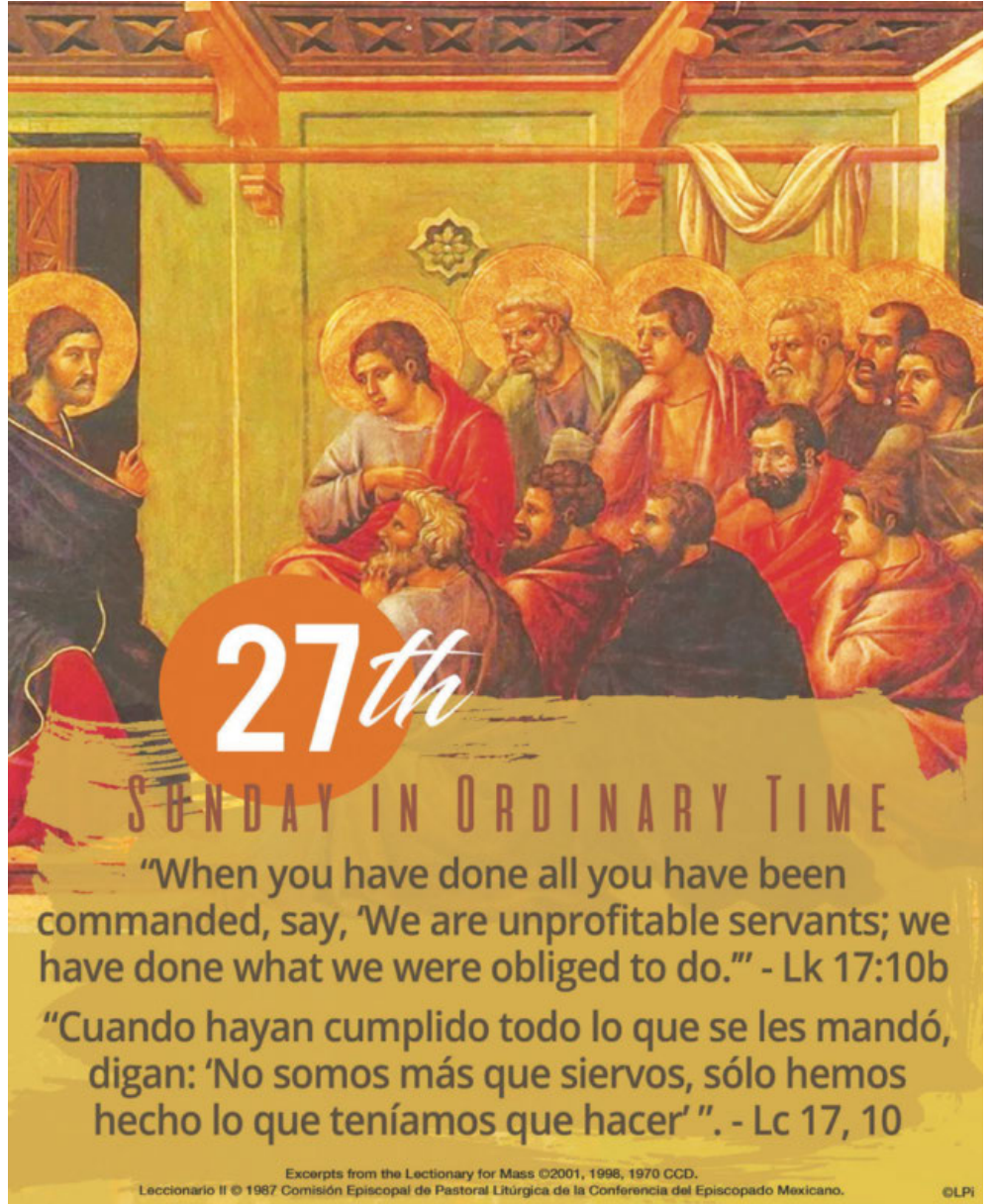

Priestly and Religious Vocations Come From Families

During the month of October, I want to offer you some reflections on the importance of saying yes to our Vocation. A Vocation is our calling from God. We live our vocations in many different ways, but the ordinary Vocations of the Church are Marriage, Priesthood and Religious or Consecrated Life.

