A Note from Fr. Tom's Desk...

Firstly, I want to take this moment to say how grateful I am for all the prayers and generous contributions people have shared during this holiday season. I am humbled by your love and appreciation and stewardship / generosity. And prayers. It's wonderfully faith filled people like all of you who help make St. Patrick's the incredible parish we call our spiritual home. Thank all of you so very much and many blessings.

In today's readings we hear of salvation events... of proclamations that our salvation is at hand. I'm hearing that we must do our parts, much like John the baptizer, proclaim Jesus Christ, and witness like Jesus did in His baptism. The question remains is that, Did Jesus need to be baptized? Most people will say no because in His virginal birth of Mary, conceived without sin, Jesus never had "**original sin.**"

His baptism was a witness and an exclamation from God. I believe that Jesus did need to continue to show His disciples who he was. Remember doubting Thomas and others who chose not to believe that Jesus was the Son of God. So, what happens is, is that Jesus was baptized and then the Holy Spirit came down like a Dove and descended upon Him. I believe that the crescendo of this amazing event is that God the Father is also there and tells everyone present that Jesus is indeed His Son, and that we should pay attention and listen to Him.

Remembering that "**faith without works is dead,**" we are called and reminded of this when we celebrate our Lord's baptism. Even though John the Baptist points out Jesus to his disciples, we must also follow that recognition in how we to are witnesses of our Loving Lord, Jesus Christ. As we continue to celebrate our Lord's Birth, let us pray for one another.

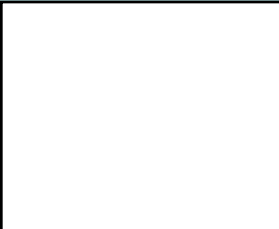
