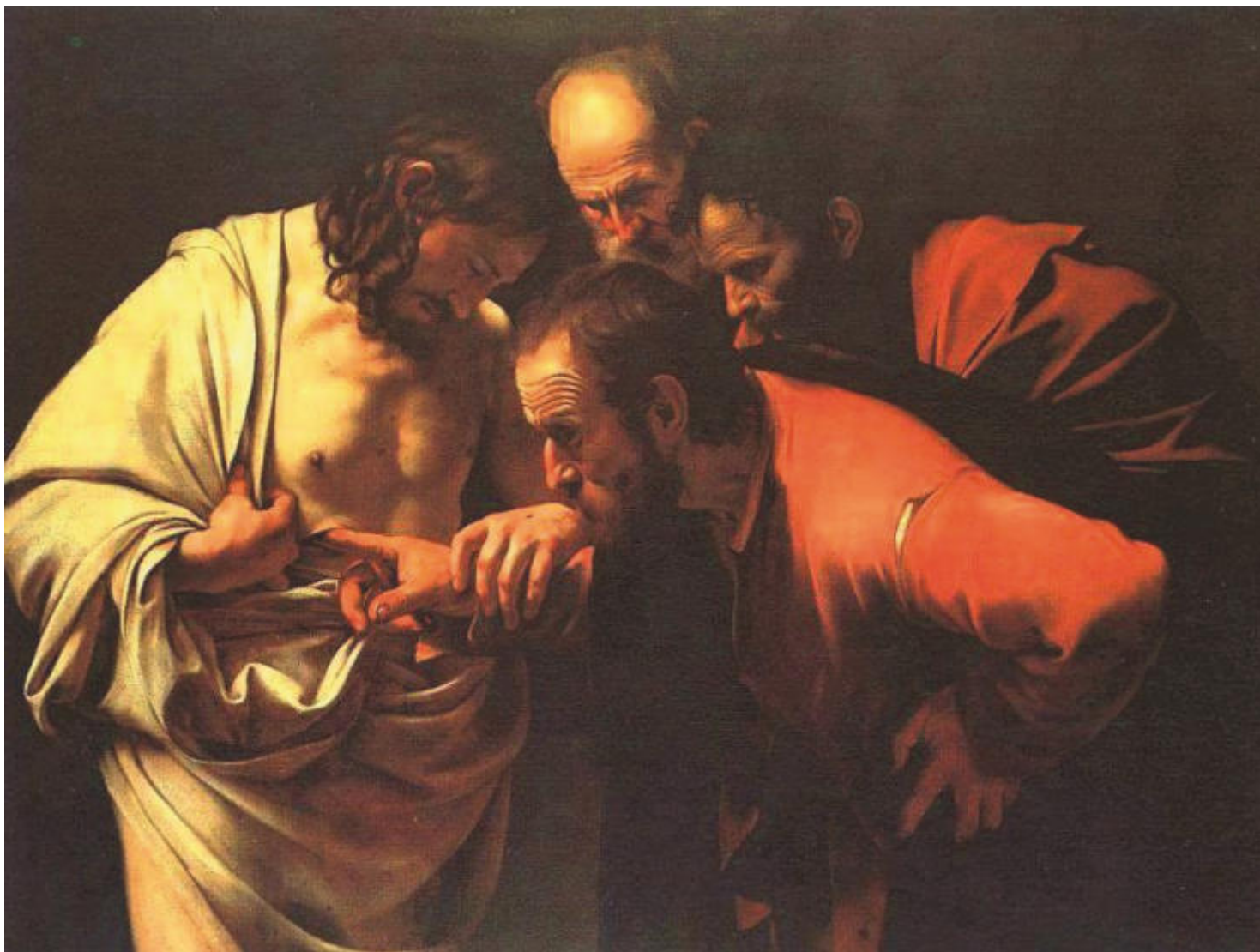

### From the Pastor's Desk:

Responding to call to anoint a parishioner who is seriously ill has been my priority during my ministry here at St. Joachim for the last ten years. Most of such visits to anoint a parishioner who is ill give immense pastoral fulfillment and satisfaction to me as

a Catholic priest. But I do admit that there have been a few times when I have felt so dejected and depressed, when I have to anoint a sick patient who is left to die all alone. On the contrary, when I have to anoint a dying parishioner surrounded by his loving family, it makes me feel so happy as I feel that the dying parishioner is not left to die all alone rather, he/she is made feel so much loved at his/her dying moment.

