This Sunday we hear the account of the Wedding Feast at Cana. At this feast, Jesus changes the water into the "Best Wine". This was uncommon at a wedding feast. Usually you served the inferior wine last and the best first. Jesus offers this gift of this wine and the gift of himself. This Gospel shows us a glimpse into the truth of the Eternal Wedding Feast in Heaven. This "Best Wine" is the gift of eternal life. It is the gift of Jesus himself. It foreshadows the sacrament of the Eucharist where Jesus gives us his body and blood to eat and drink. Jesus promises to give this wine always. He promises to be with us always until the end of the age. Jesus is the wine, He is the promise of eternal life and He will show us the way to the Heavenly Father.

During Ordinary Time in the Church, we get to hear many wonderful Sunday Gospel readings. I encourage you to read these Sunday Readings on your own. Use them to meditate on God's love for you and His church. Maybe read them with your family before or after Sunday Mass. God bless you. Fr. Irwin
