


## It is time to update your safe environment training!!


VATICAN CORNER | All life on earth has evolved to depend on the chemical prop-

erties of salt to survive. It has been used by humans for thousands of years, for food preservation and seasoning. By preserving food it was a contributor to the development of civilization. Salt helped end the dependence on seasonal availability of food, and it made it possible to transport food over large distances. Nowadays salt is inexpensive, but in the ancient world it was a valuable commodity and often difficult to obtain. It was controlled by the royalty in Egypt and Persia. Roman soldiers were partially paid with salt ("sal" in Latin). It was the origin of the word "salary" and of the phrase "worth his salt." Being costly, it was offered to God as a "covenant of salt," used in sacrifices by the Israelites and for the sacrificial meal. The belief in its healing powers led to its use to dry and harden the skin of newborns and to prevent umbilical cord infection. Shared at the sacrificial meal, salt became a symbol of friendship and hospitality, a symbol still used in Arab culture. Jesus referred to salt symbolizing friendship in Mark 9:50: "Have



salt in yourselves and be at peace with one another." Jesus referred to his disciples as the "salt of the earth" (Matt. 5:13) indicating that they are a valuable and necessary part of God's plan. He is calling on them to add fullness and flavor to Christian life, to preserve the faith they have received and pass it on to others. The disciples are called to be living proof of God's love on earth. This means they are as basic to God's word as salt is to human life, and if the disciples can't be salt, then they will not be true disciples living as God desires them. Another popular interpretation of Jesus' phrase "salt of the earth" is that Christians cannot allow themselves to lose their 'saltiness.' It is not enough to simply be "salt", Christians must take care to remain fresh and energetic in their devotion to God. On May 23, 2013 in his homily, Pope Francis said "Christians are called to be the salt of the earth, and if they don't share the flavor of their faith, hope and love with others, they are simply museum Christians. Salt has meaning when it gives flavor to something. Salt kept in a bottle, with the humidity, loses its strength and is useless...One of the special characteristics of Christianity is that God gives each Christian different gifts and characteristics. It takes each person as he is ... with his personality, his characteristics, his culture ... and leaves him with those, because they are riches. But it gives something more: It gives flavor...In order to maintain the flavor of the salt, Christians need to have a relationship with the one who gave it to them. Strengthened by prayer and adoration, Christian witness and service to others ensures we don't become museum Christians. Watch out, museum Christians. Salt without flavor is a salt that does nothing."
