“LET US MEET OUR NEW PAROCHIAL VICAR”

I guess it has been quite some time that St. Joachim community did not have an SVD Filipino missionary. Well, thanks be to God, we will have the blessings to have a missionary who has dedicated his life as a religious in the foreign missions and now actively working here in the USA.

His name: Fr. Emilio Reyes, SVD. A Filipino born and raised in Tondo, Manila on January 10.

His dad +Emilio SR, was from Sta. María, Bulacan and his mom +Felicidad Lourdes Santiago Reyes was from Gapan, Nueva Ecija.

Fr. Emil, as he is fondly called by his friends and confreres has 6 siblings; he is the youngest in the brood.

He had his philosophical studies in Christ the King Seminary in Quezon City, Philippines

He studied Canonical Theology in Divine Word Seminary in Tagaytay City, Philippines together with his other 13 SVD classmates. They were ordained as SVD Religious

Missionaries on October 19 at Divine Word Seminary in Tagaytay City. He did his baccalaureate thesis paper: “The Theology of Lay Ministry” under the Pontificio Urbaniana University (Rome).

His first foreign mission assignment was spent for 7 years in Colombia, South America, where he mastered Spanish as his second language now.

In 1994, he was assigned to Divine Word Seminary as Director of the Retreat Center, spiritual director, retreat master and part time theology professor.

He had his Renewal Course in Nemi, Italy and received his second mission assignment to work in Argentina for another 6 years. He was several times district superior during his mission in Argentina.

Opportunities came when he was assigned in 2006 to USA Western Province because they were in need of tri-lingual priest. He was Retreat Center Director in Riverside, California as his first assignment.

Then, he was sent to work in the Diocese of Oakland in St. Bernard Church.

After which the Diocese of San Francisco needed the presence of a religious community; so he was made the first SVD pastor in St. Kevin Catholic Church- a multi-cultural community.

In 2012, he worked as parochial vicar of St. Jude Shrine of the West, this time in the Diocese of San Diego.

After which he became again the first SVD priest to handle St. Mary Church In Escondido, California, with predominantly Hispanic presence.

Then, he was transferred to the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in Our Lady of Lourdes Parish where he worked effectively for 4 years.

After having been in the pastoral ministry for several years, he decided to try his hands on another kind of specialized ministry: Vocation Ministry.

So he started his work as a Vocation Director of the 3 USA SVD Provinces, traveling as far as Florida, Idaho, Atlanta, New York, Canada, Panamá, Washington DC, Virginia, Maryland, Phoenix, Mississippi, Tennessee, Illinois, Nebraska, Iowa, Chicago promoting SVD religious vocation among the youth.

He was sent for further studies in Rome(2022) about Formation and Vocation Promotions.

Last May 2, 2022, in the monthly Provincial Council meeting, they appointed Fr. Emil to be the new Parochial Vicar of St. Joachim Church, to minister hand in hand with Fr. Henry, our pastor, to a growing multicultural community and at the same time attend spiritually and sacramentally to our students of St. Joachim Catholic School.

Let us thank the Lord for this wondrous gift of Fr. Emil to our Catholic community.

Together we pray constantly for Fr. Henry Noga, SVD and Fr. Emilio Reyes, SVD, for their health, security, perseverance and commitment to the kingdom of God here in our beloved Catholic community of St. Joachim Church.



CONOZCAMOS A NUESTRO NUEVO VICARIO PARROQUIAL”

Supongo que ha pasado bastante tiempo que la comunidad de St. Joaquin no tenía un misionero filipino.

Bueno, gracias a Dios, tendremos la bendición de tener un misionero que ha dedicado su vida como religioso en las misiones extranjeras y ahora trabaja activamente aquí en los EE. UU.

Su nombre: P. Emilio Reyes, SVD.

Filipino nacido y criado en Tondo, Manila el 10 de enero.

Su papá +Emilio SR, era de Sta. María, Bulacan y su mamá +Felicidad Lourdes Santiago Reyes era de Gapan, Nueva Ecija.

Padre Emil, como lo llaman cariñosamente sus amigos y cohermanos, tiene 6 hermanos; él es el más joven en la familia. Realizó sus estudios filosóficos en el Seminario Cristo Rey en Quezon City, Filipinas.

