### 2nd Sunday of Lent ~

In the First reading we hear of God entering into a covenant with Abram, telling him that his descendants will be as many as the stars in the sky, and he will give Abram a special land. In the Psalm we proclaim that we are strong people, that we should not fear. In the second reading, we hear of changes, if we form ourselves and hold onto Christ, our citizenship will be in heaven. He will change our bodies to be like His body. We are called to stand firm in our faith as believers.

Then in the Gospel, we hear of the Transfiguration. How it is that even Jesus changed in appearance along with Moses and Elijah. That our Father came down from heaven and spoke, telling the Apostles who were there to understand that Jesus was indeed His chosen son, and that we **"should listen to Him."** If we were to embrace this Lenten journey in the desert, we need to understand that it is about our relationship with God. We need to prepare ourselves. We know that prayer, fasting and alms giving are the main components of our journey, but we need to embrace the change we are being called to. We are called to fight the evil one and sometimes ourselves. We are called to prepare for this fight. Think of it as **"Bootcamp!"** We are being challenged, to learn how to be better warriors for Jesus and ourselves, but it takes preparation. We need to learn how to use the weapons of this battle we are in. Sorry, giving up things like chocolate is not good preparations for war. We need to get tough on ourselves, get physical, get mental, building up ourselves as Jesus has taught us to. We need to listen, to understand that we are in the last covenant, the Messianic Covenant, we are the Body of Jesus Christ, and we must stand up and witness to and for our faith. The first week of Lent is over and now we begin the real time of introspection, the time of building up our minds and bodies. Why, might you ask? Because WE ARE the Body of Jesus Christ, and we need to continually work, learn, and share who we are.

### Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma

En la primera lectura, escuchamos cómo Dios hace una alianza con Abram, diciéndole que sus descendientes serán tan numerosos como las estrellas del cielo y que le dará una tierra especial. En el Salmo proclamamos que somos personas fuertes y que no debemos temer. En la segunda lectura, escuchamos sobre cambios: si nos formamos y nos aferramos a Cristo, nuestra ciudadanía estará en el cielo. Él transformará nuestros cuerpos para que sean como el suyo. Estamos llamados a mantenernos firmes en nuestra fe como creyentes.

Luego, en el Evangelio, escuchamos sobre la Transfiguración. Cómo incluso Jesús cambió de apariencia junto con Moisés y Elías. Que nuestro Padre bajó del cielo y habló, diciendo a los apóstoles que estaban allí que comprendieran que Jesús era en verdad su hijo elegido y que **"debíamos escucharlo"**.

Si vamos a abrazar este viaje cuaresmal en el desierto, necesitamos comprender que se trata de nuestra relación con Dios. Necesitamos prepararnos. Sabemos que la oración, el ayuno y la limosna son los componentes principales de nuestro camino, pero necesitamos abrazar el cambio al que estamos llamados. Estamos llamados a luchar contra el maligno y, a veces, contra nosotros mismos. Estamos llamados a prepararnos para esta lucha. ¡Piénsenlo como un **"campo de entrenamiento!"**

Estamos siendo desafiados a aprender a ser mejores guerreros para Jesús y para nosotros mismos, pero requiere preparación. Necesitamos aprender a usar las armas de esta batalla en la que estamos. Lo siento, renunciar a cosas como el chocolate no es una buena preparación para la guerra. Necesitamos ser duros con nosotros mismos, fortalecernos física y mentalmente, edificándonos como Jesús nos enseñó. Necesitamos escuchar, comprender que estamos en la última alianza, la Alianza Mesianica, somos el Cuerpo de Jesucristo y debemos levantarnos y dar testimonio de nuestra fe.

La primera semana de Cuaresma ha terminado y ahora comienza el verdadero tiempo de introspección, el tiempo de fortalecer nuestras mentes y cuerpos. ¿Por qué? Porque SOMOS el Cuerpo de Jesucristo, y necesitamos continuamente trabajar, aprender y compartir quiénes somos.

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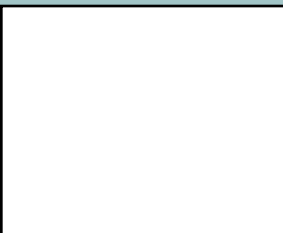
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
