Humility: The Way to God's Favor

Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29; Luke 14:1, 7-14

The Word of God this Sunday leads us to reflect on a fundamental attitude of the Christian life: **humility**.

The Book of Sirach offers us timeless wisdom: *"My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. The greater you are, the more you must humble yourself; so you will find favor with God."* In our society, we are often encouraged to climb higher, to compete, to always seek the first place. Yet, Scripture reminds us that true greatness is not measured by titles, wealth, or recognition, but by the ability to walk humbly before God and others.

Jesus echoes this lesson in the Gospel. At a banquet, He notices how people rush for the best seats, desiring honor and attention. He responds with a countercultural teaching: *"When you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place... For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."* For Jesus, humility is not weakness; it is the path to true honor in God's sight.

But He goes even further. He challenges us not only to take the lower place but also to practice generosity without expecting repayment: *"When you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind."* This is radical love. It calls us to embrace those who cannot benefit us in return, to see in them the very presence of Christ.

Humility, then, does not mean denying our gifts or talents. Rather, it means using them in service. A humble person knows that all good comes from God and lives in such a way that Christ, not the self, shines through.

This week, let us ask: Do I live for recognition, or do I allow God to lift me up in His time? Am I willing to step down so that others may rise? Can I give without calculating what I will get in return?

In God's Kingdom, the places of honor are not reserved for the powerful, but for those who live with humble and generous hearts.

Humildad: el camino al favor de Dios

Eclesiástico 3,17-18.20.28-29; Lucas 14,1.7-14

La Palabra de Dios de este domingo nos invita a mirar nuestra vida desde una clave fundamental del Evangelio: la **humildad**.

El libro del Eclesiástico nos aconseja: "Hijo mío, actúa con humildad en tus quehaceres y serás más amado que el que regala cosas. Cuanto más grande seas, más humilde debes ser, y así hallarás gracia ante el Señor". En nuestra sociedad actual, muchas veces se nos anima a sobresalir, a competir, a buscar siempre el primer lugar. Pero la sabiduría de Dios nos recuerda que la verdadera grandeza no consiste en imponernos sobre los demás, sino en reconocer nuestra pequeñez delante de Dios y en servir con sencillez.

Jesús, en el Evangelio, confirma este camino. Durante un banquete, observa cómo los invitados corren hacia los primeros asientos, buscando honores y prestigio. Entonces nos da una enseñanza sorprendente: *"Cuando te inviten, ve a ocupar el último lugar... Porque todo el que se engrandece será humillado, y el que se humilla será enaltecido"*. Jesús no solo nos pide evitar la arrogancia, sino que nos propone un estilo de vida diferente, donde el valor de la persona no depende de títulos ni reconocimientos, sino de su capacidad de amar.

Más aún, el Señor nos invita a una generosidad sin cálculos: *"Cuando des un banquete, invita a los pobres, lisiados, cojos y ciegos"*. En otras palabras, invita a los que no te pueden devolver nada. Esa es la prueba auténtica de un corazón que actúa por amor y no por interés.

Ser humilde no significa sentirse inferior ni negar los dones recibidos. Significa vivírselos como un servicio, reconociendo que todo es gracia de Dios. El humilde no busca brillar por encima de los demás, sino hacer brillar a Cristo en todo lo que hace.

Esta semana preguntémonos: ¿En qué situaciones busco el reconocimiento humano en lugar de la aprobación de Dios? ¿Estoy dispuesto a ocupar el último lugar si eso me acerca más al Señor? ¿Soy capaz de compartir con quienes nada pueden darme a cambio?

En el banquete del Reino de Dios, los primeros asientos no se reservan a los poderosos de este mundo, sino a los que viven con un corazón humilde.
