

PASTORAL REFLECTION



WELCOMING JESUS AND MARY IN OUR LIVES (JN. 2:1-11)

All weddings must be beautiful, meaningful and memorable. This is because it is really a solemn moment between TWO PEOPLE IN LOVE. It is their solemn moment with God. That is why MARRIAGE IS A SACRAMENT, and a sacred sign that bestows Sanctifying Grace. Both the New and the Old Testaments use the picture of a wedding banquet to portray the joy of the Kingdom of God.

For us, Catholic Christians it pays to cast a new look at the Sacrament of Marriage. Today, people hastily enter into it. Some enter into it without the sacrament. Some no longer believe it is necessary to get married, they just live in sin together because of love especially in America and many other countries. And this is a sad situation that many Christians experience in their relationship.

This Sunday's Gospel beautifully shows that the Wedding at Cana was so blessed because Jesus was invited there. Because of his Presence, grace filled the occasion. Grace filled the lives of the couple and all the people. WINE, a symbol of the joy that comes from God, flowed freely even after it already ran out. This happened because Jesus — together with his disciples — were invited to take part in the celebration.

This is a serious invitation to people who love each other and are contemplating marriage. This is also a daily challenge to couples who are already married and want to sustain the love relationship they have for each other. Let us then always invite Jesus to be part of all our relationships so that He can work out his miracles of love and his power to give joy, in spite of the challenges.

There was another presence, though subtle, that was not mentioned in the wedding. MARY, the mother of Jesus, was also there. She too, was invited. As Catholic Christians, we express our attachment to Mary because she is a constant and faithful companion who leads us to Jesus and obtain for us graces. Let us now confidently invite Jesus and Mary to journey with us in our everyday lives. JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH GUIDE, PROTECT AND SAVE US ALWAYS! AMEN!

#111. A STORY OF A POWERFUL GUEST AT HOME. Some time ago a woman wrote a fascinating article about redecorating her family's home. Things went well until her husband overruled the interior decoration and hung a 16-by 20- inch picture of Jesus in the most prominent place in the home.

Fabian, Pope and Martyr and Sebastian, Martyr and patron of archers, soldiers and associations. On the 21st, we have the feast of St. Agnes, Virgin and Martyr. 



- Married Godparents need Marriage & Confirmation Certificates from the Catholic Church.
- · Parents and sponsor must attend a Baptism Preparation class at the parish.
- St. Joseph offers a Baptism Preparation Class for Parents and Godparents every 3rd Saturday of each month from 9:00 AM – 12:00 Noon in classroom #4.
- · Baptism can be scheduled every Saturday; there are no baptisms during Lent and Holy Week.
- Parents and/or Godparents may give a donation to the Deacon or Priest who is officiating the Sacrament.
- Detailed policies and guidelines are discussed at the class. To register or for more information, please call the parish office at (602) 996-5120.




