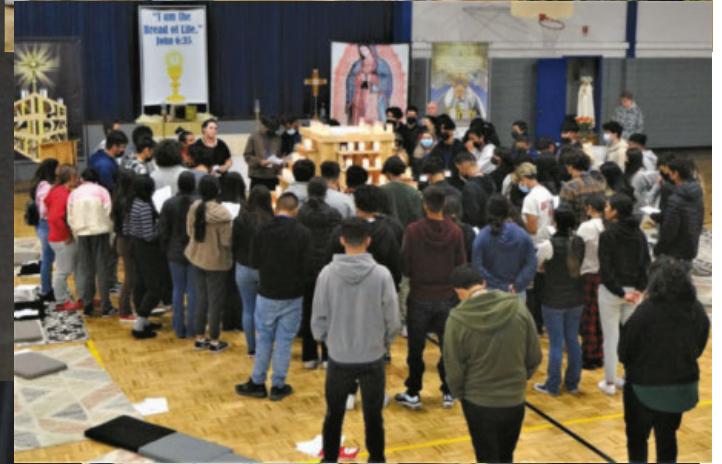

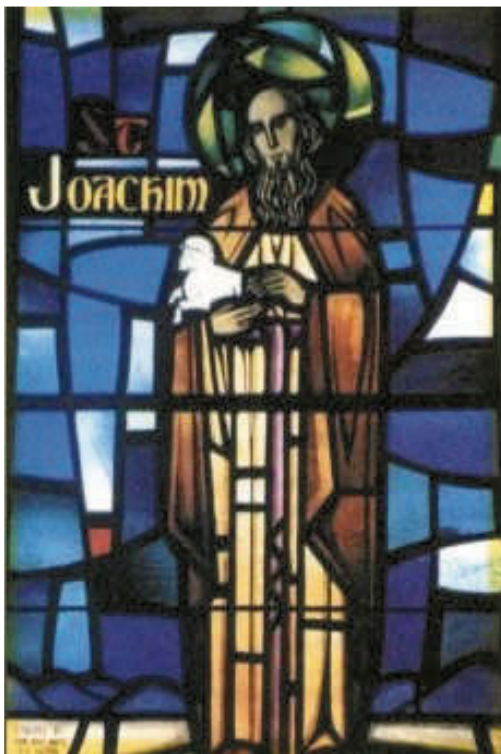

VATICAN CORNER

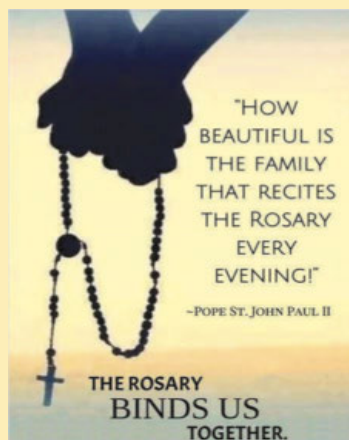

The Virgin Mary appeared to the three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal in 1917 and again she appeared to Lúcia Santos the one remaining Fatima visionary who became a novice at the Sisters of Saint Dorothy convent in Tuy, Spain in 1929. According to the Vatican's translation of the messages from the Virgin Mary, she said "God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved, and there will be peace."



Mary warned of "war, famine, and persecutions of the church and of the Holy Father, and to prevent this" she said "I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart." "If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace." "If not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. In 1942, Pope Pius XII consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary the whole of humanity which included Russia. Again in 1952 Pope Pius XII made a similar blessing but this time for "all the peoples of Russia." Pope Paul VI did the same for humanity in 1964 and Pope John Paul II did the same for the whole human race in 1981 and 1982. After consulting with Sister Lúcia, Pope John Paul II again consecrated Russia with coordination of the Catholic Bishops of the world. Sister Lúcia had been asked if that consecration had been done the way the Virgin Mary wanted it to be done and she said it had. Yet some groups have continued to say that the Virgin Mary's wish was never fulfilled or that it was never done properly. Pope Francis consecrated Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 2013. However, because of the Russian-Ukraine war, Eastern and Latin-rite Catholic bishops of Ukraine asked Pope Francis for the re-consecration of Russia. So on March 25, 2022 at the end of a penitential service in St. Peter's Basilica Pope Francis carried out the act of consecrating Russian and the Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary with a prayer asking for peace in the world. At the same time a consecration ceremony took place in Fatima, Portugal by the Papal Almoner, and Catholic bishops and priests from around the world joined in the ceremony. Francis said the consecration "is no magic formula but a spiritual act." "It is an act of complete trust on the part of children who, amid the tribulation of this cruel and senseless war that threatens our world, turn to their Mother, reposing all their fears and pain in her heart and abandoning themselves to her." It means placing in that pure and undefiled heart, where God is mirrored, the inestimable goods of fraternity and peace, all that we have and are, so that she, the Mother whom the Lord have given us, may protect us and watch over us."

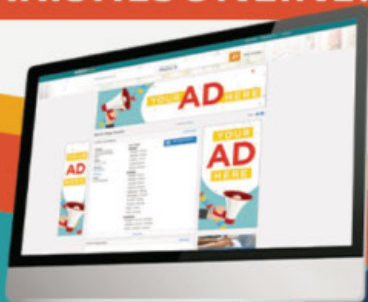
