### **PRAYER AND ACTION.**

Today's gospel (**Mc 1, 29-39**) is rich in details and events in which Jesus is the protagonist. I have the impression that today we can talk about at least four specific moments in which we discover Jesus acting in a very clear way.

The first thing we notice is that Jesus has been in prayer and has heard the Word of God with the community, that is why he went to the synagogue that day. This gives way to a second moment, Jesus acts with mercy towards the sick, Jesus heals them of their illnesses. The healing he does of Peter's mother-in-law stands out; who once healthy, understood that it was time to serve those who need her.

After having cared for so many, Jesus once again seeks solitude to pray, this time Jesus returns to personal prayer, so frequently done. Finally, Jesus decides to continue with the missionary action and announce the Kingdom of God, for which it is necessary to leave where he is and be able to go in search of those who are waiting to hear the Good News.

Jesus appears doing so many things, almost without pause, one after another. It is urgent to do all the good possible for each human being. But it stands out admirably that of all the actions described today, prayer is the one that appears as the center of everything else. With prayer you can hear God's will and have the courage to enliven that will.

Let us make prayer to occupy a primary place in our Christian life, because it is in prayer where we dialogue with God, it is in prayer where we can understand the events of our lives and act in accordance with what God expects of each one.

El evangelio de hoy (**Mc 1, 29-39**) es rico en detalles y en acontecimientos en los que Jesús es protagonista. Tengo la impresión que hoy podemos hablar de al menos cuatro momentos concretos en los que descubrimos a Jesús actuando de forma muy clara.

Lo primero que notamos es que Jesús ha estado en oración y ha escuchado de la Palabra de Dios junto a la comunidad, por eso fue a la sinagoga aquel día. Esto da paso a un segundo momento, Jesús actúa con misericordia con los enfermos, Jesús los sana de sus males. Destaca la curación que hace de la suegra de Pedro; quien una vez sana comprendió que era el momento de servir a quienes la necesitan.

Después de haber atendido a tantos Jesús busca una vez más la soledad para volver a la oración, esta vez Jesús vuelve a la oración personal, tan frecuente hecha. Finalmente, Jesús decide continuar con la acción misionera y anunciar del Reino de Dios, para lo que es necesario salir de dónde se encuentra y poder ir en búsqueda de quienes están a la espera de escuchar la Buena Nueva.

Jesús aparece haciendo tantas cosas, casi sin pausa, una tras otra. Es urgente hacer todo el bien posible por cada ser humano. Pero resalta de forma admirable que de todas las acciones descritas hoy la oración es la que aparece como centro de todo lo demás. Con la oración se puede escuchar la voluntad de Dios y tener la valentía de hacer cumplir esa voluntad.

Hagamos que la oración ocupe un lugar primordial en nuestra vida cristiana, pues es en la oración en donde dialogamos con Dios, es en la oración donde podemos comprender los acontecimientos de nuestras vidas y actuar conforme a lo que Dios espera de cada uno.

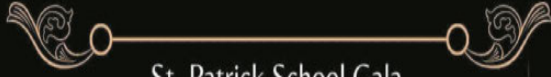

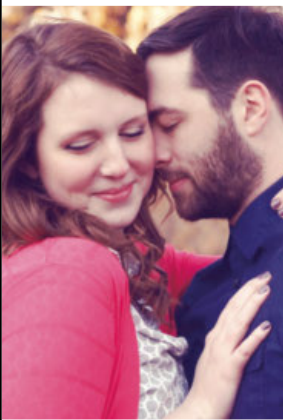
