The Holy Family

I'd like to share this reflection I found online... We tend to think of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as a model family we could never emulate. It is easy to think that they could never understand what we face day by day. That might be the case if the church were to call this the feast of the **"Perfect Family."** But perfection and holiness are not always the same thing. We live in an imperfect world, and messy things happen, no matter who we are. The key is how we respond when they do.

Look at this little incident as an example. A boy disappears without informing anyone, apparently giving no thought to the anxiety he may cause his parents. The parents, meanwhile, neglect to make sure their son is with them before starting on a long journey. How many times have we forgot to grab something before we left the house? When they retrace their steps to Jerusalem, they have no idea where to look for Jesus, because they really don't understand him or where God may be leading him. Riddled with anxiety, they don't hesitate to reproach him when they finally do find him. Yet in all these anxieties and misunderstandings, they remain holy, full of love for God and one another! There are times when we make mistakes, we judge, and we fail to understand each other, or feel very anxious. It's all right to tell family members and close friends how their behavior may have disappointed, hurt, or puzzled us, as long as we don't condemn or accuse them.

Let's just make sure we listen carefully to their explanations so that we can all move from honesty to greater love and understanding. Let's invite the Holy Family into our homes. Let's see our own families and circles of friends as places where holiness is at home—not a holiness that lives on a shelf untouched by the vicissitudes of daily life, but a holiness that unfolds and deepens as we journey together toward fuller participation in the kingdom of God.

"Joseph, Mary, Jesus, you are the Holy Family because you never stop loving each other. Fill my heart and my home with the same love."

Amen!

Me gustaría compartir esta reflexión que encontré en Internet...

Tendemos a pensar en Jesús, María y José como una familia modelo que nunca podríamos emular. Es fácil pensar que nunca podrían entender lo que enfrentamos día a día. Ese podría ser el caso si la iglesia llamara a esta fiesta la **"Familia Perfecta"**. Pero la perfección y la santidad no siempre son lo mismo. Vivimos en un mundo imperfecto y suceden cosas desordenadas, sin importar quiénes seamos. La clave es cómo reaccionamos cuando suceden.

Veamos este pequeño incidente como ejemplo. Un niño desaparece sin informar a nadie, aparentemente sin pensar en la ansiedad que puede causarles a sus padres. Mientras tanto, los padres se olvidan de asegurarse de que su hijo esté con ellos antes de emprender un largo viaje. ¿Cuántas veces nos hemos olvidado de agarrar algo antes de salir de casa? Cuando vuelven sobre sus pasos hacia Jerusalén, no tienen idea de dónde buscar a Jesús, porque realmente no lo entienden ni a dónde los puede estar guiando Dios. Llenos de ansiedad, no dudan en reprocharle cuando finalmente lo encuentran. Sin embargo, en medio de todas estas ansiedades y malentendidos, ¡siguen siendo santos, llenos de amor a Dios y a los demás! Hay momentos en que cometemos errores, juzgamos y no logramos comprendernos unos a otros, o nos sentimos muy ansiosos.

Está bien decirles a los miembros de la familia y a los amigos cercanos cómo su comportamiento puede habernos decepcionado, herido o desconcertado, siempre y cuando no los condenemos ni acusemos.

Asegurémonos de escuchar atentamente sus explicaciones para que todos podamos pasar de la honestidad a un mayor amor y comprensión. Invitemos a la Sagrada Familia a nuestros hogares. Veamos nuestras propias familias y círculos de amigos como lugares donde la santidad está en casa, no una santidad que vive en un estante intacto por las vicisitudes de la vida diaria, sino una santidad que se desarrolla y se profundiza a medida que caminamos juntos hacia una participación más plena en el reino de Dios.

"José, María, Jesús, ustedes son la Sagrada Familia porque nunca dejan de amarse. Llenen mi corazón y mi hogar con el mismo amor". ¡Amén!
