

## A Letter from Our Pastor

The great Solemnity of Pentecost always reminds me that we are all called to put to use the gifts we have been given by God in order to build up the Church – the body of Christ.

There once was an elderly woman who had four grown sons. The woman lost her home to fire, so the sons thought it would be good to build their mother a new home. They encountered some trouble. The first son was a carpenter, but he didn't know anything about plumbing, masonry or electrical work. So he thought there was no way he could build his mother a home. Each of his brothers – an electrician, a plumber and a bricklayer – had similar thoughts. They didn't know anything about the other building trades, so thinking only as individuals, they each decided there was no way any of them could build a new home for their mother. So the house never got built.

Maybe our life as a Church is sometimes like that story of the mother and her sons. How often do we think that the Church could not possibly need or make use of our God-given talents? Sometimes, we might catch ourselves thinking that we can't lead a song or a prayer service or a parish meeting. Maybe we think we could never stand before a group of people and put a meaningful sentence together. Perhaps we think that the Church simply doesn't need us because we can't do anything spectacular. Maybe we feel we don't have any special talents to share with anyone, so why bother?

Let us consider for a moment the diversity of gifts that are necessary to bring to life a parish like our own. Our parish life is not just about those whose talents we see and hear at Mass each Sunday. It is also about those whose talents are

used “behind the scenes” so to speak – the folks who clean the church each week or the person whose focus in prayer encourages others to do the same. The volunteers who work in our religious formation programs by assembling a mailing, assisting with record keeping, preparing materials for each session – all contribute immeasurably. Preparing a dish to be shared at a hospitality event can bring comfort and healing, as can an open listening ear and a compassionate heart.



God continues to pour out the Holy Spirit to touch the lives of each of us. This feast of Pentecost is all about being able to see and to sense how God has touched each of us with gifts that are necessary for the life of the Church. Yes, some gifts are used more visibly, but all those God-given gifts are necessary.

Pentecost is about believing that the power of the Holy Spirit has been poured out upon each of us. Those gifts can be pooled and put to use humbly and selflessly. Pentecost is about building a house, together, that no one person can do alone. It is about building up the Church.

Hello to everyone at St. John Neumann Catholic Church!

My name is Michael Caster, and I'm a seminarian of the Diocese of Las Vegas. I am discerning—and preparing—for a call from God to help the Bishop of my home diocese spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ through Holy Orders, ordination to the Diocesan Priesthood.

Although I was born in San Diego, California, I've spent almost my entire life in Las Vegas. My family was Catholic, but I really began to grow in my faith when I got confirmed as a young adult. This was at the St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Newman Center, a Catholic Church, and community at UNLV. I was going to school there for Architecture, and then, later, Computer-Aided Drafting and Design at CSN. I surprisingly got a job working for the United States Postal Service as a City Carrier (mailman). I was also planning to get married; I was dating.

During this entire time, the idea of priesthood only grew louder in my thoughts and prayers. It was something that permeated my life and became a recurring theme. My heart kept burning for the needs of the Church while I grew in a relationship with God. Through much prayer, spiritual direction, daily Mass, Adoration, frequent confession, and continued learning of the faith through Catholic radio and podcasts, I decided to let go of everything to discern if God is calling me to the priesthood. I visited some

religious orders, but it was Las Vegas that stayed in my heart. Within a year, I decided to say "yes" to the idea of seminary. I spoke to Bishop Thomas to see if he would be willing to accept me and send me. He did, and now after three years of seminary, I have probably four more to go.



My home parish is Holy Spirit Catholic Church, where I stay during my breaks between seminary and assignments. Bishop Thomas has sent me for my summer assignment to St. John Neumann because he believes it would help me in my journey towards priesthood. I'm honored that Fr. Marc Howes has accepted me, and I look forward to helping the parish, learning a lot, and most of all getting to know all of you!



Please do not make any arrangements such as travel, catering, etc. until the Baptism preparation process is completed and you have received a letter confirming an available date and time for the Baptism.

## Sacrament of Marriage

Please call the Director of Pastoral Ministries, Leonarda Serna at 702-657-0200, ext. 211 or email [leonarda.serna@sjnc.org](mailto:leonarda.serna@sjnc.org) **before** considering any possible future marriage plans or dates. A **minimum** of six(6) to eight (8) months for sacramental formation and preparation is needed depending on individual circumstances. No other outside contracts or reservations should be made until an available date for the Sacrament of Marriage is confirmed in writing from the parish.
