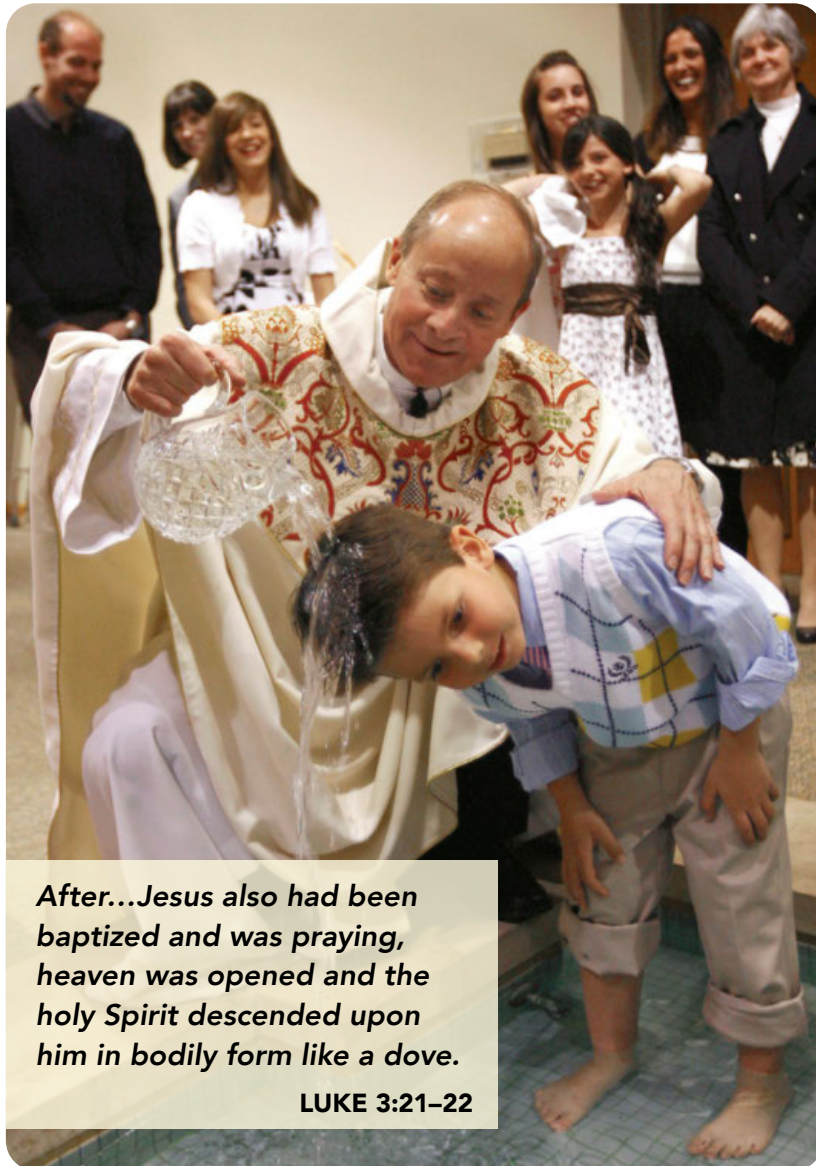

Taking Up Christ's Ministry

Before the Second Vatican Council, *ministry* was considered by many to be a Protestant word, and the religious leader who did it was called a *minister*. Catholics had priests and bishops who received and administered sacraments. Religious women did the Church's work in schools and hospitals. The council turned our understanding of Church membership inside out. We've come to realize that with baptism—not ordination or religious profession—comes the responsibility of ministry. Catholics and Protestants alike understand their commitment to justice and peace is a genuine ministry that seeks to establish God's reign in our world.

Many interpreters believe that the account of Jesus' baptism points to the inauguration of his own ministry. The theology expressed is certainly Trinitarian (the voice, Jesus identified as Son, and the dove). However, the revelation of his true identity occurs as he begins preaching and healing. Some say his baptism was meant to strengthen him as he began his public life. Others believe it was meant to strengthen his disciples.

Today we maintain that by baptism we are all children of God. Vatican II has enlightened us as to what this really means. Pope Francis has reminded us that by virtue of our baptism we are missionary disciples (see *Evangelii Gaudium*, 120). In other words, as disciples we follow Jesus, learning from him. As missionaries we go out to spread his Good News to others. It is now for us to take up the ministry where he left off, to be faithful servants with whom God is well pleased.

Dear Padre,

Why did Jesus have to be baptized? Did he have original sin like us or was there another reason to be baptized?