Recently I had one such wonderful experience. On March 20th, 2021 at 3.10 pm I got a call from Ms. Mary Ann De Los Angeles requesting me to come to Kaiser Hospital at San Leandro to anoint her husband. I told her that right now I am hearing confession which will be followed by the 4:30 pm vigil mass. I promised her that I would be coming to the hospital immediately after the mass. As I had promised her, at 6:00 pm I went to the hospital to anoint Mr. Edgar De Los Angeles. Mark, their youngest son came to the entrance and took me inside the hospital. Since only Ms. Mary Ann and Mark were inside the room, I enquired about the other children. Ms. Mary Ann told me that the Hospital administration allows only two family members to be inside the room. And then she pointed out through the window all her other children sitting inside the car which was parked opposite to the room where Edgar was admitted. They were all waiting inside the cars to participate in the ceremony of anointing through Zoom video call. I was so touched by the attitude of this wonderful and loving family. Even though they were not allowed inside the hospital, they were all looking at the room where Mr. Edgar was admitted and participating in the anointing ceremony through video call. It spoke very clearly how much the children loved their father.

On March 22nd Monday morning at 7:00 am, as I was getting ready to go for my daily morning walk, I got a call from Ms. Mary Ann De Los Angeles, calling me to come to the hospital to pray for her husband as he was at the verge of death. Immediately I rushed to the hospital. This morning the entire family stood around Mr. Edgar De Los Angeles. And we all prayed together for Edgar. And in the Afternoon, I was told that Mr. Edgar breathed his last as his entire family stood around him. Mr. Edgar De Los Angeles had been one of our faithful parishioners for so many years. Along with his wife, he served our church as a Eucharistic minister. When our church sanctuary was renovated, as a member of Knights of Columbus he painted the walls around the sanctuary and also contributed financially toward the church renovation. He not only regularly participated in our Sunday worship along with his wife but also took immense pride in seeing his children serve our church as altar servers. In his death, St. Joachim has lost a very generous, committed, loving and faithful parishioner. May God grant him the eternal reward of being with him in his eternal abode.

**Nota de nuestro pastor:** Responder al llamado para ungir a un feligrés que está gravemente enfermo ha sido mi prioridad durante mi ministerio aquí en San Joaquín durante los últimos diez años. La mayoría de esas visitas para ungir a un feligrés que está enfermo me dan una inmensa satisfacción y satisfacción pastoral como sacerdote católico. Pero admito que ha habido algunas ocasiones en las que me he sentido tan abatido y deprimido, cuando tengo que ungir a un paciente enfermo que se deja morir solo. Por el contrario, cuando tengo que ungir a un feligrés moribundo rodeado de su amada familia, me siento tan feliz como siento que el feligrés moribundo no se deja morir solo, sino que se siente muy amado en su último momento.

