A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

As Church, we have honored the countless learned and holy men and women - teachers of all generations and cultures who have dedicated their lives to the advancement not only of holy wisdom but of earthly knowledge. From the writer of Sirach in our first reading to Saint Paul the great evangelist and preacher, to modern theologians and catechists, they have shared their knowledge and wisdom and laid before us their insights and learning. There are even those among us who may have less formal scholarship and education, but lead lives and speak truths that advance the Gospel. They are all teachers of the faith who have helped us to mine and understand the mysteries of this world and the world to come. They have helped us to understand how God is present in our world, and in those great moments of life and death.

Knowledge, integrity and responsibility are necessary qualities for anyone who wishes to teach, or share, the faith. Jesus is scathing when these are absent; one is guilty of hypocrisy when one ignores serious matters and insists that others adhere to minor things. Likewise, if we all concentrate on removing the splinters in our own lives, we would have no time to judge and gossip about the faults and struggles of others. For Jesus, the ultimate success of an individual's efforts relies on the effect they have on the lives of others. The true teacher will produce good fruit; the uninformed, self-centered or misguided teacher will produce rotten fruit. The status of the fruit reveals the true nature of the tree.

The blind cannot lead the blind. Good produces good, and evil produces evil. As we heard in the first reading, so too does one's speech disclose the bent of one's mind. So let us always, as Saint Paul says, be firm, steadfast, always fully devoted to the work of the Lord. For the ways of the Lord are always and only good, and thus so shall be what we teach, preach and live as a result.

Let us nourish our hearts and bodies with the perfect gift from God in the body and blood of Jesus Christ.

May it give us the grace to be firm and steadfast as Paul encourages, and to bear good fruit for the world.

How do we obtain this training? Thankfully, we have an abundance of supernatural "training materials" at our disposal.

First and foremost, we can spend time with the Teacher, our Lord: we can study His life through reading the Scriptures, and we can listen and speak with Him in quiet, regular times of prayer. We can expand our faith knowledge through study of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. We can find healing and strength in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Amazingly, we can partake of His Body and Blood in the Eucharist.

The more intentionally and frequently we make use of these means, the more we will become like our Teacher and Lord. Then, all that we do and say (and tweet and post) will bring others closer to Him. This is the life's work of the Christian steward. It is privileged work indeed.

DANIEL LANG, a parishioner of SJN, who we introduced in our parish announcements this weekend, is about to embark on a mission. We will be following his journey through his blog and other correspondence while he is serving the Lord overseas. We are so honored to be able to have this young disciple as part of our parish family, and we hope you will be inspired by his faith-led process. Over the next few editions, we will be featuring excerpts from his introductory letter which helps explain the Missionary Society, their work and his involvement with them. From Daniel Lang-

"Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am Daniel, a Catholic lay missionary postulant with the St. Francis Xavier Lay Missionary Society. I hail from the Knights of Columbus University of Nevada Council #16207 and most recently have served as a trustee. I write to share with you the mission on which I am about to embark, to serve God's people in Asia. Please read this and share it. I hope that you keep me, our mission and the people we serve in your prayers.

At my time of writing, I've completed my formation training in San Francisco, the city of St. Francis, and prepare now in these two weeks back in Nevada to continue to ready my heart, mind, body and soul. But this is a calling that has come long and persistently. Ever since college, when I first traveled to my late mother's homeland—China—at church overseas, I've felt moved by the universality of Catholicism. I returned to China the following summer then traveled to Taiwan. With help from Maryknoll, I got to know Catholic Asian young adults and their needs. That January, I fundraised and participated in the World Youth Day pilgrimage, to Panamá. That summer, I became a Peace Corps Volunteer in Mongolia. Yet when the coronavirus pandemic began, we evacuated home.

I discerned into the St. Francis Xavier Lay Missionary Society after having spent the pandemic growing in faith, serving domestically and honing my Asian language skills. The Holy Spirit guided me to this Society, which, for the past decade, has been forming, sending and supporting lay missionaries to share the love of Jesus Christ in Asia. We focus on the Church's future, in nations where fewer than 10% of the population is Christian. We minister by evangelization, faith formation and social justice."

HE RITE OF ELECTION is the second step on the catechumens journey toward Baptism. The Church chooses those it deems ready for initiation and leads them into the more intense period of Lenten preparation.

Those chosen inscribe their names in the BOOK OF THE ELECT as a promise of faithfulness to the call they have received from Christ. At the Easter Vigil, they will be baptized, confirmed and receive Eucharist. Thus they will be fully initiated into the Body of Christ.

it is only fitting that we should be present at this celebration to welcome and support them.
