**Fr. The Desk of Fr. Tom ~
5th Sunday of Easter (A)**

Dear sisters and brothers, in today's reading we have the wonderful opportunity to look at ourselves as church. Luke uses the word "*disciples*" to identify "*believers*." It is from this group that the Apostles "laid hands upon them." In almost all instances in scripture and in our faith, the Holy Spirit is involved. When this happens, a sacrament is in progress. With this laying on of hands, these men were given through Apostolic succession, were ordained to the priesthood. It even mentioned that a large group of Jewish priests were converted becoming obedient to the Faith. This is an important concept in the second reading.

Come to Him, a living stone... Our Church is built upon stones, and it began with Jesus calling Simon, Peter, in Greek, Petros, which means rock, being built by Jesus into a "Spiritual house, to be offered as a *"holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ."* This began at your Baptism!!! You were called to be one of the stones that helps build our Holy Catholic Church!!! The idea that believing in the "*capstone*" is that "*chosen, precious,*" believers will not be put to shame. Jesus is going to take care of His Church! It is a stone that will cause others "*to stumble,*" in their choosing not to be obey God's word, who is Jesus Christ. Remember that choice is something we make. There are "*Christians*" who choose to not believe in what Jesus called His Church to do. We need to practice and "*have faith.*" Our Lord calls us!!!

In the Gospel, we are called to believe that Jesus IS the way, the Truth and the Life. In my understanding of this Scripture is that not only is Jesus the Truth, but that the Truth also sets us free, gives us a way to Jesus, who says that He is in the Father. The next statement from Jesus is that he who believes in Him will do the works that He does (prayers, consoling and others, healing, sharing His Body and Blood and others.)

I think that in all the Scriptures we hear today, it all revolves around how it is that we believe in who we are called to believe we are... living stones, believers, disciples, followers, "*devoting ourselves to prayer and the ministry of the Word.*" Are you ready?

Queridas hermanas y hermanos: en la lectura de hoy tenemos la maravillosa oportunidad de contemplarnos a nosotros mismos como Iglesia. Lucas utiliza la palabra «discípulos» para identificar a los "creyentes". Fue sobre este grupo que los Apóstoles "impusieron las manos". En casi todas las ocasiones, tanto en las Escrituras como en nuestra fe, interviene el Espíritu Santo. Cuando esto sucede, se está realizando un sacramento. Mediante esta imposición de manos, y a través de la sucesión apostólica, estos hombres fueron ordenados al sacerdocio. Incluso se menciona que un gran grupo de sacerdotes judíos se convirtió, haciéndose obedientes a la Fe. Este es un concepto importante en la segunda lectura.

Acérquense a Él, piedra viva... Nuestra Iglesia está edificada sobre piedras, y su inicio se remonta a cuando Jesús llamó a Simón —Pedro; en griego, *Petros*, que significa "piedra"—, para ser edificado por Jesús como una "casa espiritual", destinada a constituir un "sacerdocio santo para ofrecer sacrificios espirituales, aceptables a Dios por medio de Jesucristo». ¡¡¡Esto comenzó en su Bautismo!!! ¡¡¡Ustedes fueron llamados a ser una de las piedras que ayudan a edificar nuestra Santa Iglesia Católica!!! La idea implícita en creer en la "piedra angular" es que los creyentes —"elegidos y preciosos"— no quedarán avergonzados. ¡Jesús cuidará de su Iglesia! Es una piedra que hará "tropezar" a otros, a aquellos que eligen no obedecer la Palabra de Dios, que es Jesucristo. Recuerden que la elección es algo que nosotros realizamos. Hay «cristianos» que deciden no creer en aquello que Jesús llamó a su Iglesia a realizar. Necesitamos ponerlo en práctica y "tener fe". ¡¡¡Nuestro Señor nos llama!!!

En el Evangelio, somos llamados a creer que Jesús ES el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Según mi interpretación de esta Escritura, no solo es que Jesús sea la Verdad, sino que esa Verdad también nos libera y nos abre un camino hacia Jesús, quien afirma que Él está en el Padre. La siguiente afirmación de Jesús es que aquel que cree en Él realizará las obras que Él realiza (la oración, el consuelo y otras acciones, la sanación, el compartir Su Cuerpo y Su Sangre, entre otras).

Creo que, en todas las Escrituras que escuchamos hoy, todo gira en torno a cómo creemos en aquello que estamos llamados a creer que somos: piedras vivas, creyentes, discípulos, seguidores, "dedicándonos a la oración y al ministerio de la Palabra". ¿Están listos?

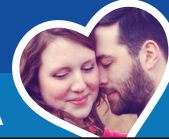
