1st Sunday of Advent...

It's time! I'd like to share a post from a wonderful scriptural professor who passed away some years ago. His name is Fr. Donald Senior, and I find it very inspiring.

"This Sunday we begin the season of Advent, one of the most beautiful periods of the Church's liturgical year. With the sounds of Christmas carols surrounding us in malls and on the radio, we can easily assume that Advent is meant solely to prepare us for the great feast of Christmas (so get shopping!). While that is true, it is not the complete story. Advent, in fact, is meant to remind us of three great **"arrivals"** (the literal meaning of the Latin word **"adventus"**): 1. The coming of Christ, two thousand years ago in Bethlehem; 2. The coming of Christ at the end of time; and 3. The coming of Christ into our everyday lives of faith.

If that act of creative love is our ultimate origin, a return to that vortex of love that is God is our true destiny. Although it uses many different metaphors to express it, the Scriptures see the final destiny of the human family as communion with the God of love who first created it. This is the central message of Jesus himself, the Word made flesh, who in the beautiful prologue of John's Gospel is presented as coming from the heart of God, becoming flesh and dwelling among us, and then himself returning to loving communion with the Father who sent him. Thus Jesus Christ reveals that, at their deepest level, our lives have purpose and meaning. The canon of the Scriptures reflects this: the story begins with the account of creation in Genesis and ends with the Book of Revelation and its vision of a new and astoundingly beautiful Jerusalem, the dwelling place of God with humanity where there will be no more tears and no more death.

All three of our readings this Sunday long for that final day where love rules and death is defeated. And all three remind us what we must do in the meantime: being awake and alert to the presence of God's grace all around us; living lives of integrity and justice; conducting ourselves in a way that pleases God. Advent reminds us that we are not to live our lives in fear nor indulge in idle speculation about the timing of the end of the world. We should not waste our time with anxious doomsday predictions but, rather, have a sense of hope and purpose and be committed to living lives worthy of God's intense love for us. The true Advent - and Christian - stance is found in Jesus' words: ***"Stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand."***

1er Domingo de Adviento...

¡Ya es hora! Me gustaría compartir una publicación de un maravilloso profesor de Sagrada Escritura que falleció hace algunos años. Su nombre es el padre Donald Senior, y me parece muy inspirador.

"Este domingo comenzamos la temporada de Adviento, uno de los períodos más hermosos del año litúrgico de la Iglesia. Con los sonidos de los villancicos que nos rodean en los centros comerciales y en la radio, podemos suponer fácilmente que el Adviento tiene como único fin prepararnos para la gran fiesta de Navidad (¡así que a comprar!). Si bien eso es cierto, no es la historia completa. El Adviento, de hecho, tiene como fin recordarnos tres grandes **"llegadas"** (el significado literal de la palabra latina **"adventus"**): 1. La venida de Cristo, hace dos mil años en Belén; 2. La venida de Cristo al final de los tiempos; y 3. La venida de Cristo a nuestra vida cotidiana de fe. Si ese acto de amor creador es nuestro origen último, el retorno a ese vórtice de amor que es Dios es nuestro verdadero destino. Aunque utiliza muchas metáforas diferentes para expresarlo, las Escrituras ven el destino final de la familia humana como la comunión con el Dios de amor que la creó primero. Este es el mensaje central de Jesús mismo, el Verbo hecho carne, que en el hermoso prólogo del Evangelio de Juan se presenta como saliendo del corazón de Dios, haciéndose carne y habitando entre nosotros, y luego regresando él mismo a la comunión amorosa con el Padre que lo envió. Así, Jesucristo revela que, en su nivel más profundo, nuestras vidas tienen un propósito y un significado. El canon de las Escrituras lo refleja: la historia comienza con el relato de la creación en el Génesis y termina con el Libro del Apocalipsis y su visión de una Jerusalén nueva y asombrosamente hermosa, la morada de Dios con la humanidad donde no habrá más lágrimas ni más muerte.

Las tres lecturas de este domingo anhelan ese día final en el que el amor gobierne y la muerte sea derrotada. Y los tres nos recuerdan lo que debemos hacer mientras tanto: estar despiertos y alertas a la presencia de la gracia de Dios a nuestro alrededor; vivir vidas de integridad y justicia; comportarnos de una manera que agrade a Dios. El Adviento nos recuerda que no debemos vivir nuestras vidas con miedo ni permitirnos especulaciones ociosas sobre el momento del fin del mundo. No debemos perder nuestro tiempo con ansiosas predicciones del fin del mundo, sino, más bien, tener un sentido de esperanza y propósito y comprometernos a vivir vidas dignas del intenso amor que Dios nos tiene. La verdadera postura del Adviento -y cristiana- se encuentra en las palabras de Jesús: ***"Manténganse erguidos y levanten la cabeza porque su redención está cerca"***.


