Our Lady of Czestochowa - Black Madonna

The original miraculous image of Our Lady of Czestochowa, or the Black Madonna is housed at the Bright Mount - Jasna Gora Monastery in Czestochowa, Poland. This famous painting of Blessed Virgin Mary holding the Child Jesus is shown as the "One Who Shows the Way".

If you look closely you will notice that the Virgin Mary directs attention away from herself with her right hand toward Jesus as the source of salvation.

In turn, the child Jesus extends his right hand toward the viewer in blessing while holding a book of gospels in his left hand.

When I look at this icon, I see a perfect theology. Mary directing us to Jesus and Jesus directing us to Mary who is the best way to get to Jesus.

The icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa or the Black Madonna has been associated with Poland for the past 600 years.

Czestochowa is a spiritual capital of Poland, and She is known as the Queen of Poland.

Saint John Paul II had a very strong devotion to Mary Mother of Jesus, to the point that when he was elected pope, his motto was "Totus Tuus, which means "All Yours".

And when he prayed to Mary, he did so in front of Our Lady of Czestochowa, the Black Madonna. He brought the image to the pope's chapel in the Vatican. And it is still there.

The feast day of Our Lady of Czestochowa is celebrated on August 26. The American National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa is located in Doylestown, Pennsylvania.

This image of Mary, Mother of Jesus will find a place in our church in the Holy Family chapel.

May Mary, Mother of Jesus, Our Lady of Czestochowa, the Black Madonna... pray for all of us, our families and friends, all the parishioners of St. Joachim's Church, now and forever. Amen.

La imagen milagrosa original de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa, o la Virgen Negra, se encuentra en el Monte Brillante - Monasterio de Jasna Gora en Czestochowa, Polonia.

Esta famosa pintura de la Santísima Virgen María sosteniendo al Niño Jesús se muestra como "El que muestra el camino".

A su vez, el niño Jesús extiende su mano derecha hacia el espectador en bendición mientras sostiene un libro de evangelios en su mano izquierda.

Cuando miro este ícono, veo una teología perfecta. María nos dirige a Jesús y Jesús nos dirige a María, que es la mejor manera de llegar a Jesús.

El icono de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa o la Virgen Negra se ha asociado con Polonia durante los últimos 600 años.

Czestochowa es una capital espiritual de Polonia y es conocida como la Reina de Polonia.

San Juan Pablo II tenía una devoción muy fuerte por María Madre de Jesús, hasta el punto de que cuando fue elegido Papa, su lema era "Totus Tuus, que significa" Todo tuyo".

Y cuando rezó a María, lo hizo frente a Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa, la Virgen Negra. Llevó la imagen a la capilla del Papa en el Vaticano. Y todavía está ahí.

La fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa se celebra el 26 de agosto. El Santuario Nacional Estadounidense de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa se encuentra en Doylestown, Pensilvania.

