




### Prayer For Ukraine

#### **VATICAN CORNER**

Continued ... Sacramentals are


sacred signs which remind us of the sacraments. They can be physical objects such as rosary beads, devotional metals, holy water, blessed palms, cross necklace, etc. Salt blessed by the liturgical prayer of a priest is also a sacramental. Sacramentals do not have selfcontained power, their power comes from the Church's official prayer or blessing, which is a power the Church derives from Christ himself. In the Bible, the blessing promised by God on food and water, as well as the prevention of miscarriages and agricultural catastrophes (Exod. 23:25-26) was extended by God through Elisha in Jericho (II Kings 2:20-21), when he



was inspired to put salt into the contaminated water. Adding salt to already bad water to decontaminate it, made the miracle all the greater, since the opposite result would be expected. This miracle of Elisha is the main Scriptural basis for the sacramental use of blessed salt today, as the Roman Ritual indicates. Blessed salt is intended to be an instrument of grace to preserve one from the corruption of evil occurring as sin, sickness, demonic influence, etc.

Today, much of the world's salt comes from salt mines in caves or landlocked lakes that were once part of the ocean. In countries boarding the sea where the amount of water evaporation exceeds the amount of annual rainfall by at least 30 inches, salt can be produced by solar evaporation from seawater using shallow ponds. Impurities like trace minerals, sulfates, soil sediments, algae and bacteria affect the taste and appearance of certain types of salts. The little seaside town of Cervia in northern Italy, on the Adriatic Coast, produces a salt of exceptional quality and sweet taste which has made it highly prized. Cervia's salt has earned the honor of being known as the pope's salt and an old tradition has been revived so that now every year a gift basket of the first salt of the harvest is brought to Rome by Cervian dignitaries and handed to the pope in person. Ceriva used a multi-tiered seawater evaporation system going back to Roman or possibly Etruscan times. Salt has had an important and complicated history in Italy, being the cause of or lost prize from many wars, with little Cervia being in the middle of most of the turmoil. The rivalling Italian States and the Catholic Church would fight to control salt. In 1464 when the former bishop of Cervia became Pope Paul II, he commanded that Cervia would continue being the official supplier of salt to the Papal table. That tradition stopped and started over the next few centuries. Papal States use the control of salt to charge a large salt tax of its citizens. The bread still made today in Tuscany and Perugia without the ingredient of salt, is thought to be the result of a protest against the new papal tax of 1540. In 1959 the harvesting of salt was industrialized in Cervia, but in 2003 a group of passionate citizens and Bishop Mario Marini revived the traditional harvesting method to pass on the incredible heritage of their land and ecosystem. Now every year pilgrims and Cervia's officials recreate the four-century tradition of salt workers journeying on mules to bring this white gold to the Vatican.
