

How to receive Holy Communion:

- ~ When leaving your pew/seat, you do so reverently with your hands folded/crossed and you approach the altar in silence., reflecting on Whom you are about to receive.
- ~ As you come to the Priest/Minister bow slightly then you receive the Body of Christ in one of two ways:
- 1) Create a cross with your hands held at chest level with one hand under the other—The Priest/ Minister will hold the Body of Christ in front of you and say "The Body of Christ:" you reply with "Amen" They will place the Jesus on the cross you have made with your hands,. You step slightly to the side, remove your mask from one side/ear, then take that hand to pick up the Body of Christ to place in your mouth, then replace your mask and return to your seat. You should not start walking until you have placed the Body of Christ in your mouth.
- 2) To receive the Body of Christ in your mouth during this Pandemic time we request that you go only to the Priest and to be last in his line. When approaching the Priest you keep your hands crossed/folded —The Priest will hold the Host in front of you and say "The Body of Christ: you reply with "Amen" then immediately open your mouth wide and stick your tongue out far enough to create a plate for him to place the Body of Christ on, far enough out so the Body of Christ will not fall off your tongue.
- ~Both of these ways are completely acceptable ways to receive the Body of Christ, but only these two ways and always with reverence and respect. (#160.General Instruction of the Roman Missal—3rd edition)
- ~ You return to your place with your hands folded and in silence, When you arrive at your place, this is a time for you to pray and to reflect and thank Jesus for coming into your life through the Holy Eucharist.

Cómo recibir la Sagrada Comunión:

- ~ Al abandonar tu banca / asiento, lo haces con reverencia con las manos cruzadas y te acercas al altar en silencio, reflexionando sobre A quién estás a punto de recibir.
- ~ Al acercarse al sacerdote / ministro haga una reverencia levemente, recibirá el Cuerpo de Cristo de una de dos maneras:
- 1) Crea un cruz con las manos a la altura del pecho con una mano debajo de la la otra—El Sacerdote/ Ministro sostendra el Cuerpo de Cristo frente a ti y dirá "El cuerpo de Cristo". Respondes con "Amén". Ellos colocararn a Jesus en la cruz que has hecho con tus manos, Da un paso ligeramente hacia un lado, se quita la máscara de un lado/oreja, luego toma esa mano para levantar el Cuerpo de Cristo y colocarlo en su boca, luego se vuelve a colocar la máscara y regresa a su asiento. No debe comenzar a caminar hasta que haya colocado el Cuerpo de Cristo en su boca.
- 2) Para recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo en su boca durane este tiempo de Pandemia le pedimos que se dirija solo al Sacerdote y que sea el ultimo en su fila Cuando se acerque al Sacerdote mantenga sus manos cruzadas uando se acerque al Sacerdote , —El Sacerdote / Ministro sostendrá a la Hostia frente a usted y le dirá "El Cuerpo de Cristo: responda con" Amén "y luego Inmediatamente abra la boca y saque la lengua lo suficiente como para crear un plato para que coloquen el Cuerpo de Cristo, lo suficiente como para que el Cuerpo de Cristo no se caiga de su lengua.
- ~ Ambas formas son formas completamente aceptables de recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo, pero solo estas dos formas y siempre . con reverencia y respeto. *(#160. Institucion general del Misal Romano tercera edicion)*
- ~ Regresas a tu asiento con las manos cruzadas y en silencio. Cuando llegas a tu asiento, este es un momento para que ores y reflexiones y agradezcas a Jesús por venir a tu vida a través de la Sagrada Eucaristía.



VATICAN CORNER

Michelangelo designed and built the dome of St. Peter's Basilica and Bernini was the architect of St.

Peter's square with its welcoming arms of columns framing the Basilica. Both men visualized a surprise effect on pilgrims who came to see St. Peter's. The pilgrims would be coming from the narrow and irregular streets and alleys of the adjacent neighborhood known as the Spina di Borgo. The view of the vastness and magnificence of the Basilica would therefore be blocked right up until arriving at St. Peter's Square, creating an incredible visual surprise. In 1667 Bernini even proposed a third wing of the colonnade to close off completely the view of the Basilica, separating the space of devotion from that of commerce and other secular activities. But that third colonnade was never built. The neighborhood the Spina di Borgo, consisted of four blocks outside the Vatican in the shape of a wedge. It had grown up with buildings after the 1527 sack of Rome and it provided an extra line of defense for the Basilica. Although having some aristocratic and religious palaces and piazzas, the Borgo was mainly a working class neighborhood with cobblestones,



weathered buildings and a quaint feeling associated with a preindustrial era. Its population was not necessarily Pope friendly. St. Peter's Square itself was frequently the site of anticlerical demonstrations in the mid -1800s through the early 1900s. Over the centuries, successive popes had toyed with the idea of building a triumphant route into the Vatican through the Borgo in order to welcome the crowds of pilgrims and present a symbolic image of the power of the Church. But those popes never succeeded. Ironically it was Benito Mussolini, the extremely anti-clerical atheist and the first of Europe's 20th-century fascist dictators who made that idea of a triumphant route into St. Peter's a reality. Mussolini early in his career realized that if he wanted power in Italy he would have to get the Catholic Church on his side. He forced the Lateran Treaty between Italy and the Vatican which is still in force today. As part of the treaty Pope Pius XI obtained Mussolini's promise to demolish the Spina di Borgo and on Dec. 29, 1936 Mussolini swung his pickax which began the demolition work for the great new artery in the center of Rome, the Via della Conciliazione to commemorate the reconciliation between the Italian State and the Vatican. The artery was to be inaugurated in 1942, but World War II caused postponement. The postwar Italian Republic continued the project and the road was finally inaugurated in the jubilee year of 1950. Despite its name, the Via della Conciliazione embodied conflicts between church and state, conservation and demolition, tradition and modernism. The Fascist were motivated to build the artery by a desire for grandeur and ritualistic uses of urban space to celebrate the Fascist state. But by making St. Peter's visible from afar and no longer enclosed by the Borgo, the highway changed the role of St. Peter's Square

making it reserved exclusively for religious celebrations and no longer an anticlerical space. The highway also merged the Vatican with the rest of the city of Rome, bypassing the separation of powers established by the Lateran Treaty. Today the Via della Conciliazione is firmly part of the Roman fabric, familiar to Romans, tourists and the Catholilc faithful from around the world. But to some it is still an open wound, the demolition and new construction by a dictator who wanted to turn Rome into the monumental capital of the new Fascist empire.
