She was part of our first Teen Leadership Council and recently ministered to teens as a Life Teen Missionary in the extended Life Teen summer program. Melissa brings a strong spiritual energy, a deep passion for evangelizing and forming young people in their faith and devotion to building strong, meaningful relationships with youth and their families. She also brings valuable bilingual skills to our youth program leadership. We look forward to her creating engaging, faith-centered experiences that draw our young people closer to Christ and the life of the Church. Please join the staff in welcoming Melissa to the team!

***We received a very large thank you card from the Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center,** thanking us for providing the venue for their annual Gala on September 17, 2024. ***On Monday, November 4th, 2024, the "Come to the Table" Ministry celebrated its 2nd anniversary** as a ministry here at St. Peter's Parish. Members and sponsor families began the celebration with a Rosary at 6:00 pm, followed by Daily Mass at 6:30, at which they received a blessing from Fr. Norm. After Mass, they proceeded to their party in the Cana Ballroom.

Thank you to all our wonderful volunteers. Special thanks to Wayne & Mary Stapper, who brought this ministry to our parish and have served as the leads these past two years. Congratulations and blessings to you all! In partnership with Hill Country Daily Bread Ministries, "Come to the Table" family mentoring helps those in need in our local community through one-on-one mentoring, spiritual support and provision of food, clothing, diapers and basic resources. ***Our governing, planning and formation committees continue to meet on a regular basis** to plan upcoming events, make sure our parish is on track with its many goals, ensure transparency and accountability to our parishioners and donors, and ensure that we continue to execute our mission. The **Finance Council** met on Tuesday, October 29, the **Teen Leadership Council** met on November 3, and the **Liturgy Committee** met on Wednesday, November 6. Our **Pastoral Council's** monthly meeting is Saturday, November 9th. Thank you to all the committee members for all your hard work.

***Approximately 15 to 20 youth attend the Friday 6:15 am Daily Mass.** Some of you may remember that pre-Covid, teens would meet once a week at a 6:15 am Daily Mass and all go out to breakfast afterward, before heading to school. The teens usually go to Mary's Tacos for breakfast and social interaction. What a wonderful and spiritual way to begin the day!

***On Sunday, November 3 at the 9:00 am and 1:00 pm Masses, Fr. David led our celebration of the Rite of Welcome** for those adults and children who were baptized in another Christian faith tradition and wish to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church. The celebration of this rite also included adults and children who were baptized Catholic and are now preparing to receive the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. We welcome the 38 adults and children who will continue their formation in RCIA and their journey towards the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Please keep all our catechumens and candidates in your prayers.

***RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is in full swing. Inquiry period began on April 21 and on October 20 we moved into the Catechumenate phase. We celebrated the Rite of Acceptance on October 6 for those seeking the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation (Catechumens). On November 3 we celebrated the Rite of Welcome for those baptized in another Christian faith tradition and who are wanting to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church as well as those who were baptized Catholic but need to complete their Sacraments of Initiation (Candidates). We also have adults who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please continue to pray for the 22 Catechumens, 39 Candidates, and 12 Confirmandi as they continue the journey through RCIA to receive their sacraments.

AMEMONOS DE CORAZÓN

El Papa León XIII enseñó que la caridad de Cristo «nos incita a devolverle amor por amor».

Necesitamos volver a la Palabra de Dios para reconocer que la mejor respuesta al amor de su Corazón es el amor a los hermanos, no hay mayor gesto que

podamos ofrecerle para devolver amor por amor. La Palabra de Dios lo dice con total claridad:

- «Les aseguro que cada vez que lo hicieron con el más pequeño de mis hermanos, lo hicieron conmigo» (Mt 25,40).
- «Toda la Ley está resumida plenamente en este precepto: Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo» (Ga 5,14).
- «Un mandamiento nuevo les doy: Que se amen unos a otros; como yo los he amado, que también se amen los unos a los otros» (Jn 13,34)
- «Nosotros sabemos que hemos pasado de la muerte a la Vida, porque amamos a nuestros hermanos. El que no ama permanece en la muerte» (1 Jn 3,14).
- «Queridos míos, amémonos unos a otros, porque el amor viene de Dios. Todo el que ama ha nacido de Dios y conoce a Dios» (1 Jn 4,7)
- «¿Cómo puede amar a Dios, a quien no ve, el que no ama a su hermano, a quien ve?» (1 Jn 4,20).