Recientemente tuve una experiencia tan maravillosa. El 20 de marzo de 2021 a las 3.10 pm recibí una llamada de la Sra. Mary Ann De Los Ángeles pidiéndome que fuera al Hospital Kaiser en San Leandro para ungir a su esposo. Le dije que ahora mismo estoy escuchando una confesión que será seguida por la misa de vigilia de las 4.30 pm. Le prometí que iría al hospital inmediatamente después de la misa. Como le había prometido, a las 6:00 pm fui al hospital para ungir al Sr. Edgar De Los Ángeles. Mark, su hijo menor vino a la entrada y me llevó al interior del hospital. Como solo la Sra. Mary Ann y Mark estaban dentro de la habitación, pregunté por los otros niños. La Sra. Mary Ann me dijo que la administración del Hospital solo permite que dos miembros de la familia estén dentro de la habitación. Y luego señaló a través de la ventana a todos sus otros hijos sentados dentro del auto que estaba estacionado frente a la habitación donde Edgar fue admitido. Todos esperaban dentro del automóvil para participar de la ceremonia de la unción a través de la videollamada de Zoom. Me conmovió mucho la actitud de esta maravillosa y amorosa familia. Aunque no se les permitió entrar al hospital, todos miraban la habitación donde ingresaron al Sr. Edgar y participaban en la ceremonia de la unción a través de una videollamada. Hablaba muy claramente de cuánto amaban los niños a su padre.

El 22 de marzo el lunes por la mañana a las 7:00 a.m., mientras me preparaba para mi caminata matutina diaria, recibí una llamada de la Sra. Mary Ann De Los Ángeles, llamándome para que fuera al hospital a orar por su esposo tal como estaba. al borde de la muerte. Inmediatamente corrí al hospital. Esa mañana, toda la familia rodeó al Sr. Edgar De Los Ángeles. Y todos rezamos juntos por Edgar. Y por la tarde, me dijeron que el Sr. Edgar exhaló su último suspiro mientras toda su familia lo rodeaba. El Sr. Edgar De Los Ángeles había sido uno de nuestros fieles feligreses durante varios años. Junto con su esposa, sirvió a nuestra iglesia como ministro eucarístico. Cuando se renovó el santuario de nuestra iglesia, como miembro de Caballeros de Colón, pintó las paredes alrededor del santuario y también contribuyó financieramente a la renovación de la iglesia. No solo participaba regularmente en nuestro culto dominical junto con su esposa, sino que también se enorgullecía enormemente de ver a sus hijos servir en nuestra iglesia como monaguillos. En su muerte, San Joaquín ha perdido a un feligrés muy generoso, comprometido, amoroso y fiel. Que Dios le conceda la recompensa eterna de estar con él en su morada eterna.

## VATICAN CORNER

For the second year in a row, the ceremonies of Holy Week and Easter, which Pope Francis presides over, were changed to streaming services online because of the covid-19 restrictions. The ceremonies were not open to the general public because of the need for social distancing. Only a very small number of the faithful were allowed to attend. However, over 170 broadcast networks and media outlets carried the Easter broadcasts to the people around the world. This year the Vatican added sign language to their services, in order



to follow their “No One Left Out” project started by their Dicastery for Communication. The primary celebrations were held in front of St. Peter’s Basilica or inside the Basilica at the Altar of the Chair. In place of his Easter homily, after the Gospel, Pope Francis chose to lead with a silent prayer, to reflect on the mystery of Christ’s Resurrection from the dead. During the Liturgy of the Eucharist, Francis recited the Roman Canon which is the oldest Eucharistic Prayer used in the Latin-rite and it dates back to a least to the 7th century. The Canon has an extensive list of Saints, Apostles, and Martyrs that Francis read. The Basilica was decorated with floral arrangements donated by florists from Holland. The florists placed Avalanche roses around the Altar of the Chair. Also this year, they donated some of their roses to residences for the elderly in Rome, where people are suffering from the pandemic. For 35 years the florists have been donating their time, money and flowers in order to make Easter Mass beautiful. The only year they missed was last year due to the pandemic. The time of the Easter Vigil was moved up an hour and a half to 7:30 P.M. to allow the attendees to be able to return home before Italy’s nightly 10:00 P.M. curfew. At Mass on Easter Sunday morning, Pope Francis thanked all those who worked so hard to make the Triduum celebrations so beautiful and those that worked so hard preparing the liturgical celebrations. In Francis’ Easter message to the people, he said “the crucified Jesus, none other, has risen from the dead. God the Father raised Jesus, his Son, because he fully accomplished his saving will. Jesus took upon himself our weakness our infirmities, even our death. He endured our sufferings and bore the weight of our sins. Because of this, God the Father exalted him and now Jesus Christ lives forever, he is the Lord.” ...”Amid the many hardships we are enduring, let us never forget that we have been healed by the wounds of Christ. In the light of the Risen Lord, our sufferings are now transfigured. Where there was death, now there is life. Where there was mourning, now there is consolation. In embracing the cross, Jesus bestowed meaning on our sufferings and now we pray that the benefits of that healing will spread throughout the world.

