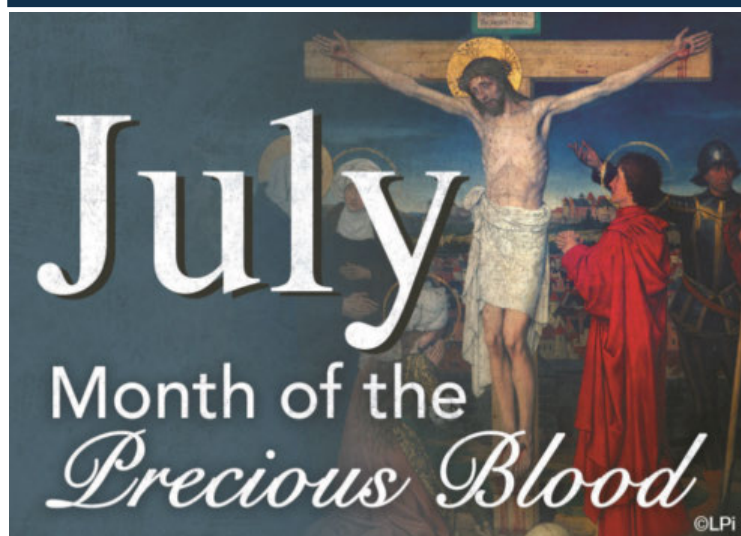

FAITH FOR THE FUTURE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN 2024

To: Church of the Madalene,

I have been made aware of concerns that I may be moving the target amount needed for our current "Faith for the Future Capital Campaign." I apologize if I have been unclear about the campaign's goals during my weekly updates.

The very first item we presented is the renovation of the Kitchen and Parish Hall which is needed not only to continue our mission of helping the less fortunate in our community, but also to provide a facelift for the widely used Parish Hall where we all meet for meetings, meals, and special occasions. The original "estimate" from the architect was \$600,000. It is possible the Kitchen/Hall Project may come in under budget when all is said and done, but if so, it probably won't be by much. There will be surprises with the project during construction as there are with any project.

In the interest of transparency, within the next week I will prepare an accounting of the Kitchen/Hall Renovation detailing all of the cost components we have agreed to include in the project. This information will be available on the Madalene website as well as be included in the weekly email and the printed bulletin. I want all of you to trust the process of accounting for and spending your generous donations to the Campaign.

As we made clear in the printed brochure you see in the pews each week, "Security and Lighting Upgrades will be addressed if funds are available." Campus security issues have come to the forefront in recent months with continued intrusions and damage to our facilities happening regularly. Several parishioners have expressed to me that security issues should take priority ahead of the Kitchen/Hall renovation. Madalene needs to make our grounds and facilities safe for our employees, our worshipers, and our guests whether we can afford it or not. The need for safety is critical as everyone needs to feel safe

while visiting our Parish. We need to properly address this issue.

Our outdated church lighting is old technology that is relatively costly to operate and maintain. I have been talking about lighting upgrades for years. LED lighting is much more cost effective and does not radiate heat like the fluorescent bulbs we currently use. Surely you have noticed how hard it is to cool the church in the summer months. Upgrading to LED lighting should lower our monthly expenses. If we can make the lighting more attractive and effective, the new lighting system will certainly add to Madalene's overall appeal.

If I have been vague about the Capital Campaign's target goal for funds needed, it is because we do not know how much the security and lighting improvements will cost. We are asking for input from contractors and as you might guess, we are getting a wide variety of proposals and recommendations. While the Kitchen/Hall Project is ready to start, we will not proceed with any security or lighting projects until the Finance Committee and Parish Council approve the contractor and scope of work. The same transparency procedure will be used for these projects as well. We will publish the costs for each project once the information is settled.

Let me assure you that our 2024 Capital Campaign effort is only for the benefit of Madalene Parishioners. This is your church, and these improvements will benefit the Parish long after I have been assigned elsewhere in the coming years. Part of my mission is to improve Parish Life for the Church of the Madalene, for all of you, and for future parishioners.

If there are any questions, please contact me or any Parish representative. We will treat your request with respect and honesty. I am here to serve you.

Everyday Stewardship

The Prophecy of You and Me

Prophet. There's a heaviness to this word. It's weighted down with meaning. We think of prophets and we think of Charlton Heston with wild hair and a booming voice, reaching out his hand to work wonders of nature by the grace of God. We think of prophets and we think of ancient Biblical history — someone far away, someone so removed from our everyday life. A prophet is someone who knows something we don't.

When I let you in on this secret, it might scare you at first: in a way, God is calling you to be a prophet. He is calling me. He is calling anyone who hears the truth of the Gospel. However, there is no need for the megaphone and the wild locusts. This prophet gig might not be what you're thinking.



What does a prophet do? He hears and testifies to the truth, even when it's uncomfortable, even when it's unpopular, even when it results in, as Paul says, "weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions and constraints." A prophet doesn't have to be

smart or rich or ordained; heck, he doesn't even have to be particularly willing.

All a prophet has to do is listen to the truth. The truth we receive from Christ, through the Gospel and the sacraments, is a mighty gift. But it is a gift that we are not meant to simply keep for ourselves. In possessing it, we are compelled to also pass it on, to share it, to let the Spirit set us on our feet. — *Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS*

COFFEE & DONUTS

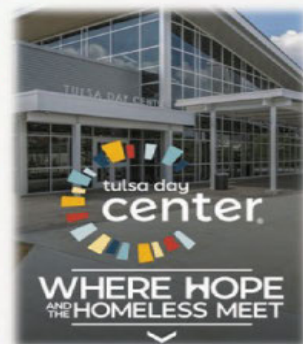
