Sunday, January 5, 2025 — The Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany of our Lord.

In my family, it is a custom that on Christmas morning we choose one present from under the tree to be set aside and opened after we went to Mass on Sunday for the Epiphany. It was a way to honor the three wise men, who came and offered gifts in adoration to Jesus. Maybe in your families you too have certain traditions that bring back fond memories.

I think that when we have those moments, they become for us forms of enlightenment. You remember the story, that the Three Wise Men followed a star, much like us following our faith. They travel from various parts of the region, from various countries. I like to think of this as being “**universal**,” Catholic if you will. They have been sent on a mission by King Herod, but much like Jonah, they change their minds after seeing the child Jesus.

The moment of Epiphany comes when there is a striking realization that what they have been sent to do is wrong, hence they begin to recognize that the Child Jesus has tremendous purpose and meaning, that He is the newborn King.

Yes, they found him in a smelly, dirty old barn, but isn't that like life itself. Life is never what we want or think it to be, but with faith and hope, we too recognize that our Lord and King has come to be and walk with us, bringing us to enlightenment, and sharing of Himself with us so that we too can be what our Lord and God created us to be.

We need the traditions of these sudden “**Ah ha**” moments to remind us that we too are sharing the Love of God with those we encounter every day. Hence the gifts we share at the Epiphany are acts of love. (I've never seen an angry person give gifts to those they dislike.)

We acknowledge and give thanks for all of God's blessings and graces. It is my prayer that those special moments are blessings for you as well.

La Epifanía de nuestro Señor.

En mi familia, es una costumbre que en la mañana de Navidad escogemos un regalo de debajo del árbol para apartarlo y abrirlo después de ir a misa el domingo por la Epifanía. Era una forma de honrar a los tres Reyes Magos, que vinieron y ofrecieron regalos en adoración a Jesús. Tal vez en sus familias también tengan ciertas tradiciones que traen recuerdos entrañables.

Creo que cuando tenemos esos momentos, se convierten para nosotros en formas de iluminación. Recuerden la historia de que los Tres Reyes Magos siguieron una estrella, al igual que nosotros seguimos nuestra fe. Viajaron desde varias partes de la región, desde varios países. Me gusta pensar en esto como algo “**universal**”, católico, por así decirlo. Han sido enviados en una misión por el rey Herodes, pero al igual que Jonás, cambian de opinión después de ver al niño Jesús. El momento de la Epifanía llega cuando hay una sorprendente comprensión de que lo que han sido enviados a hacer está mal, por lo tanto, comienzan a reconocer que el Niño Jesús tiene un propósito y un significado tremendo, que Él es el Rey recién nacido.

Sí, lo encontraron en un viejo granero sucio y maloliente, pero ¿no es eso como la vida misma? La vida nunca es lo que queremos o pensamos que es, pero con fe y esperanza, nosotros también reconocemos que nuestro Señor y Rey ha venido a ser y caminar con nosotros, llevándonos a la iluminación y compartiendo de Sí mismo con nosotros para que también podamos ser lo que nuestro Señor y Dios nos creó para ser.

Necesitamos las tradiciones de estos repentinos momentos de “**Ajá**” para recordarnos que nosotros también estamos compartiendo el Amor de Dios con aquellos con quienes nos encontramos todos los días. Por lo tanto, los regalos que compartimos en la Epifanía son actos de amor. (Nunca he visto a una persona enojada dar regalos a quienes no le agradan). 
