synagogue looked intently at him."

To whom are our eyes directed today? Who are the objects of our hopes? Who appears in the center of our lives?

Jesus has captivated, generation after generation, the attention of many men and women. Men and women who searched for a place to place their hopes and find relief and consolation. Many placed their eyes where there were no answers to their deepest questions and anxieties, but for those who saw Jesus and listened carefully, they found in Him the answers they so desired in their lives.

Jesus appears in the synagogue reading the passage from the prophet Isaiah that mentions that the Spirit of God is upon Him. He is the anointed one. He is the chosen one. He has been sent by God the Father to relieve, comfort, liberate, heal, announce the Good News, and proclaim the Lord's year of grace. Jesus is clear with those who hear him: He is the One of whom the scriptures speak. He is the one expected by all.

Let us listen attentively to what Jesus tells us on behalf of the Father. Let's see how Jesus approaches our lives. Let his words enter our hearts. And together with Him let us write our stories full of God's love, where compassion and charity are paths to follow for every Christian.

Lc 1, 1-4; 4, 14-21

Escuchemos atentamente lo que Jesús nos dice de parte del Padre. Miremos cómo Jesús se acerca a nuestras vidas. Dejemos que sus palabras entren en nuestro corazones. 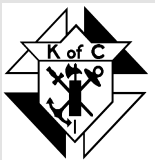

St. Patrick's Involvement in the World Synod 2023

Last October, Pope Francis convened a World Synod for 2023 on the topic of consultation and synodality within the Church.

The consultation process that we will use in our Diocese is designed to promote pastoral listening and discernment; while helping to shape a quantitative survey instrument that will inform the work of the Synod.

The methodology we will work with invites parishioners regardless of language and culture, and others to participate in small group discussions. These conversations will focus on three basic questions, from which notes will be taken. These questions will reflect on the individual's experiences of pain, joy, and hope within the Church. We need your stories and input on these important questions.

We here at St. Patrick's are inviting all those who are interested in participating in this important synodal process to be aware of the dates of the meetings that will be scheduled for listening and discernment in our Parish community.

For this synodal process and purpose, it is necessary to registrar in advance. We are in the process of choosing a bilingual coordinator. This person will be our contact person who will act within our parish facilitating our synodal processes. The person and important dates will be announced soon, as we need to begin our meetings beginning February.

We ask that you pray to the Holy Spirit that you be involved in our Parish's efforts in the World Synod 2023.

Let us be guided by the Holy Spirit as we continue this important journey together as Church. Amen!

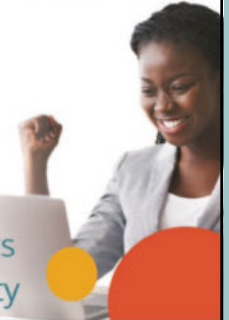

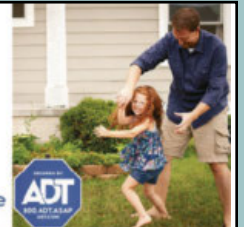