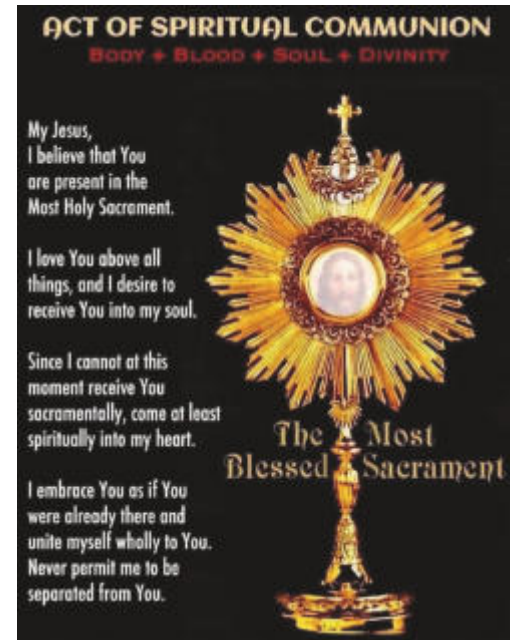

## HOW TO REQUEST A MASS INTENTION

If you would like to do a mass intention while the office is closed the easiest way is to do it online on our parish website [saintjoachim.net](http://saintjoachim.net) / Select the Donate/Pay in the upper right hand corner and then select mass intentions , put all your payment information in and in the comment section please put a date and time of the mass you would like your intention read at. Even though right now those mass times do not exist we would like to know which mass would be your preference. Intentions must be in by noon the day before except for the weekend masses - those must be submitted by noon on Friday. You can still drop mass intentions in the Rectory mail slot or in the mail but these must be a minimum of one week in advance since we are not in the office on a regular basis now. If you have questions about this process, please call the Rectory Office and someone will return your call.



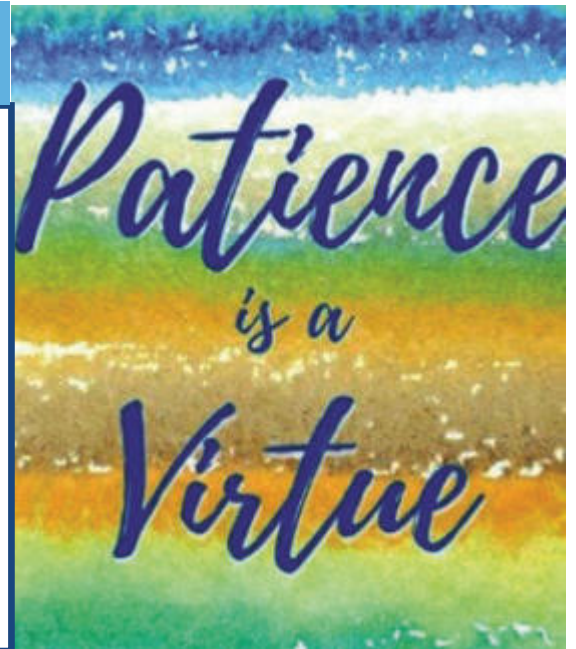
# Things we need to Remember

## To receive Communion

~ Father will give communion to the ONE Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion at communion time.

~ Ushers will direct you to come to communion. The side pews will be first, then the main section.

~To receive communion, you will receive The Body of Christ, in your hand, take a step to the side, remove your mask with your other hand, then consume the host, and then replace your mask. If you want to receive in the mouth go to the back of the church to the main double doors and be the last one that goes to Father for Communion.