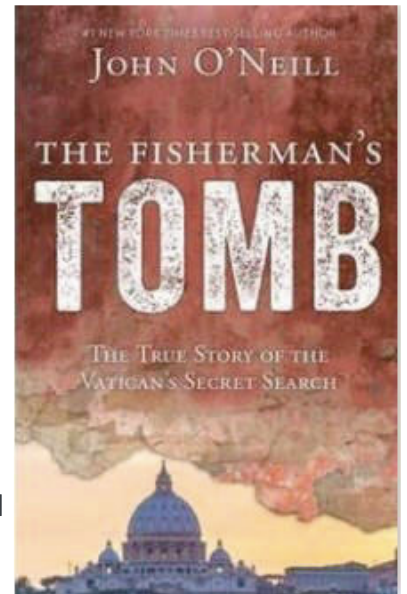

VATICAN CORNER

The author John J. O'Neill's book: "THE FISHERMAN'S TOMB: THE TRUE STORY OF THE VATICAN'S SECRET SEARCH" tell the gripping archeological detective story of the excavations that took place under St. Peter's Basilica starting during World War II. The work was done in search of the bones of St. Peter – the apostle, the first pope - the Rock on which Jesus built his Church. It was a Christian legend that the Roman Emperor Constantine had built the first St. Peter's Basilica directly over the grave of St. Peter. Secret excavations had been made previously in 1513 and 1683 but only pagan graves had been found, so searching was abandoned. In 1939 when digging under the Basilica for the burial of Pope Pius XI, a worker fell through the floor and an unknown subterranean world was discovered. It was a monumental archeological discover, the necropolis. The Emperor Constantine when creating a level area on Vatican Hill to build the first St. Peter's Basilica, had filled and covered over the early Christian graves and the Roman Family tombs located there. They had therefore been hidden from invaders and remained intact under the Basilica. With this great discovery, Pope Pius XII decided to excavate in secret in order to prove or disprove that Peter had come to Rome and died there. But the Church was nearly broke because of the Great Depression. The Book tells how the Pope Pius XII reached out to the wealth American oil man - George Strake who said "yes" to the Pope and gave him a blank check. Strake anonymously financed the excavations and his philosophy of life was expressed in the sign he kept on his desk: "God doesn't care how much money you



have when you die. God does care what you did with the money you had when you were alive." The excavation work he funded was very difficult and risky and went on for decades. The Book tells of the intrigues and adventures of World War II, the scholarly feuds, the petty jealousy among Vatican members, and the genius and tenacity of archeologist Margherita Guarducci who eventually solved the puzzle of St. Peter's bones and who confirmed the truth and brought those bones to light.

Author John O'Neill tells this incredible true story with much clarity and care. Speaking about the world today he writes: A slaughter and persecution of ancient Christian communities in the Middle East is underway today, even using the familiar, dehumanizing tools of crucifixion, fire, and rape employed by the persecutors of Christians in the ancient Roman Empire. These Christians are the true brothers and sister in faith of the brave Christians depicted in this book. Inspired by George Strake, I contribute all proceeds I receive from this book to their relief. – John O'Neill

If you don't have time to pray and read the scriptures —- You are busier than God ever intended you to be.

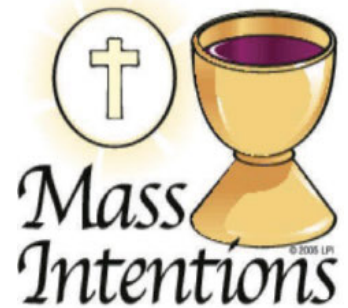

The History of the Advent Wreath

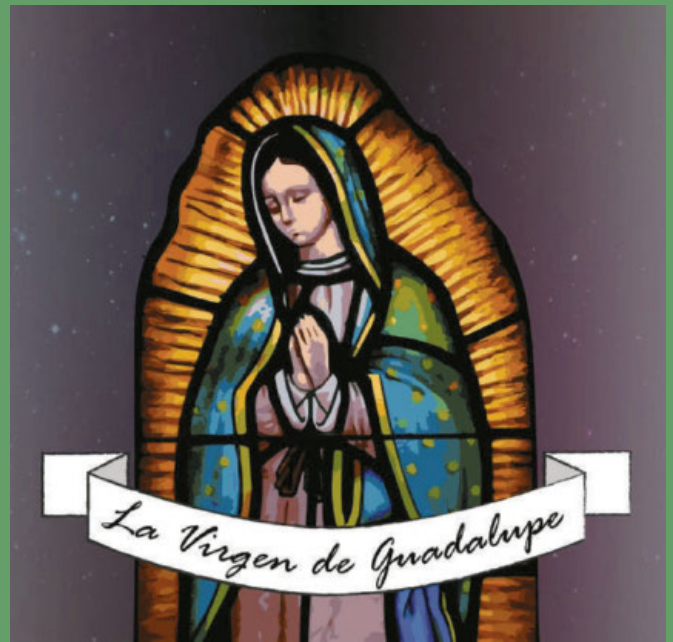
The Catholic church adopted this tradition during the Middle Ages, as a way to prepare the hearts and minds for Christmas. The word advent itself comes from the Latin word “adventus” meaning “arrival.” We prepare for the arrival of Christ. The wreath itself represents eternity and everlasting life, a circle that never ends (John 3:16).

Some have traced the origin of Advent as far back as the 4th or 5th century, but most would agree that the advent we’ve come to know now, symbols and all, started from the Middle Ages onward to the 1800s.
