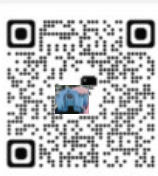

"WHOEVER WISHES TO COME AFTER ME ..., TAKE UP HIS CROSS, AND FOLLOW ME."

Every time I have the opportunity to meditate on the story today's Gospel it describes to me (**Mc 8, 27-35**), by how in one moment Jesus goes from praising Peter for being able to recognize in Him the mystery of being the expected Messiah. In response to Jesus' explanation of his passion and sacrifice, Peter tries to change Jesus' mind, which is why Jesus pushes him away, even calling him Satan. What has happened to Peter to go from being praised by Jesus to being corrected by him?

Peter was able to know the mystery of Jesus and confess it openly, since the Spirit of God acted in him. For this Peter must be open to the experience of God. However, when Peter hears what Jesus says about himself, it does not please Peter, since what Jesus says contradicts what Peter has in mind regarding the Messiah. Peter has been educated with a vision and expectation of a warrior-political Messiah who comes to change the political-social reality of Israel with respect to the other kingdoms of this world, where Israel would prevail. This is why Peter tries to dissuade Jesus. In Peter, his humanity acted, a selfish humanity in which he himself hopes much like Judas, to achieve some kind of human greatness (riches, fame, power). It is for all this that Jesus will say to Peter: **"You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."**

Jesus invites us all to take part in the construction of his Kingdom, but it is not a kingdom like those of this world (**Jn 18, 36**). The kingdom of Jesus is built on love, service, humility, solidarity, justice, truth, peace. It is a kingdom that must be built with the efforts of everyone, with sacrifices, with decisions. It is a kingdom that requires disciples of Christ willing to carry their own cross, because only by losing one's life for Christ and his gospel can one earn one's life, and be able to help build the Kingdom of God.

"EL QUE QUIERA VENIR CONMIGO ..., QUE CARGUE CON SU CRUZ Y QUE ME SIGA."

Cada vez que tengo la oportunidad de meditar en el relato que el evangelio que hoy domingo nos describe (**Mc 8, 27-35**) me impresiona mucho cómo en un momento Jesús pasa de alabar a Pedro por poder reconocer en Él el misterio de ser el Mesías esperado, pero ante la explicación que Jesús hace de su pasión y sacrificio Pedro intenta hacer cambiar de opinión a Jesús por lo cual Jesús lo aparta llamándolo incluso Satanás. ¿Qué es lo que en Pedro ha ocurrido como para pasar de ser alabado por Jesús a ser corregido por Jesús?

Pedro fue capaz de conocer el misterio de Jesús y de confesarlo abiertamente puesto que en él actuó el Espíritu de Dios, para esto Pedro debe estar abierto a la experiencia de Dios. Sin embargo, cuando Pedro escucha lo que Jesús dice de sí mismo no le es del agrado a Pedro, puesto que lo que Jesús dice contradice lo que Pedro tiene en mente respecto al Mesías. Pedro ha sido educado una visión y expectativa de un Mesías guerrero-político que viene a cambiar la realidad política-social de Israel respecto a los demás reinos de este mundo, donde Israel se impondría. Por esto Pedro intenta disuadir a Jesús. En Pedro actuó su humanidad, una humanidad egoísta en la que él mismo espera lograr algún tipo de grandeza humana (riquezas, fama, poder). Es por todo esto que Jesús le dirá a Pedro: **"Porque tú no juzgas según Dios, sino según los hombres."** Jesús nos invita a todos a tomar parte en la construcción de su Reino, pero no es un reino como los de este mundo (**Jn 18, 36**). El reino de Jesús se construye sobre el amor, el servicio, la humildad, la solidaridad, la justicia, la verdad, la paz. Es un reino que se debe construir con el esfuerzo de todos, con sacrificios, con decisiones. Es un reino que requiere de discípulos de Cristo dispuestos a cargar con su propia cruz, pues sólo perdiendo la vida por Cristo y su evangelio se gana la vida, y se puede construir el Reino de Dios.

MY GRATITUDE TO ALL

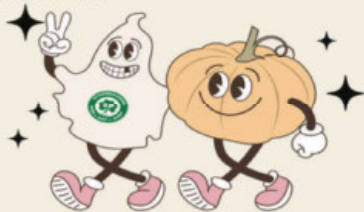

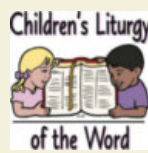
