Do Not be Afraid

Jesus speaks directly to us: "Do not be afraid." He repeats it not because fear is rare, but because it is so familiar. Fear can quietly shape our decisions, limit our generosity, and make us hesitant to live our faith openly. Jesus knows this, and He meets us right there, in the places where we feel small, uncertain, or overwhelmed.

He reminds us that God sees the full truth of our lives. Nothing is hidden from the Father: not our intentions, not our struggles, not the quiet acts of love we offer when no one else is watching. If God notices even the fall of a sparrow, one of the least valued creatures in the marketplace, how much more does He notice us. Our worth is not measured by our accomplishments or by the approval of others. It is rooted in the unwavering love of the One who created us.

To acknowledge Christ before others does not require dramatic gestures or public speeches. It begins in the ordinary moments of daily life: choosing patience when we feel rushed, offering forgiveness when it is difficult, speaking truth with kindness, or showing compassion when it would be easier to look away. These small, faithful choices become a quiet but powerful testimony to the presence of Christ within us.

Jesus does not promise a life free from challenges. Instead, He promises that we will never face them alone. Courage in the Christian life is not the absence of fear, it is the decision to trust God more deeply than our fears, to let His love steady our steps, and to believe that He is at work even when we cannot see the full picture.

As we enter this new week, perhaps we can ask ourselves: Where is fear holding me back, and what might happen if I allowed God's love to guide me instead?

No Tengas Miedo

Jesús nos habla directamente: "No tengas miedo." Lo repite no porque el miedo sea raro, sino porque le resulta tan familiar. El miedo puede moldear silenciosamente nuestras decisiones, limitar nuestra generosidad y hacernos dudar en vivir nuestra fe abiertamente. Jesús lo sabe, y nos encuentra justo ahí, en los lugares donde nos sentimos pequeños, inseguros o abrumados.

Nos recuerda que Dios ve toda la verdad de nuestras vidas. Nada se oculta al Padre: ni nuestras intenciones, ni nuestras luchas, ni los silenciosos actos de amor que ofrecemos cuando nadie más nos observa. Si Dios nota incluso la caída de un gorrión, una de las criaturas menos valoradas del mercado, ¿cuánto más nos observa? Nuestro valor no se mide por nuestros logros ni por la aprobación de los demás. Está arraigado en el amor inquebrantable de Aquel que nos creó.

Reconocer a Cristo ante los demás no requiere gestos dramáticos ni discursos públicos. Comienza en los momentos ordinarios de la vida diaria: elegir la paciencia cuando nos sentimos apresurados, ofrecer perdón cuando es difícil, decir la verdad con amabilidad o mostrar compasión cuando sería más fácil apartar la mirada. Estas pequeñas y fieles elecciones se convierten en un testimonio silencioso pero poderoso de la presencia de Cristo dentro de nosotros. Jesús no promete una vida libre de desafíos. En cambio, promete que nunca los enfrentaremos solos. El valor en la vida cristiana no es la ausencia de miedo, es la decisión de confiar en Dios más profundamente que en nuestros temores, de dejar que Su amor nos ayude a calmar nuestros pasos y de creer que Él está actuando incluso cuando no podemos ver el panorama completo.

Al entrar en esta nueva semana, quizá podamos preguntarnos: ¿Dónde me frena el miedo y qué podría pasar si permitiera que el amor de Dios me guiara en su lugar?
