3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

If we take a look at today's readings, they are about action, the actions we take to further enhance our understanding and relationship with, not only God, but with one another as the Body of Christ. You might ask how it is that we respond to this concept of our faith.

I look at it as Scripture mentions, that each part of the body has a purpose. Can't eat with my ears, nor can I hear with my toes. Each body part has specific purpose. I can't wash my feet with the hair on my head. Certain things were not meant to be. Let's look at this from a parish perspective.

Understanding from the perspective of what we hear in today's readings, we, as church, as parish, as community are called to be what it is that we receive, as St. Augustine mentioned, the Word, as we hear in today's Gospel, and as Jesus's Precious Body. You have heard in some of my homilies my question regarding which part of the Body are you? Remember that each body part helps another part of the body. I love what the 1st Reading mentions about God's intentions... **"God has placed the parts as He intended."**

I truly believe that God has placed me here for a purpose. Sometimes I wonder why. But I have come to realize that God gives us purpose. I also love that it mentions that **"God has so constructed the body so as to give greater honor to a part that is without it, so that there may be no division in the body, but that the parts may have the same concern for one another. If one part suffers, they all suffer; and if one part is honored, all parts share in the joy."**

This for me is one of the motivators of why it is that I do what I do, to help build up the Body of Christ right here at St. Patrick's in North Park. My Sisters and Brothers, that is part of our Baptismal Call, to witness and help one another, in building the faith, in building one another, but also building up who we, are as the Body of Jesus Christ! Amen!!! ~ Fr. Tom

Tercer Domingo Ordinario

Si echamos un vistazo a las lecturas de hoy, se trata de la acción, las acciones que tomamos para mejorar aún más nuestra comprensión y relación, no solo con Dios, sino con los demás como el Cuerpo de Cristo. Puede que se pregunte cómo respondemos a este concepto de nuestra fe.

Lo veo como menciona la Escritura, que cada parte del cuerpo tiene un propósito. No puedo comer con mis oídos, ni puedo escuchar con mis dedos de los pies. Cada parte del cuerpo tiene un propósito específico. No puedo lavarme los pies con el cabello de mi cabeza. Ciertas cosas no estaban destinadas a ser. Veámoslo desde una perspectiva parroquial.

Entendiendo desde la perspectiva de lo que escuchamos en las lecturas de hoy, nosotros, como iglesia, como parroquia, como comunidad, estamos llamados a ser lo que es que recibimos, como mencionó San Agustín, la Palabra, como escuchamos en el Evangelio de hoy, y como el Cuerpo Precioso de Jesús. Has escuchado en algunas de mis homilias mi pregunta sobre qué parte del Cuerpo eres. Recuerda que cada parte del cuerpo ayuda a otra parte del cuerpo. Me encanta lo que menciona la primera lectura sobre las intenciones de Dios... **"Dios ha colocado las partes como Él quería"**.

Realmente creo que Dios me ha colocado aquí con un propósito. A veces me pregunto por qué. Pero me he dado cuenta de que Dios nos da un propósito. También me encanta que menciona que **"Dios ha construido el cuerpo de tal manera que se dé mayor honor a una parte que está sin él, para que no haya división en el cuerpo, sino que las partes puedan tener la misma preocupación unas por otras. Si una parte sufre, todas sufren; y si una parte es honrada, todas las partes comparten la alegría"**.

Para mí, esto es uno de los motivos por los que hago lo que hago, para ayudar a construir el Cuerpo de Cristo aquí mismo en St. Patrick's en North Park. Mis hermanas y hermanos, eso es parte de nuestro llamado bautismal, dar testimonio y ayudarnos unos a otros, en la construcción de la fe, en la construcción de unos a otros, pero también en la construcción de quienes somos como el Cuerpo de Jesucristo. ¡Amén!

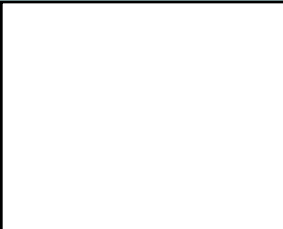
