

Registration Requirements:

- 1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism and First Communion Certificates (for Confirmation registration) will be required at the time of registration.
- 2. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year and any retreats attended must have been</u> <u>paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.





VATICAN CORNER In 1968 a German scholar / archaeologist with very sharp

eyes discovered the remains of a siege wall encircling a site in the desert in the country of Jordan, east of the Dead Sea. The site was eventually definitely identified as the ruins of the ancient city of Machaerus, a desert fortress, which was destroyed by the Romans at the end of the First Jewish Revolt in 71/72 A.D. The name Machaerus is derived from the Greek word for sword. It is where the Holy Bible says that St. John the Baptist was placed in prison for telling (King) Herod Antipas "It is not lawful for you to have her", speaking of Herodias, the wife of Herod's brother. The Bible says that when Herod's



birthday came, the daughter of Herodias danced for Herod and so pleased him that he promised her anything. She asked for the head of John the Baptist and she received it. St. John was executed making him a martyr. The Holy Bible reports that Jesus Christ's speaking about St. John's suffering and death, said that the Son of Man will suffer similarly, foretelling his own death. The events of John the Baptist's death were recorded by the non-Christian historian Josephus of the same era and by Bishop Eusebius of Pamphilia, two important historians of ancient Palestine. So the site discovery has both great religious and historical significance and is now considered the most important Gospel scene in the country of Jordan. Archeological work began with a survey by members of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary of the U.S. Then in 1978 two Franciscan archaeologists worked at the site. But none of the archeological work was published. In 2009 Pope emeritus Benedict XVI in his papal visit to the Holy Land expressed interest concerning Machaerus. So Jordan's Royal Department of Antiquities responding by deciding to have the site seriously excavated and contacted Hungarian archaeologist / architect Dr. Győző Vörös. For ten years now Vörös has been working at the site and on February 1, 2022 he was at the Vatican to receive a papal Gold Medal from the Pontifical Academies for his published three volumes of archaeological work on Machaerus. Vörös explained that it is a miracle that Machaerus is a Gospel scene that has survived as an archaeological time capsule. He says everything is there. Historians and visitors will have the opportunity to gain a truly accurate picture of a Gospel event. Vörös team has been able to reconstruct portions of Herod's palace. He is hoping that by the year 2029 when his contract with Jordan expires and when there will be a celebration of the 2,000th anniversary of St.John's ministry in the year 28 or 29 A. D., that the site of St John the Baptist's martyrdom will be presented in an authentic way and be put on the Holy Land map. He also hopes it will be ready for the next papal visit from Rome. Vörös recalled the words of Pope Francis who says the Holy Land is "the fifth Gospel" helping us to understand the first four. Vörös says that the sites of the Holy Land offer historical context not only for us "but for our children, for the next generation" for whom "we can provide religious books that are illustrated with historical reality." 


