GOSPEL MEDITATION - Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture
December 30, 2018 - The Holy Family

"After three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers." As we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family, this Gospel exposes us to a strange tension. While this family is one we can look to for an example, they are not quite the same family unit as everyone else. There is an otherness to Jesus, something profound. And yet, perhaps on second thought, are our families so different? When Mary and Joseph encountered Jesus in the temple, "they were astonished." But at what? Mary's response is surprised. They're not astonished that Jesus is preaching in a place for respected teachers. They're not astonished that their son has captured the attention of the wisest men of the time period. They're astonished at his seemingly disobedient behavior! "Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." All our children have an "otherness" about them, something that makes them unique and different. They are distinctly not "me." What will our own children become? What temple will they wander off to? Who will they astound?

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO - Fomentar el Entendimiento Profundo de Entendimiento de la Escritura

30 de diciembre de 2018 - La Sagrada Familia
"Después de tres días lo encontraron en el templo, sentados en medio de los maestros, escuchándolos y haciéndoles preguntas, y todos los que lo escucharon se sorprendieron de su comprensión y de sus respuestas". Al celebrar la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, este Evangelio nos expone a una tensión extraña. Si bien podemos ver un ejemplo de esta familia, no son exactamente la misma unidad familiar que todos los demás. Hay una alteridad en Jesús, algo profundo. Y, sin embargo, quizás pensándolo bien, ¿son nuestras familias tan diferentes? Cuando María y José se encontraron con Jesús en el templo, "se asombraron". Pero a qué? La respuesta de María se sorprende. No se sorprenden de que Jesús esté predicando en un lugar para maestros respetados. No se sorprenden de que su hijo haya captado la atención de los hombres más sabios del período. ¡Están asombrados por su comportamiento aparentemente desobediente! "Hijo, ¿por qué nos has hecho esto? Tu padre y yo te hemos estado buscando con gran ansiedad". Todos nuestros hijos tienen una "alteridad" acerca de ellos, algo que los hace únicos y diferentes. Ellos son claramente no "yo". ¿En qué se convertirán nuestros propios hijos? ¿A qué templo se irán? ¿A quién asombrarán?

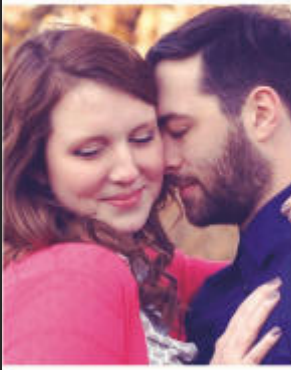