Today I want to consider this question, where do vocations come from? Primarily, our knowledge, desire and encouragement of our Vocation comes from our families. They can be inspired in other places too; from our schools, our parishes, with friends and our heroes, those who show us how to truly serve God. But, the foundation of our vocation comes from the family. We first learn to pray at home. Praying as a family is so important! Spend time at home, with your spouse, children and grandchildren, praying, talk to Jesus, reading scripture and encountering Jesus together. This is where Jesus begins to speak to our hearts. Jesus will give an abundance of blessing upon those families that pray, offer sacrifices and worship God together.

From this place of family love and prayer, Jesus speaks to our hearts. Come and follow me! Too often I hear of parents not encouraging their children to follow the will of God. If your son or daughter is considering the priesthood or consecrated life, do not discourage them. Show them love and support. Show them how to say yes to the Call of Jesus.

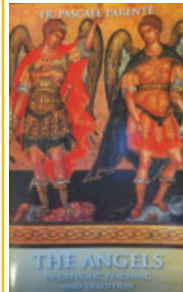

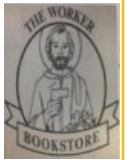
The Angels in catholic teaching and tradition

Bulletin Announcement of Archdiocese of OKC Abuse of Minors and Vulnerable Adults

The Archdiocese of Oklahoma City through its programs, organizations and events, has numerous daily contacts with many minors and vulnerable adults. It is, therefore, important that all Archdiocesan Personnel, clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers, protect the rights of children and vulnerable adults and be alert to the possibility for child abuse and abuse of vulnerable adults.

Under Oklahoma State law, all individuals MUST report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18 years of age) to the civil authorities immediately. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services has established a statewide abuse hotline for reporting: 1-800-522-3511. This number is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If you have reason to believe a child is in immediate danger of harm call 911.

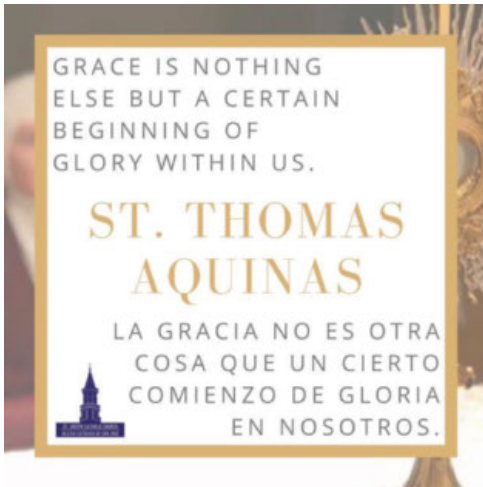
For the safety of children and vulnerable adults and the healing of victims, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City provides an Abuse of Minors and Vulnerable Adults Pastoral Response Hotline for reporting the abuse of minors and vulnerable adults (in the past or presently) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel: 1-405-720-9878. The Archdiocesan Victims Assistance Coordinator, a licensed professional counselor, will respond to calls to the Archdiocesan Pastoral Response Hotline. A report to the Archdiocese does not relieve the individual of the duty to report child abuse to civil authorities as required by Oklahoma State Law. In Oklahoma, failure to report child abuse is a misdemeanor punishable by law.

Anuncio de la Arquidiócesis de OKC Abuso de Menores y Adultos Vulnerables

La Arquidiócesis de Oklahoma City a través de sus programas, organizaciones y eventos, tiene numerosos contactos diarios con muchos menores y adultos vulnerables. Por lo tanto, es importante que todo el personal de la Arquidiócesis, el clero, los seminaristas, los religiosos, los empleados y los voluntarios, protejan los derechos de los niños y adultos vulnerables y estén alertas a la posibilidad de abuso infantil y abuso de adultos vulnerables.

