From the Pastor's Desk

***Congratulations to the children who received First Reconciliation** Saturday, March 6 at a special 11:00 am service. I would like to thank the six priests who assisted with confessions. Special thanks to the Sacramental Preparation team—Laura Balderrama Contreras, Angela Spino, Sheila Dillard and all the catechists.

*Today at the 9:00 am Mass, we are finally honoring our **outgoing Pastoral Council members** who completed their term of office on December 31st. They are being presented a statue of St. Peter as a small sign of our appreciation. These members include: **Bill Strain, chairperson, Ed Hoepfner, Vicki Harris, Molly Birkett and Brett Haas.** Thanks again for your service.

*Last Sunday at all Masses we finally beat the weather and other challenges to finally have our **In-Pew Sunday for the Archbishop's Annual Appeal for Ministries.** All registered families of the parish should have already received a mailing from the Archbishop inviting you to participate by making a one-time donation or a pledge to be fulfilled in 10 months. Our goal at St. Peter's Parish is to increase parishioner participation to 25% of total registered families. We need your participation to accomplish this. Please note that two bulletins were given out that day due to late deliveries: One for February 21st which had an Appeal brochure and donation envelope attached inside and one for the day, February 28th, that arrived immediately before weekend Masses began.

*An important part of our Lenten journey is to **celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession).** We make one available every Lent as a communal experience with 14 to 15 priests present to hear your confession without waiting for too long. Please mark your calendars to participate on **Tuesday, March 9th starting at 7:00 pm.** Please come spiritually prepared to experience God's incredible love, mercy and forgiveness. Fr. Norman has already been going from parish to parish of our Deanery helping pastors in Bandera, Comfort, Fredericksburg, and Kerrville with their Reconciliation Services.

***There is a critical shortage of blood in our communities.** St. Peter's Parish is sponsoring its **Lenten Blood Drive on Saturday and Sunday, March 20th and 21st.** Please see the blood drive ad for details on how to sign up. All safety protocols will be honored for your health and welfare. Thanks for helping save lives through your donations. Donating blood might be a work of charity for the Lenten season!

*On Friday, February 26th, St. Peter's Parish hosted a **second mass vaccination event.** There were a total of approximately 550 injections given to citizens as their first of two injections. In the first mass vaccination event here, approximately 600 injections were administered. I want to thank all of our parishioners who volunteered to help for this event serving as stewards of hospitality, answering questions and giving directions, serving refreshments, driving golf carts to assist those needing a lift to and from the parking lot, etc. Special thanks to Jesse Martinez, Doreann Sommers and Rick Martini who attend to all the details of collaborating with City of Boerne and Kendall County officials to arrange these events. This is a small way in which our parish is helping immunize our community and preserve the health of our city and county residents.

*On Sunday, February 21st, Life Teen sponsored another **XLT Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** for the Life Teen Community and other parishioners. Thanks to Lacey Sorrell, Deacon Mike and all the Life Teen members who helped organize and serve for it, and to Hannah Reich, the exceptional guest speaker. I encourage more parishioners to attend these spiritual experiences to witness the faith of our youth and to grow in your love for the Eucharist and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

*I am happy to announce that **Nancy Boerner** has accepted an invitation to serve as our new parish **Librarian.** She has already been tidying-up and sorting through books that have been donated. Previously, Eleanor Moring served as the Librarian for the **Elizabeth Ann Dashiell Library** and

Darcy Maciolek was the staff coordinator. Thanks to Nancy for being so willing to continue her service building-up our community. This is a reminder to all of our parishioners that we have this parish library as a great Catholic reading and research resource for you. Please take advantage of it. There is also a children's books section for parents to use. You can check-out and return books on an "honor" system. Read instructions in Library. Nancy will be available on Mondays and Wednesdays for a few hours on an experimental basis until the best times can be determined.

*Many of our parishioners do extraordinary things in and for our parish. Many also do extraordinary things in the larger Boerne Community. For example, **Wendy Ludwig Sangdahl** was recognized as the Cpt. Mark T. Voss Middle School's **2020-21 Teacher of the Year**. Wendy was acknowledged for going to work daily inspiring, supporting and lifting-up everyone that she encounters. She's a teacher who goes above and beyond the call of duty, engaging and transforming her students by using the latest digital tools. She is incredibly collaborative inviting others to participate in her projects. Her servant's heart leads her to help those in need in many ways. She also sponsors the National Junior Honor Society and has led them in several service initiatives. Dr. Price presented the award to Wendy with her daughter, Caitlin, present after driving from A&M to be there. Congratulations, Wendy! You make us proud!

