Second Sunday of Advent

As we have begun this Advent Season, the readings this weekend are of change, change in our lives, change in how we see ourselves and how it is that we are called to change. If you think about it, all of God's Word is about change. It's also about our perspectives.

In the 1st reading we hear of Jerusalem being told to remove things the negativity that hold them back, and to put on something new, the splendor of Glory from God. I'm reminded of the instances where we all are on this eschatological (God travels with us) journey together, but in many ways, we hold ourselves back because of how we see ourselves. Instead of our negative perceptions of how we might see ourselves, we are told to stand tall, To be God's people! God is making our paths easier to follow Him.

The 2nd reading reiterates this. **"...the One who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus."** Paul urges the Philippians to continue to increase our love in knowledge, to discern our perceptions of what is really of value so that we can be pure and blameless when Christ comes.

In our baptismal call as priests, as prophets and royalty we are much like John the Baptizer, called to witness and share the excitement of our Lord's coming. ~ Amen!!!

It is my prayer that this week's readings touch your hearts as you get excited about the coming of our Lord.

Segundo Domingo de Adviento

Al comenzar esta temporada de Adviento, las lecturas de este fin de semana hablan de cambio, cambio en nuestras vidas, cambio en cómo nos vemos a nosotros mismos y cómo estamos llamados a cambiar. Si lo piensas, toda la Palabra de Dios habla de cambio. También habla de nuestras perspectivas.

En la primera lectura, escuchamos que se le dice a Jerusalén que elimine las cosas, la negatividad que la frena, y que se vista de algo nuevo, el esplendor de la Gloria de Dios. Recuerdo las ocasiones en las que todos estamos en este viaje escatológico (Dios viaja con nosotros) juntos, pero en muchos sentidos, nos frena a nosotros mismos debido a cómo nos vemos a nosotros mismos. En lugar de nuestras percepciones negativas de cómo podríamos vernos a nosotros mismos, se nos dice que nos mantengamos erguidos, ¡que seamos el pueblo de Dios! Dios está haciendo que nuestros caminos sean más fáciles para seguirlo.

La segunda lectura reitera esto. **"...el que comenzó en ustedes la buena obra la continuará perfeccionando hasta el día de Cristo Jesús"**. Pablo insta a los filipenses a seguir aumentando nuestro amor en el conocimiento, a discernir nuestras percepciones de lo que es realmente valioso para que podamos ser puros e irreprochables cuando Cristo venga.

En nuestro llamado bautismal como sacerdotes, profetas y miembros de la realeza, somos muy parecidos a Juan el Bautista, llamados a dar testimonio y compartir la emoción de la venida de nuestro Señor. ~ ¡Amén!

Es mi oración que las lecturas de esta semana toquen sus corazones mientras se entusiasman con la venida de nuestro Señor.

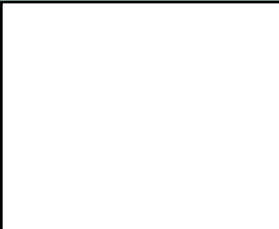