El amor a los hermanos no se fabrica, no es resultado de nuestro esfuerzo natural, sino que requiere una transformación de nuestro corazón egoísta. Entonces nace de una forma espontánea la célebre súplica: «Jesús, haz nuestro corazón semejante al tuyo». Por esta misma razón, la invitación de san Pablo no era: «esfuércense por hacer obras buenas». Su invitación era más precisamente: «Tengan entre ustedes los mismos sentimientos de Cristo Jesús» (Flp 2,5).

San Agustín nos dice: «Ama y haz lo que quieras. Si callas, callarás con amor; si gritas, gritarás con amor; si corriges, corregirás con amor; si perdonas, perdonarás con amor. Si tienes el amor arraigado en ti, ninguna otra cosa sino amor serán tus frutos».

Cuando San Pablo habla del amor, afirma indudablemente que, «ahora existen tres cosas: la fe, la esperanza y el amor, pero la más grande todas es el amor». (1 Co 12,13)

Si el centro de tu vida es Dios, entonces el centro de tu vida, familia, emociones, sentimientos, actividades, pensamientos debe ser el amor porque «Dios es amor» (1 Jn 4,8)

Por último, Madre Teresa de Calcuta nos enseña que:

- «Darle a alguien todo tu amor nunca es seguro de que te amarán de regreso, pero no esperes que te amen de regreso; solo espera que el amor crezca en el corazón de la otra persona, pero si no crece, sé feliz porque creció en el tuyo. Hay cosas que te encantaría oír, que nunca escucharás de la persona que te gustaría que te las dijera, pero no seas tan sordo para no oírlas de aquel que las dice desde su corazón».
- «El amor, para que sea auténtico, debe costarnos».
- «Ama hasta que te duela. Si te duele es buena señal».

Finally, one innkeeper tells them they can stay in the stable. The doors are open to all at this final house, the Rosary is prayed and a big party begins!

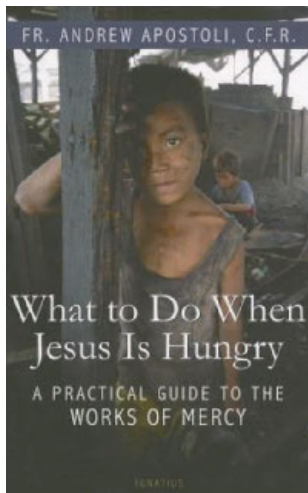

Gospel Meditation

Once at an evening Mass as a poor college student, the collection basket was fast approaching, and I only had a ten-dollar bill. I was planning on using that to buy my favorite Chipotle burrito that night for dinner. Should I keep the money? Who would know if I did? If I gave it away, what would I eat? Would I be okay? I kissed my future burrito goodbye, dropped the money in the basket, and winced. But strangely, the rest of the Mass I felt more engaged than usual. I had skin in the game. I left the Mass excited to see how God would take care of me. And he did, in amazing ways.

When the poor widow places two copper coins in the temple treasury, Jesus doesn't pity her. He praises her. He blesses her. He brags about her. He celebrates her as the temple's largest benefactor. Her giving is an act of radical, concrete trust in God. It is as if she is entering a new level of giving that excites Jesus, because she contributes not out of her abundance, but she gives "everything she had."

What a challenge this is to each one of us! How easy it is to ignore this! But imagine the eruption of the energy of faith, hope, and love that would be unlocked if our financial sacrifices to the Church actually tapped into daily bread and not only our disposable income. I challenge us to try this in some way this coming week and see what happens in our hearts. Even if it costs us a burrito. — Father John Muir ©LPi

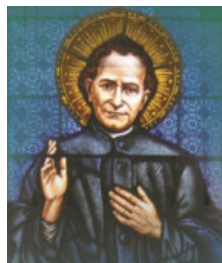
The history of Catholic Education shows the amazing work by many **Saints in the Church and our Families** who wanted children to know and love God and to form them to be good citizens of the world. Some of these Saints include:



Thomas Aquinas (d. 1274) -- Most influential philosopher and theologian in the scholastic tradition. Doctor of the church, and author of "Summa Theologica."



The **first** Catholic School in America opened in Philadelphia in 1783, and in 1809, **St. Elizabeth Ann Seton** moved to Emmittsburg, Maryland to begin a school for girls named Saint Joseph's Academy and Free School and thus started the **largest parochial school system in the world**.



St. John Bosco (d. 1888), patron of schoolchildren, students, schools, colleges, and universities, founded the Salesian Brothers Religious Order in 19th century Turin to teach urban children of the Industrial revolution.

Some of the Saints and Family Members sacrificed for the Catholic education of our children and maybe our own education.
