



A Letter from Our Pastor

We tend to be a very skeptical and doubtful culture. Many people believe only what they can see and touch. Many do not trust their government, their neighbors, or even that God loves them. There is only one way to overcome doubt. And that is through faith. In spiritual matters, no one can give you faith except God. Others can lead you there, others can show you how to nurture it, still others can point you in the right direction, but inevitably you have to believe through God's grace and your own free will. You have to make that conscious leap from doubt to faith.

Remember the words of Jesus to the Apostles at the Last Supper, *What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will understand later.* Many people want answers, but no answer will satisfy them. What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will understand later. We have got to keep those words in mind as we stumble through life carrying our own crosses. We understand very little, even though we think we know so much.

Most of us, at different times in our lives, are not unlike the Apostle Thomas—and that is not necessarily a negative thing. But, if we remain in doubt, and not search for the truth, we cannot grow in our faith. If we only believe those things that we can see or fully understand, we cannot begin to experience the glories of creation, or the mysteries of our faith. If we stay in that place of doubt, then Jesus can become for us someone who has no power in our lives. And our faith and hope wither.

In today's Gospel we see an example of God's mercy, as Jesus speaks gently to Thomas, acknowledging his doubt and helping to bolster his faith. Jesus was patient with Thomas. He met him where he was in his faith. He does the same for us and for all who struggle with doubts. This

Gospel also provides us with a model of how we are to help others come to understand the depths of God's mercy and love, and to turn to the Lord with trust.



We show others the way by our own lives of love and mercy. This is the witness of our faith, which is to help lead others to Christ. So many have judged others in the name of the Lord while forgetting that Jesus did not come to condemn people, but to save them. Listen to His teaching in another part of John's Gospel: *I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved. . . . I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly* (Jn 10:9-10). Jesus wants to save all of us, Christians, Muslims and Jews; politicians and priests; murderers, drug addicts, prisoners, the self-righteous, the rich and the poor, and of course, the doubters. So, let us rejoice and be glad, for God sent His beloved Son, Jesus, who offers all of us salvation through His Divine Mercy!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On the weekend of April 24 and 25, our Diocese will be taking up the national collection for the Catholic Home Missions and the Black and Indian Missions.

Our Catholic faith is one of beauty and hope, mercy and joy. But for too many people across the country, there are few opportunities to learn about and deepen that faith. Even the most basic programs are out of reach because of fragile financial situations, tough terrain, or small populations of Catholics. One does not need to go far to find mission territory: it is right here at home.

Nearly half of our country is considered home mission territory. This appeal strengthens the Catholic Church in the United States and its territories where resources are thin and priests are few. Proceeds are distributed as grants to dioceses supporting and strengthening evangelization programs which would otherwise be in danger of disappearing among the Black and American Indian communities.

Your support helps these mission dioceses form vibrant faith communities and strengthens the Church at home. Monies are used for a wide range of pastoral services including evangelization, religious education, and maintenance of mission parishes, the training of seminarians and lay ministers, and ministry with ethnic groups.

Please be generous, and prayerfully consider how you can support this collection.



APRIL Is Child Abuse Prevention Month

Every April, Catholic parishes and schools across the United States participate in National Child Abuse Prevention Month.



The Effects of ABUSE

When a child is abused, the effects are grave and can last a lifetime. Some of the most common effects of abuse include:

- Loss of faith and trust in God.
- Post-traumatic stress disorder, psychological distress, and other indirect signs of trauma, such as anxiety, trouble sleeping, chronic stomach pain, and headaches.
- A greater risk of developing behavioral problems, substance abuse, and suicide.

The sense of violation goes deep into a person's psyche and feelings of anger, shame, hurt, and betrayal can build long after the abuse has taken place.

Steps to Prevent ABUSE

Communicate with Your Children

It is extremely important to communicate openly with your children. Let them know that they can talk to you about anything that bothers them. This will help you identify warning signs and grooming behaviors perpetrated by offenders before they escalate to abuse.

Educate Yourself and Your Children on Abuse

Learning how to identify, prevent, and report abuse is key. Parents and guardians should empower their children to protect themselves from harm and to report abuse. Ask your diocesan safe environment coordinator or parish delegate about opportunities for safe environment training.

Identify and Report Warning Signs of Child Abusers

Grooming behaviors are the actions abusers take to project the image that they are kind, generous, caring people, while their intent is to lure a minor into an inappropriate relationship. Offenders can be patient and may groom their victim, his or her family, or community for years.

Some abusers isolate a potential victim by giving him or her undue attention or lavish gifts, while others allow young people to participate in activities which their parents or guardians would not approve, such as watching pornography, drinking alcohol, using drugs, and excessive touching, such as wrestling and tickling. Abusers also often try to isolate their victims from family or friends and encourage their victims to keep secrets from their parents or other caring adults.

Holding Offenders ACCOUNTABLE

To help hold offenders accountable, report all suspected abuse to local public authorities. You can also contact your local diocesan victim assistance coordinator to make a report and seek outreach for the abused.

In accordance with diocesan policy, when a single act of sexual abuse is admitted or established, the offender is to be removed permanently from ministry.