*Our new Director of **Music & Liturgy, Adam Olmos**, has been given permission to increase the number of musicians/singers per Mass to 4 or 5 people. This is in keeping with more recent developments and practices in the Archdiocese. We trust this will help to improve our worship experience after almost a year of severe restrictions on musicians, wind instruments and choir singing to prevent the spread of the Covid-19.

*Our parish will make attendance of the **Archdiocesan Youth Spectacular 2021: "Walking in the Way of Love" possible for the youth**. Over the years this has been a very popular spiritual event in which youth can meet each other across parish boundaries and grow spiritually together. **Lacey Sorrell** will help organize this event. Parents, please encourage your youth to participate. It will take place on Saturday, March 20, 2021 from 9:00 am until 11:30 am as a free online experience. See a more complete ad in another spot in this bulletin.

*Thanks to **Mary Jo Perley and the Faithful Quilters** of our parish who sewed and stuffed hand size red velvet hearts with decorations to be given to medical personnel who work directly with Covid-19 patients. This small gift will be presented to keep in their pockets as a reminder of the community's tremendous appreciation for their dedicated and tireless work, putting their own lives at risk, to compassionately serve and heal those suffering from the virus.

*Many of you enjoy the **Little Gretel Restaurant and Chef Denise Mazal**. I feel an instant connection with her due to our common Czech heritage. Chef Denise wanted to honor her Czech heritage and celebrate her country of origin. Her vision led her to honor the Czech author and playwright, Karel Capek, who never reached any due notoriety for his creativity and intelligence. She had the sculpture designed by the Czech artist, Peter Vrana, who is based in Berlin. She had the aluminum piece fabricated here in Boerne and installed it on the corner of

their restaurant property at 512 River Road. Fr. Norman led a prayer and blessing for the sculpture's introduction to the City of Boerne last Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm. Please take special note of it as you walk or drive by. This is a unique artistic gift to Boerne. You can learn more about Mr. Chapek by researching online.

*St. Peter's Parish received a letter from **Connie M. Klein**, Executive Director, of the **Hill Country Mission for Health** thanking parishioners for the yearly monetary donations made for their valiant efforts. Their mission as a not-for-profit organization, is to provide healthcare for eligible, uninsured/under-insured, low-income residents in Kendall County. Thanks for your generosity that makes our donations to this worthy organization possible.

*St. Peter's Parish also makes monthly donations to the **Hill Country Family Services** and receives regular thank yous from their leadership. We recently also received a 2020 Impact Report for service to Kendall County families in crisis. This agency receives cash and food donations, distributes that food, provides financial assistance to help with mortgage, rent and utilities, and hands out toiletry hygiene bags for children. This agency raised \$59,735 from local church communities for housing assistance and had 3,102 volunteer hours donated to serve the community in 2020.

*Last week we joined a national tribute to remember and honor the **500,000 people of our country who have died due to Covid-19** by flying the church flags at half-staff. All of us know that parishioners and Boerne citizens contracted the virus, some have suffered incredibly and been hospitalized, and others have died of it. Please pray with and for those who have lost their lives and their families who suffer their loss.

RCIA



Today at the 9:00 am Mass, our RCIA Catechumens will celebrate the "First Scrutiny" in preparation for full initiation into the Church at the Easter Vigil. The next two weekends, March 14th and March 21st, they will celebrate the "Second and Third Scrutiny."

The scrutinies are among the most ancient prayers in the Christian liturgical tradition. As early as the second century, Christian communities would help those who had been chosen for Baptism to prepare for their initiation by laying on hands and by prayers for protection and deliverance from evil. At the beginning of the third century, Hippolytus told the Christians at Rome to celebrate these rites with catechumens on a daily basis during the final stages of preparation for Baptism.

