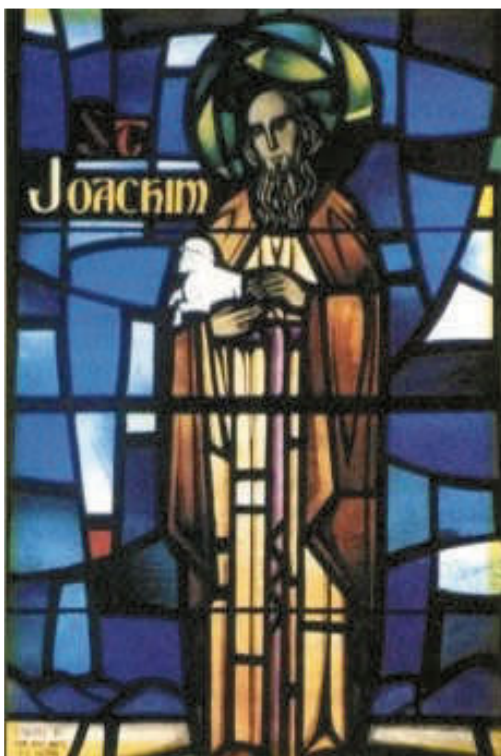

Catholics tend to see the



Consecration of Russia to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary as a matter of converting atheistic Communism Russian into followers of Jesus Christ. While many Orthodox Christians see it differently. They look at it as part of the historical conflict between the two Christian groups which separated in the Great Schism of the 11th century. They see the Consecration as an encroachment of the Latin Church on their territory. They say that Russia already belonged to the Christian religion at the time of the alleged Fátima apparitions and already had a long history of devotion to the Virgin Mary. They fear that the phrase “Russia will be converted” means from Orthodox Christianity to Roman Catholicism.

In 2016, Pope Francis became the first pope to meet a leader of the Russian Orthodox Church since the Great Schism. The meeting was to discuss improving relations. Both Christian groups have now declared to work towards unity, but they are still far apart theologically and over the role of the papacy in an eventually reunited Church. There was hope that later this year a second meeting could take place between Pope Francis and Patriarch Kirill, the leader of the Russian Orthodox Church, but the Russian / Ukrainian war has complicated relations with the two Churches. Cardinal Pietro Parolin the Vatican Secretary of State has called the relationship delicate”. Since the start of the war in Ukraine, Pope Francis has not directly blamed Russian leader Vladimir Putin in his public words about the Russian invasion and has instead used words like “those who make war”. He has received some criticism for not calling out Putin as the aggressor, but possibly one reason may be that Patriarch Kirill backs Putin. The fear is that direct criticism by the Pope of Russia or Putin could set back decades the relations between the two churches. Diplomatic experts however say that throughout the centuries the Vatican hasn’t publicly used shame or condemnation or shown favor to one side of a conflict over the other. It has been said that the Vatican always leaves room for the next conversation, for the next dialogue, in an attempt to be able to bring about peace. But while the Pope has not been specific about the aggressor, his top aides have been more direct and that is not the usual Vatican tradition, but it may be part of the strategy for this conflict. On April 2, 2022, first to reports on the plane taking him for a two-day visit to Malta, and then in a hard-hitting speech in Malta’s presidential palace, he condemned an “unjustified aggression” and he denounced “atrocities” in the war, and although he did not say Putin’s name, he left little doubt who he was talking about when he said “once again, some potentate, sadly caught up in anachronistic claims of nationalist interests, is provoking and fomenting conflicts, whereas ordinary people sense the need to build a future that, will either be shared, or not be at all.” Francis said “now in the night of the war that is fallen upon humanity, let us not allow the dream of peace to fade.” Earlier a reporter had asked Francis if he was considering an invitation to visit Kyiv, the Ukrainian capital, and he said he is considering visiting. Cardinal Parolin when asked about such a trip to Kyiv said “I believe that in the end a trip is not prohibitive; it can be done.” Be he added that the “consequences” of a papal trip are being evaluated. One factor to consider are relations with the Russian Orthodox Church.

