






It is time to update your safe environment training!!

VATICAN CORNER

The Vatican earns money from the

production of coins and it is one of its major sources of revenue. Sales of coins date back as far as the beginning of the 700s. In 1929 the Vatican state and the Kingdom of Italy entered into agreements known as the Lateran Pacts. Part of the agreements was that the Vatican's coins would be minted exclusively at the Roman Mint and those coins would be the same size, composition, and value as Italian coins, and would be accepted within the Vatican, Italy, and San Marino. The agreement also fixed the total value of coins that can be minted each year. Those agreements, with modifications, are still being kept today. Fifty-one present of the total value of coins has to go into circulation, but the remainder is aimed at collectors. Because of the low number of coins produced, they are considered rarer than most,



and are attractive to collectors as well as the religious. Vatican coin sales do well in the market place, especially Italy, Germany, and throughout Europe. The Vatican is not a member of the European Union but since the year 2002 it has produced euro denominations which are also greatly sought after because of their rarity. Vatican euro coins have appreciated in value over time and this is not a result of increases in precious metal prices, but of limited supply and solid demand. Vatican coins are classified under which pope they were issued, and an image of that pope normally appears on each coin. However, starting in 2017 when Pope Francis no longer wanted his image on the coins, the coat of arms of the Vatican was substituted. Vatican coins also typically feature themes that reflect issues the pope at the time stressed, or often depict saints, Jesus, the Virgin Mary or biblical scenes. The coins issued under the papacy of St. John Paul II, are especially popular all over the world because he played an important role in promoting peaceful change in Eastern Europe. The design of a coin first starts when the artist makes a chalk model from his drawing. It is like a sculpture, 2 mm thick. Once the model is approved it is given to the Italian department that produces the coins. The model is stamped and a coin results. Each year, in the spring, the Vatican issues a mint set and a proof set of new uncirculated coins. Additionally 2-euro commemorative sets are produced in the fall of every year. But the Vatican only sells to an exclusive group of large coin dealers, and not to the general public. So collectors have to obtain coins from coin dealers and distributors. Mauro Olivieri, the director of the former Vatican's stamp and coin office explained that after 80 years, in 2020 his office was reorganized into new State departments to hopefully increase production, keep sales up and in a small way, transmit the faith. People collect Vatican coins for many reasons, such as because they feature Catholic images or events, because they are beautiful, are rare, retain or increase in value and display history. Coin collecting can also be relaxing and can leave a valuable inheritance for heirs. The Vatican benefits greatly from all those collected coins. Mauro Olivieri said each year; the Vatican earns more than 9,000,000 euros from their sales!


Come Pray the Rosary with us!