Today we continue to celebrate these powerful rituals, convinced that those about to enter into a covenant with God in Christ stand in need of our prayers for deliverance and protection. We also understand today that our prayers for protection from evil are not limited to those formally engaged in the catechumenal process. Just as our entire community is called to journey with the catechumens throughout the Lenten season, we recognize the need we all share for freedom from evil and its effects. That is why during the Masses that we celebrate the scrutinies we will use the Lectionary's "scrutiny readings" from Year A. During the week before the scrutiny is celebrated, those seeking Baptism will gather to listen to the gospel proclaimed and will name the evil from which we must seek God's deliverance and protection. We urge you to prepare for the celebration of the scrutinies in a personal way by discerning what it is in your own life that needs to be freed from sin's bondage. Join in spirit with all in our community who turn to Jesus for freedom from sin and protection from all evil.



Why Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual Direction is setting aside time to explore the actions of God in your life. During hard times and good times, we need to see where God is in our lives. The more we see Him in our everyday lives, the better we grow in our relationship with Him.

When we see a Spiritual Director, it is one Christian to another Christian, sharing personal experiences about God in our lives. We discern what God is saying to us, what He wants us to do. We start with a prayer and ask the Holy Spirit to be with us. The Holy Spirit is present, and He guides us as we speak. He is the one in charge. He is the true Spiritual Director.

A Spiritual Director listens with sacred presence and attends to the entire person. A Spiritual Director offers a gentle, confidential and nonjudgmental place of welcome.

Here at St. Peter's Parish, we have six Spiritual Directors who meet with people by phone, Zoom or in person. We are using the COVID-19 precautions. We want anyone who comes to us to feel comfortable. Our directors are Bonnie Caruso, Maryann Hawn, Hector Lopez, Deacon Ken Nickels, Dorene Oesterreicher and Kelly Ward. We will also be welcoming three new directors who finish their three years of formation in June 2021—Brian Hammer, Leroy Ferry and Elizabeth Nolen.

FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION AND E-FILING

—A COMMUNITY SERVICE FOR 30 YEARS—

Your **FREE**, volunteer-staffed community service is again available in Boerne, Kendall County, and surrounding areas. We prepare and e-file individual income tax returns at the Boerne Library and this includes **FREE** electronic filing. **There are no income or age restrictions.** Due to COVID and Tax-Aide restrictions, returns will only be done at the Boerne Library in 2021. Tax returns will be prepared by **appointment only** from February 16th through April 14th at the Boerne Library, 451 N Main St. every Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday 10:00 am-6:00 pm - except for Monday, Feb. 15th, President's Day, when the Library is closed. Face masks and temperature checks are required on Library entry. Spanish language tax assistance is available on Mondays.

Returns are by **appointment only** and Taxpayers must come to the Library to make their appointment and pick up several required forms. You can contact the Library during their normal hours at (830) 249-3053 to make an appointment but must **STILL** pick up several documents at the Library and fill them out **BEFORE** your appointment.

We can assist with tax questions and complete the most commonly used tax forms. Taxpayers must bring a copy of last year's tax return, photo ID, and Social Security card for each person on the return. Volunteers preparing tax returns are not IRS employees, but are trained and certified by the IRS.

Free Tax Preparation

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program provides free tax preparation for individuals who earn up to \$55,000 annually, providing immediate cash to supplement living expenses, pay debt, or save money.



You are eligible for tax preparation assistance from VITA if you earn up to \$55,000 a year. If filing your taxes jointly, your spouse must be present at the time of dropoff.



The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based religious formation for 3-12 year olds. It seeks to create and

facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space called an atrium, in which both the children and the catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate.

Silence During Lent

We know that silence is necessary to prepare ourselves to encounter God. It is in silence that the religious or spiritual sense of the child may be developed. Silence leads the child to a relationship with him or herself, through the listening of his or her own breathing. As children become conscious of their inner silence, they realize that this allows them to be able to listen to and answer God. Silence is a great help for the child's prayer life. At home, you may want to practice quiet time at the prayer table. Silence is necessary for prayer.

- Create a card for your family prayer table with the words, "Be Still."
- At home, invite your child to sit comfortably at the prayer table, with his or her body still, and eyes closed. Depending upon the age of the child, allow for a few minutes (or more) of silence. Discuss what was heard.
- Do you practice/model silence in your prayer life?




