LET US CLOSE TO JESUS

Today's Sunday Gospel continues to develop the scene in which Jesus is in the synagogue on Saturday, as was His custom, to listen to and comment on the word of God. On this occasion, the lecture is from the prophet Isaiah, a lecture that Jesus has attributed to himself. He is the one sent by the Father to heal, reconcile, liberate and offer the grace of God to those who need it.

Let's get close to Jesus, and let Him touch our lives.

Let's draw close to Jesus, and let Him heal our wounds.

Let us draw close to Jesus, and discover the merciful face of God.

Come closer to Jesus, and let us love Him.

CENTENNIAL CORNER: # 14

Dear fellow parishioners. Two facts concerning our parish's sponsorship of scouting.

FACT #23: On April 4, 1938, St. Patrick chartered a Boy Scout Troop, #17, with the Assistant Pastor, Fr. Cunningham, as its first chaplain. There were 23 scouts and 6 adult leaders, including the first Scoutmaster, J.H. Butcher (1938-1941). The Troop number changed in 1956 to #917, and our parish's sponsorship ended in 1985.

FACT #24: St. Patrick also chartered a Cub Scout Pack, #17, on May 31, 1944. The Assistant Pastor, Fr. John J. Sullivan, was its chaplain. There were 13 scouts and 3 adult leaders. The first Cub Master was Glen B. Teagarden.

St. Patrick's Involvement in the World Synod 2023

Last October, Pope Francis convened a World Synod for 2023 on the topic of consultation and synodality within the Church.

The consultation process that we will use in our Diocese is designed to promote pastoral listening and discernment; while helping to shape a quantitative survey instrument that will inform the work of the Synod.

The methodology we will work with invites parishioners regardless of language and culture, and others to participate in small group discussions. These conversations will focus on three basic questions, from which notes will be taken. These questions will reflect on the individual's experiences of pain, joy, and hope within the Church. We need your stories and input on these important questions.

We here at St. Patrick's are inviting all those who are interested in participating in this important synodal process to be aware of the dates of the meetings that will be scheduled for listening and discernment in our Parish community.

For this synodal process and purpose, it is necessary to registrar in advance. We are in the process of choosing a bilingual coordinator. This person will be our contact person who will act within our parish facilitating our synodal processes. The person and important dates will be announced soon, as we need to begin our meetings beginning February.

We ask that you pray to the Holy Spirit that you be involved in our Parish's efforts in the World Synod 2023.

Let us be guided by the Holy Spirit as we continue this important journey together as Church. Amen!

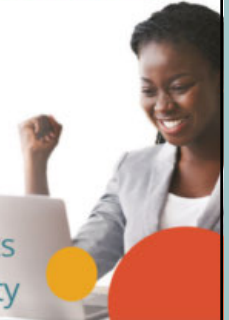
