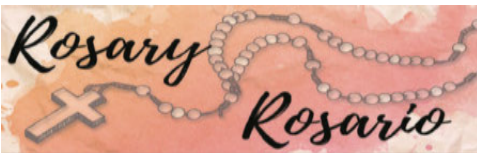

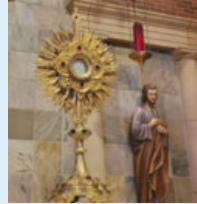

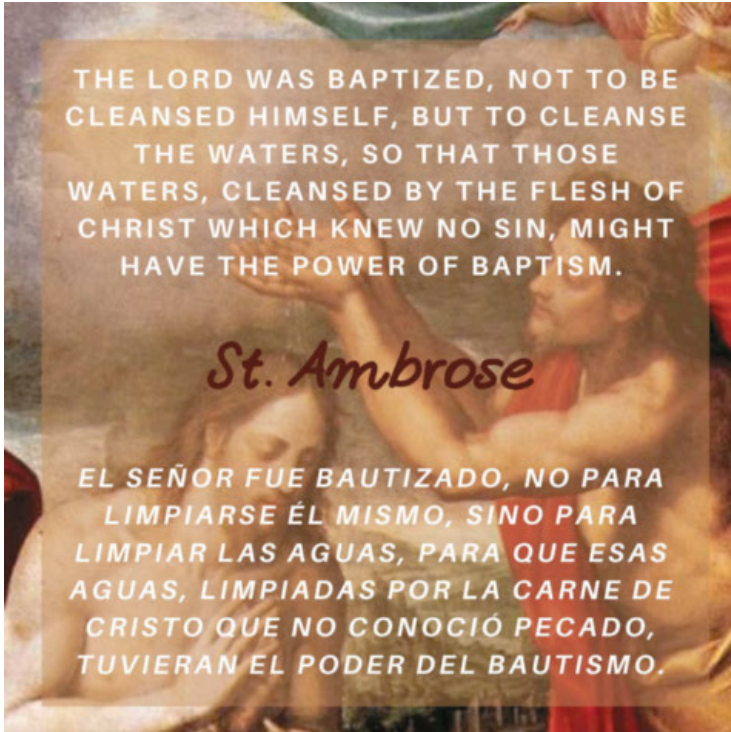


El Bautismo del Señor

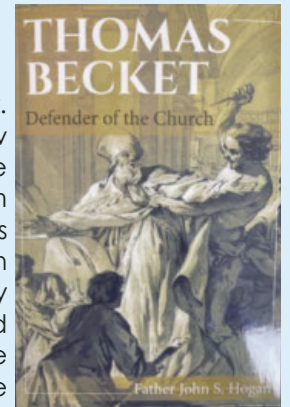

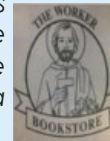


**Thomas Becket

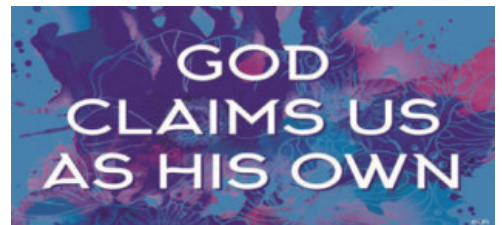



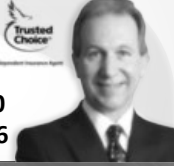