Bajo la ley del Estado de Oklahoma, todas las personas DEBEN reportar un incidente o sospecha de abuso sexual de un menor (persona menor de 18 años) a las autoridades civiles de inmediato. El Departamento de Servicios Humanos de Oklahoma ha establecido una línea directa de abuso en todo el estado para informar: 1-800-522-3511. Este número está disponible las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana. Si tiene razones para creer que un niño está en peligro inmediato de daño, llame al 911.

Para obtener información sobre la seguridad de los niños y adultos vulnerables y la curación de las víctimas, la Arquidiócesis de la Ciudad de Oklahoma ofrece una línea directa para reportar Abuso de Menores y Adultos Vulnerables (ya sea en el pasado o en la actualidad) por un miembro del clero u otro personal de la iglesia: 1-405-720-9878. El Coordinador de Asistencia a las Víctimas de la Arquidiócesis, un consejero profesional con licencia responderá a las llamadas a la línea directa de Respuesta Pastoral Arquidiocesana. Un informe a la Arquidiócesis no exime a la persona del deber de denunciar el abuso infantil a las autoridades civiles como lo exige la Ley del Estado de Oklahoma. En Oklahoma, el hecho de no denunciar el abuso infantil es un delito menor castigado por la ley.

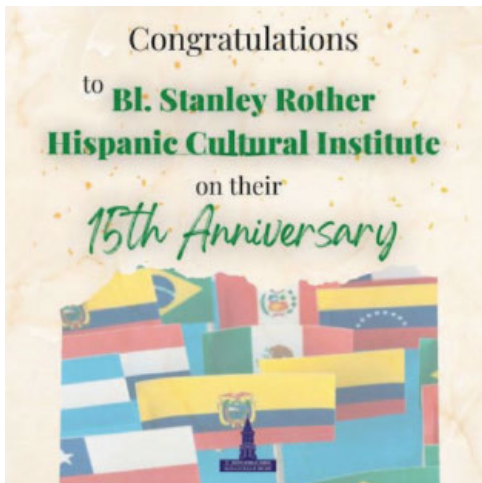

Lighting the Way

Within the Catholic Church in the United States, we can hear some hopeful responses. As a Church, we are embarking on a synodal journey at the invitation of the Holy Father, which is centered on cultivating a "Church which listens... in which everyone has something to learn." The initial fruits are already a great blessing. Among the preliminary results, one voice that emerges, especially among the youth, is a need for the Church to care for creation.

Recently the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops updated its socially responsible investment guidelines, and the section with the largest revisions was on "Saving our global common

home," introducing five different categories for responsible investment, including climate change, biodiversity, water and natural resources, technology and environmental impact. ... Numerous U.S. Catholic institutions, religious orders, dioceses, parishes, communities, families, and individuals are responding to the invitation of Laudato Si'.

Amidst our country's political divisions, there are liberal and conservative lawmakers who share concerns about both the world's climate and the welfare of our nation. They are doing the hard work of considering bi-partisan policies that can preserve the environment, promote energy

security, and grow the economy.

We pray that now, and in the future, both parties will continue to put forward their best environmental policies and work together to protect our "common home which God has entrusted to us."


While these actions give us hope, we are also aware that they are far from sufficient to meet the challenges of our times. The safeguard against complacency and hubris is a listening faith, always aware of God's action preceding and increasing our own efforts. This Season of Creation, we give thanks to the professionals and everyday citizens who work to protect the environment and promote the common good.

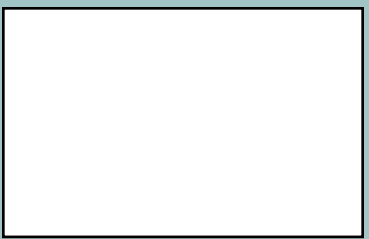

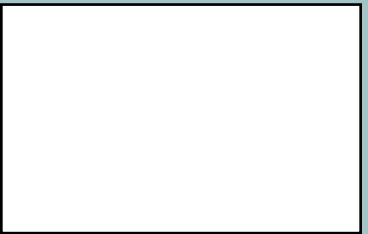