Jesus is God and did not have original sin like us. He is like us in all things except sin. The baptisms John performed did not free people from their original sin. The people who came to John to be baptized were declaring



that they were going to change their ways and reform their lives. They promised to turn away from sin and follow the commandments. The baptism of Jesus was different. When Jesus was baptized, God revealed who Jesus is and commissioned him to begin his mission on earth.

There were three significant components to Jesus' baptism. First, the skies opened above

Jesus. The prophet Isaiah prayed that God would tear open the sky and come down to earth (Isaiah 63). This was a sign to the people that God was coming down to earth. A new era was beginning. God was no longer "locked up" in the heavens.

Second, the Spirit of God, in the form of a dove, descended from the sky and hovered over Jesus and the water. This takes us back to the first moments of creation when the spirit of God hovered over the waters. The Spirit was a sign to the people that a new creation was being made.

Finally, a voice declared that Jesus is the Son of God. Jesus is the new Adam, who will begin the new creation. Let us call the Holy Spirit to be within our hearts and send us forth, as Jesus was sent, to proclaim a new creation founded on the love and peace of our Savior.

Asumir el ministerio de Cristo

Antes del Concilio Vaticano II, el *ministerio* era considerado por muchos como una palabra protestante, y el líder religioso que lo hacía era llamado *ministro*. Los católicos tenían sacerdotes y obispos que recibían y administraban los sacramentos. Las religiosas hacían el trabajo de la Iglesia en escuelas y hospitales. El Concilio dio un vuelco a nuestra concepción de la pertenencia a la Iglesia. Nos hemos dado cuenta de que con el bautismo —no con la ordenación o la profesión religiosa— viene la responsabilidad del ministerio. Tanto los católicos como los protestantes entienden que su compromiso con la justicia y la paz es un auténtico ministerio que busca establecer el Reino de Dios en nuestro mundo.

Muchos intérpretes creen que el relato del bautismo de Jesús apunta a la inauguración de su propio ministerio. La teología expresada es ciertamente trinitaria (la voz, Jesús identificado como Hijo y la paloma). Sin embargo, la revelación de su verdadera identidad se produce cuando comienza a predicar y curar. Algunos dicen que su bautismo estaba destinado a fortalecerlo al comenzar su vida pública. Otros creen que fue para fortalecer a sus discípulos.

Hoy sostenemos que por el bautismo todos somos hijos de Dios. El Vaticano II nos ha iluminado sobre lo que esto significa realmente. El Papa Francisco nos ha recordado que, en virtud de nuestro bautismo, somos discípulos misioneros (véase *Evangelii Gaudium*, 120). En otras palabras, como discípulos seguimos a Jesús, aprendiendo de Él. Como misioneros salimos a difundir su Buena Noticia a los demás. Ahora nos toca a nosotros retomar el ministerio donde Él lo dejó, para ser siervos fieles de los que Dios se complace.

- ✦ **Sal de tu camino para hacer la vida de alguien un poco mejor esta semana.**

Querido Padre,

¿Por qué tuvo que ser bautizado Jesús? ¿Tenía pecado original como nosotros o había otra razón para ser bautizado?

Jesús es Dios y no tuvo pecado original como nosotros. Es como nosotros en todo, excepto en el pecado. Los bautismos que Juan realizaba no liberaban a las personas de su pecado original. Las personas que venían



a Juan para ser bautizadas declaraban que iban a cambiar sus costumbres y reformar sus vidas. Prometían alejarse del pecado y seguir los mandamientos. El bautismo de Jesús fue diferente. Cuando Jesús fue bautizado, Dios reveló quién es Jesús y le encargó que comenzara su misión en la tierra.

El bautismo de Jesús tuvo tres componentes significativos.

Primero, los cielos se abrieron sobre Jesús. El profeta Isaías oró para que Dios abriera el cielo y bajara a la tierra (Isaías 63). Esto fue una señal para el pueblo de que Dios bajaba a la tierra. Comenzaba una nueva era. Dios ya no estaba “encerrado” en los cielos.

En segundo lugar, el Espíritu de Dios, en forma de paloma, desciende del cielo y se posa sobre Jesús y el agua. Esto nos remite a los primeros momentos de la creación, cuando el espíritu de Dios se cernía sobre las aguas. El Espíritu era una señal para el pueblo de que se estaba realizando una nueva creación.

Finalmente, una voz declaró que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios. Jesús es el nuevo Adán, que iniciará la nueva creación. Llamemos al Espíritu Santo para que esté en nuestros corazones y nos envíe, como fue enviado Jesús, a proclamar una nueva creación fundada en el amor y la paz de nuestro Salvador.


