

Protect Your Medicare

Follow these Tips to prevent Medicare ID fraud:

- Keep your Medicare and Social Security cards secure.
- >> Don't share your numbers with anyone but your health care team.
- If someone calls and asks for your Medicare information, hang up. Medicare will only call you if you've called and left a message or a representative said that someone will call you back.
- >> Check your statements carefully and log into **Medicare.gov** to spot any possible fraud or billing mistakes.
- Report suspicious activities by calling Senior Medicare Patrol:

KINGDOM BUILDER UPDATE

Since 2007, the Kingdom Builder Foundation has been stewarding legacy gifts from members and friends of Solana Beach Presbyterian Church, providing hundreds of grants that support dynamic Christ-centered ministries at home and throughout the globe. One of those ministries is Plant with Purpose, a Dominican Republic-based outreach that partners with farmers, their families, helping them work their way out of poverty, restore their land, and grow in their faith in Christ.

The ministry's holistic model promotes sustainable development through local empowerment, economic resilience, regenerative agriculture, reforestation, and restored relationships through all of creation. Partnering farmers are able to cut their level of poverty by 55% and experience 37% higher crop yields.

PLANTW

A recent Kingdom Builder grant enabled Plant with Purpose to work with 400 new families in the Cana Watershed of the Dominican Republic, directly impacting the lives of almost 2,000 people. These families are now participating in community-based savings groups, called Purpose Groups. Purpose Groups provide a platform THPURPOSE for members to save money, to access loans, to receive training, and to encourage and support each other. On average, each family in the Dominican Republic is planting over 300 trees a year and have currently saved over \$200 of their own money. Even more important is their increased level of confidence in God, themselves and each other.

Raul and Claudia, a couple in one of the Cana Watershed Purpose Group's, had this to say about their involvement in the program: "Before we found out about Plant with Purpose we had so many financial uncertainties. We'd been down for such a long time,

we were even considering leaving the farm life behind and living with some of our children in the city. But once we heard about this plan to restore our community, we became determined to stay and work the land! With the help of Plant with Purpose, we've made new investments in our plot's production. We've also bought equipment for solar panels, so we can help our daughter Raguel have light to see when studying so she can improve her life. We have a wood house right now, but we have a plan to remake it from sturdier materials."


