1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism and First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will be required at the time of registration.
2. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year and any retreats attended must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.

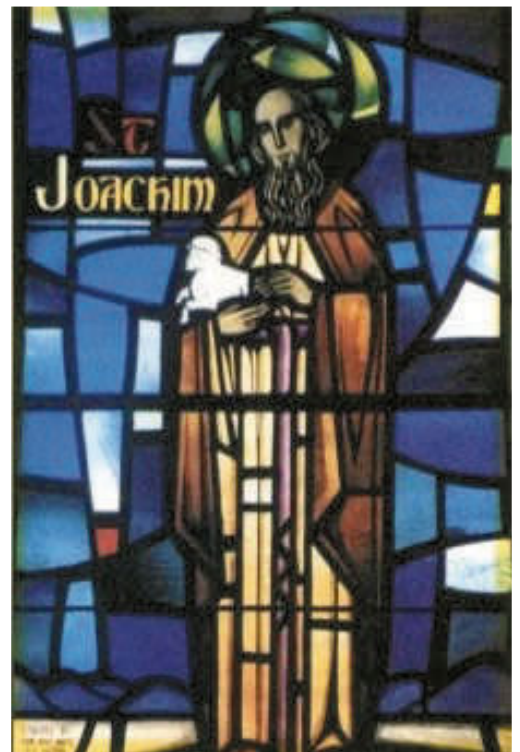

Up to the Job

Have you ever had a job for which you didn't feel qualified? I think we all have, whether it was a paying gig or not. A lot of us parents often feel in awe of the magnitude of that role and lose sleep worrying that we made the wrong decision in one situation or a bad call in another. Some of us feel intimidated by what our communities need from us, on the parish level or in our personal relationships. Or maybe we are simply dreading a task that seems too big, too overwhelming — that necessary basement cleanout, or the weekly organization of family schedules.

When we don't feel qualified, we don't want to do the work. We get stuck in our own fear. That's the birthplace of procrastination, self-doubt and bitterness. When we look inward at our own abilities, we can only see all the traits that aren't there. The intelligence, the dexterity, the ambition — whatever it is we lack, we get stuck on it.

I've got good news and bad news. I'll start with the bad news: none of us are qualified for the call of discipleship. We simply aren't. We don't have the love or grace or strength to get the job done. Now I'll give you the good news: God knows this, and He doesn't care. Stewardship does not insist that we possess every good quality — no, as a way of life, stewardship recognizes that we lack so many qualities. But it shows us where to find the love and grace and strength we need. Stewardship does not demand that we know every answer; it merely reminds us who to ask when we don't.

VATICAN CORNER

In 2018, Pope Francis spoke of the sacrament of

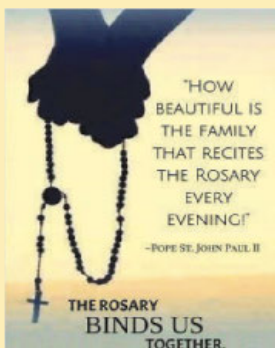
Confirmation explained that “it is a further spiritual anointing that completes the grace of Baptism and leads to the Eucharist. He said the rite of Confirmation recalls and renews the promises made at Baptism and invokes a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Just as Jesus received the outpouring of the Spirit at his baptism in order to carry out his messianic mission, the Church prays that we too may receive the gifts and fruits of the Spirit that enable us to help the Body of Christ grow in unity and missionary zeal. The gift of the



Spirit is communicated through the laying on of hands and anointing with sacred chrism. Saint Paul sheds lights on the meaning of these sacramental signs when he says that ‘God ...had anointed us, by putting his seal on us and giving us his Spirit in our hearts’ (2 Cor 1:21-22). Sealed with the Holy Spirit, we are configured more closely to Christ and strengthened to bear witness to him in our world. May each of us grow in gratitude for the gift received at our Confirmation and open our hearts ever more fully to the creativity of the Spirit who makes all things new.”

Through the centuries the way we have celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation and understood its meaning has changed. It is nearly universally accepted as a celebration of the Holy Spirit within us and a time for affirming our Baptism, but it has had different meaning and purpose over time, and the age of those participating has varied. In the early Church the three sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist were celebrated in the same ceremony by adult catechumens at the Easter Vigil. In the fourth century when Emperor Constantine made Christianity the state religion, more people were baptized and the religion spread to the countryside. Bishops with the added duties of governing could no longer preside over all the baptisms. Eastern Bishops delegated the sacraments to the presbyter and kept the blessing of the Confirmation oil for themselves. The Church of the East still today celebrates all three sacraments together. The Church of the West delegated Baptism to the priests but retained Confirmation for themselves. So that Sacrament was only performed when the Bishops visited a particular area, and therefore performed at a later time than Baptism. In the middle ages it became the practice to confirm close to adolescence instead of infancy. Theologians began to teach that Confirmation was the sacrament of maturity and it fortified the Christian with the Holy Spirit to fight, suffer and die for the faith. The idea that the sacrament made a person a soldier of Christ prevailed. The Bishop’s gentle slap on the face while saying “peace be with you” became part of the rite. It indicated readiness for life’s battles and was also thought to serve as an exorcism and as a memory device to keep people from forgetting they were confirmed.
