**PENTECOST SUNDAY, YEAR A
THE SPIRIT WHO MAKES US NEW**

Pentecost is often called the “*birthday of the Church*,” but it is much more than an anniversary. It is the moment when ordinary disciples, confused, fearful, unsure of their future, were transformed from the inside out. The same men and women who had locked themselves in a room suddenly stepped into the world with courage, clarity, and joy. What changed? Not their circumstances, but **their hearts**. The Holy Spirit breathed new life into them.

In today’s readings, Jesus enters the room where the disciples are hiding and says, “*Peace be with you.*” Then He breathes on them and gives them the Spirit. Notice the order: peace first, mission second. The Spirit does not come to overwhelm us, but to steady us, to anchor us, to remind us that we are never alone. Only then does He send us out.

Pentecost reminds us that the Holy Spirit is not a distant force. He is God’s own life dwelling within us, the One who heals what is wounded, strengthens what is weak, and rekindles what has grown cold. He gives gifts not for our own glory but for the building up of the Church and the healing of the world. Some gifts are dramatic, like tongues of fire. Most are quiet: patience, wisdom, compassion, courage, forgiveness. These are the flames that keep the Church alive.

This week, we might ask ourselves: Where do I need the Spirit’s fire? Where do I need His peace? Where is God inviting me to step out of my “*locked room*”?

Pentecost is not a story of the past. It is a promise for today. The same Spirit who moved over the waters of creation, who descended upon the apostles, who has guided the Church for centuries, that Spirit is breathing in us now. May we welcome Him with open hearts, and may He make us new.

EL ESPÍRITU QUE NOS HACE NUEVOS

Pentecostés suele llamarse el “*nacimiento de la Iglesia*”, pero es mucho más que un aniversario. Es el momento en que discípulos comunes, confundidos, temerosos, inseguros del futuro, fueron transformados desde dentro. Los mismos hombres y mujeres que se habían encerrado por miedo salieron al mundo con valentía, claridad y alegría. ¿Qué cambió? No sus circunstancias, sino **sus corazones**. El Espíritu Santo sopló vida nueva en ellos.

En las lecturas de hoy, Jesús entra en el lugar donde los discípulos están escondidos y les dice: “*La paz esté con ustedes.*” Luego sopla sobre ellos y les da el Espíritu. Observa el orden: primero la paz, luego la misión. El Espíritu no viene para abrumarnos, sino para darnos estabilidad, para anclarnos, para recordarnos que nunca caminamos solos. Solo entonces nos envía.

Pentecostés nos recuerda que el Espíritu Santo no es una fuerza lejana. Es la vida misma de Dios que habita en nosotros: Aquel que sana lo herido, fortalece lo débil y reaviva lo que se ha enfriado. Sus dones no son para nuestra gloria personal, sino para edificar la Iglesia y sanar el mundo. Algunos dones son llamativos, como lenguas de fuego. La mayoría son silenciosos: paciencia, sabiduría, compasión, valentía, perdón. Estas son las llamas que mantienen viva a la Iglesia.

Esta semana podemos preguntarnos: ¿Dónde necesito el fuego del Espíritu? ¿Dónde necesito su paz? En qué “*cuarto cerrado*” me invita Dios a dar un paso hacia afuera? Pentecostés no es un recuerdo del pasado. Es una promesa para hoy. El mismo Espíritu que se movía sobre las aguas de la creación, que descendió sobre los apóstoles y que ha guiado a la Iglesia durante siglos, es el Espíritu que respira en nosotros ahora. Que lo recibamos con un corazón abierto, y que Él nos haga nuevos.

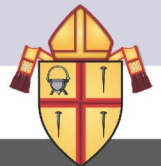

DIocese of San Diego

The faithful of the Diocese of San Diego are asked to exercise caution with a group of men fraudulently posing as Catholic priests and bishop.

They claim to be Guadalupan Missionaries of the Most Holy Sacrament (MGSS) and are offering sacraments to Catholic families in exchange for money. The public is advised that any sacraments conferred by these men are invalid and illicit.

These group of men—some of them ordained priests but now laicized, have formed their own sect and reside in Rosarito but are not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

Reports of these fraudulent priests have been sighted in our diocese and the public must contact their pastor should you become aware of any incidents. Some of the fraudulent priests names are: Bishop Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa, Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

If anyone is a victim of fraud relating to these priests, please contact the authorities.
