## *Sunday, June 8, 2025 — Pentecost Sunday*

### **Pentecost Sunday Reflection (Acts 2:1–11)**

***“They were all filled with the Holy Spirit...” (Acts 2:4)***

Pentecost is not just a moment in history, it is the ongoing reality of the Church's birth, breath, and boldness. When the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples like wind and fire, fear gave way to courage, silence turned into proclamation, and division was overcome by unity in the Spirit.

In a world of confusion and closed hearts, the Holy Spirit still speaks, powerfully, and in every language of love. What was once spoken only in upper rooms is now meant to be heard on every street and in every soul. St. Paul teaches us that the Spirit not only gives us courage but also equips the Church with diverse spiritual gifts: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, prophecy, discernment, and more (*cf. 1 Cor 12:4–11*). These gifts are not for personal glory, but for building up the Body of Christ. Just as the Spirit united diverse peoples in Jerusalem, so too does He unite our different talents and vocations in service to one mission: Christ's mission.

Each of us, baptized and confirmed, is called to live as a Spirit-filled witness, not just within church walls but in our homes, workplaces, and communities. The Spirit enables us to speak Christ through the “languages” of compassion, patience, mercy, and truth. This Pentecost, let us ask: Are we still waiting behind locked doors, or are we ready to be sent?

Come, Holy Spirit renew us, your Church, and the face of the earth.

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### **Reflexión para el Domingo de Pentecostés – Hechos 2,1–11**

***“Todos quedaron llenos del Espíritu Santo...” (Hch 2,4)***

Pentecostés no es solo un momento del pasado, es una realidad viva que sigue dando aliento, identidad y fuerza a la Iglesia. Cuando el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los discípulos como viento y fuego, el miedo se convirtió en valentía, el silencio en proclamación, y la división en unidad.

En un mundo lleno de confusión y corazones cerrados, el Espíritu sigue hablando, con claridad, con poder, y en todos los lenguajes del amor. Lo que antes se anunciaba solo en el cenáculo, ahora está destinado a resonar en cada rincón del mundo y en cada corazón abierto.

San Pablo nos enseña que el Espíritu no solo da valor, sino que reparte dones espirituales diversos: sabiduría, ciencia, fe, sanación, profecía, discernimiento, entre otros (*cf. 1 Cor 12,4–11*). Estos dones no son para engrandecernos, sino para edificar el Cuerpo de Cristo. Así como en Jerusalén el Espíritu unió a personas de distintas lenguas y culturas, también hoy une nuestros talentos y vocaciones para un solo propósito: la misión de Cristo.

Cada uno de nosotros, bautizado y confirmado, está llamado a vivir como testigo lleno del Espíritu, no solo dentro del templo, sino también en nuestros hogares, trabajos y comunidades. El Espíritu nos capacita para hablar de Cristo a través de los “lenguajes” de la compasión, la paciencia, la misericordia y la verdad.

Este Pentecostés, preguntémonos: ¿Seguimos esperando tras puertas cerradas, o estamos listos para salir enviados?

Ven, Espíritu Santo renuévanos, renueva tu Iglesia, y renueva la faz de la tierra.

## ASSISTANCE FOR SEMINARIANS AND RETIRED PRIESTS

The Annual Catholic Appeal provides essential support for seminarians preparing for the priesthood, helping to fund their formation.

In 2025, three seminarians are to be ordained to the priesthood in our diocese, the culmination of five or six years of preparation.

This year, a total of 12 seminarians are in various stages of priestly formation.

The ACA also offers vital support for retired priests, supplementing their pension when necessary. They have dedicated their lives to serving the People of God at parishes across the diocese and now look to the community to help sustain them after retiring.

The normal retirement age for a priest in our diocese is age 75. However, many continue to participate in the life of the Church as long as they are able to, celebrating Masses and more.

Like the rest of the community, retired priests face escalating costs in housing, food, medical care, and prescription drugs. Through the ACA we help them to meet these needs.

A retired priest described the sense of security he feels after serving in various parishes for 44 years.

"I'm so grateful to discover that, in our retirement years, Cardinal McElroy and the diocese have our back."

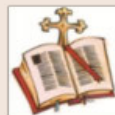

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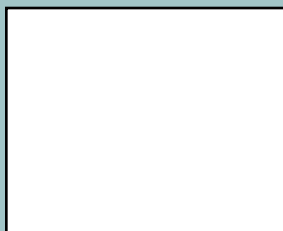
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