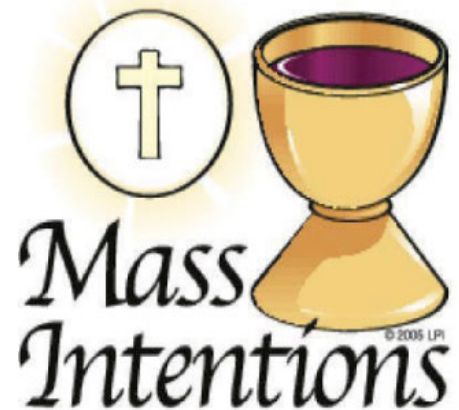

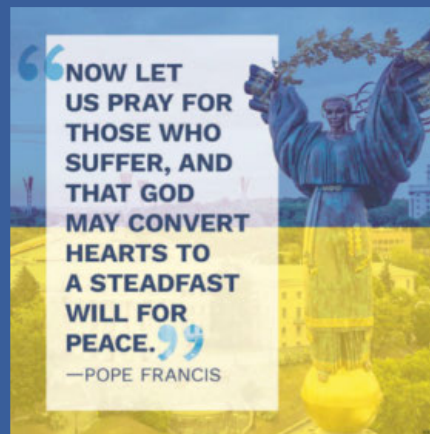
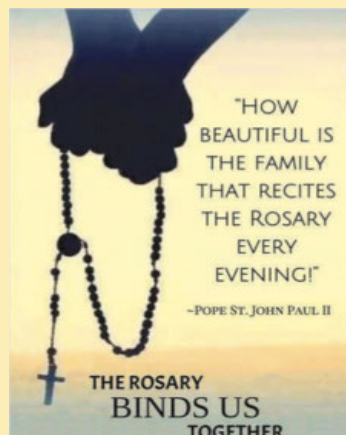


Come Pray the Rosary with us !

Everyday Stewardship

At Easter, we celebrate that our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, conquered death, rose from the dead, and remains very much alive. To the world of non-believers: what!? It is quite a big reality to swallow. But for the believer, it is a reality that inspires us to the point where we find ourselves constantly sharing the Gospel with everyone we meet! Right?

So what does Easter mean to you? The question is not what do you believe. The question is what impact does Easter have on you? How do your actions demonstrate the power of Easter? What does it mean when you hear that we, the Church, are an Easter people?

You may be saying right now that you have no intention of becoming an evangelist, passing out Bibles to all you meet. But I would like to suggest that you actually have a more powerful way of evangelizing others: everyday stewardship. Actions speak louder than words and the way you live your life can be a great testimony to all those you encounter. By acknowledging the gifts you have been given, cultivating those so they grow to an increase, and then sharing them fully with God and with others in God's name will give testimony to your belief that Jesus is alive and seeking a relationship with each of his people. If more of us won't live our lives in this manner, then non-believers and non-intentional disciples will ask the question, "What difference does Easter make anyway?" La corresponsabilidad diaria

Durante la Pascua celebramos el hecho de que Jesús venció la muerte, resucitó de entre los muertos y sigue vivo entre nosotros. Al no creyente esto es difícil de entender. Es una realidad enorme. Pero para el creyente, es una realidad que nos inspira y que nos ayuda a compartir el Evangelio con todos.

¿Qué significa la Pascua para usted? Note que la pregunta no es si usted cree, sino que ¿qué efecto tiene la Pascua para usted? ¿Cómo demuestran sus acciones el poder de la Pascua? ¿Qué significa el decir que la Iglesia somos una gente pascual?

Puede estar decidido que no quiere ser evangelizador dándoles Biblias a todos que se encuentra. Pero le quiero sugerir que usted tiene una manera más fuerte de evangelizar: la corresponsabilidad diaria. Las acciones pueden decir más que las palabras y la manera en que usted vive su vida puede ser testimonio para los que se encuentre. En aceptar los dones que Dios le ha regalado, dará testimonio a su creencia de que Jesús está vivo y está buscando una relación con todos.

Si más de nosotros no buscamos vivir nuestras vidas de esta forma, entonces los no creyentes se preguntaran: ¿Qué diferencia hace la cua de cualquier modo? Jesús murió y resucitó para usted y para mí. Asegúrese de que sí haga una diferencia.

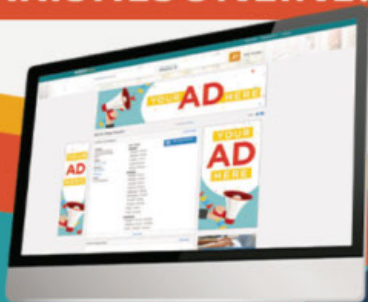