Estudió Teología Canónica en el Seminario del Verbo Divino en la ciudad de Tagaytay, Filipinas, junto con sus otros 13 compañeros SVD. Fueron ordenados como Misioneros Religiosos SVD el 19 de octubre en el Seminario del Verbo Divino en la ciudad de Tagaytay.

Realizó su tesis de licenciatura: “La Teología del Ministerio Laico” en la Universidad Pontificio Urbaniana (Roma).

Su primera misión en el extranjero la pasó durante 7 años en Colombia, América del Sur, donde dominó el español como su segundo idioma ahora.

En 1994, fue asignado al Seminario del Verbo Divino como Director del Centro de Retiros, director espiritual, maestro de retiros y profesor de teología a tiempo parcial.

Hizo su Curso de Renovación en Nemi, Italia y recibió su segunda asignación misionera para trabajar en Argentina por otros 6 años. Fue varias veces superior de distrito durante su misión en Argentina.

Las oportunidades llegaron cuando fue asignado en 2006 a la Provincia Oeste de EE. UU. porque necesitaban un sacerdote trilingüe. Fue Director del Centro de Retiro en Riverside, California como su primera asignación.

Luego, fue enviado a trabajar en la Diócesis de Oakland en la Iglesia St. Bernardo.

Después de lo cual la Diócesis de San Francisco necesitaba la presencia de una comunidad religiosa; por lo que se convirtió en el primer pastor SVD en la Iglesia Católica St. Kevin, una comunidad multicultural.

En 2012, trabajó como vicario parroquial de St. Jude Shrine of the West, esta vez en la Diócesis de San Diego.

Después de lo cual se convirtió nuevamente en el primer sacerdote SVD en manejar la Iglesia St. Mary en Escondido, California, con una presencia predominantemente hispana.

Luego, fue trasladado a la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles en la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes donde trabajó efectivamente durante 4 años.

Después de haber estado en el ministerio pastoral durante varios años, decidió probar suerte en otro tipo de ministerio especializado: la Pastoral Vocacional.

Entonces comenzó su trabajo como Director Vocacional de las 3 Provincias SVD de EE. UU., viajando hasta Florida, Idaho, Atlanta, Nueva York, Canadá, Panamá, Washington DC, Virginia, Maryland, Phoenix, Mississippi, Tennessee, Illinois, Nebraska, Iowa, Chicago promoviendo la vocación religiosa SVD entre los jóvenes.

Fue enviado a Roma (2022) para continuar sus estudios sobre Formación y Promoción Vocacional.

El pasado 2 de mayo de 2022, en la reunión mensual del Consejo Provincial, nombraron al P. Emil para ser el nuevo Vicario Parroquial de la Iglesia St. Joachim, para ministrar de la mano con el P. Henry, nuestro pastor, a una comunidad multicultural en crecimiento y al mismo tiempo atender espiritual y sacramentalmente a nuestros estudiantes de la Escuela Católica St. Joaquin.

Demos gracias al Señor por este maravilloso don del P. Emil a nuestra comunidad católica.

Juntos rezamos constantemente por el P. Henry Noga, SVD y el P. Emilio Reyes, SVD, por su salud, seguridad, perseverancia y compromiso con el reino de Dios aquí en nuestra amada comunidad católica de la Iglesia de San Joaquín.

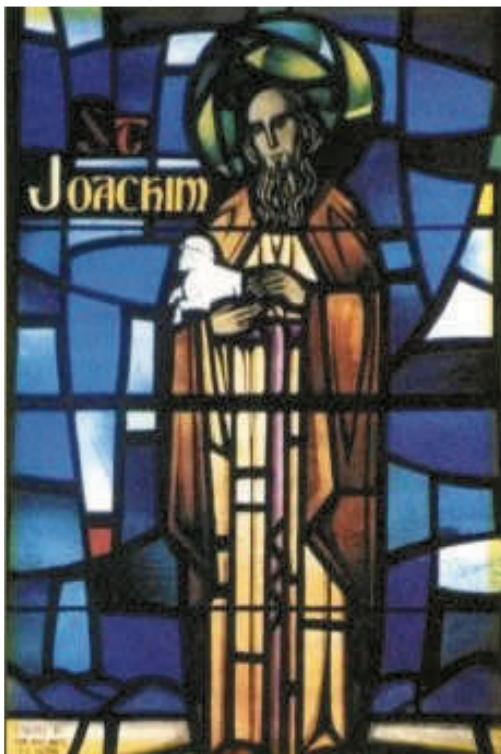

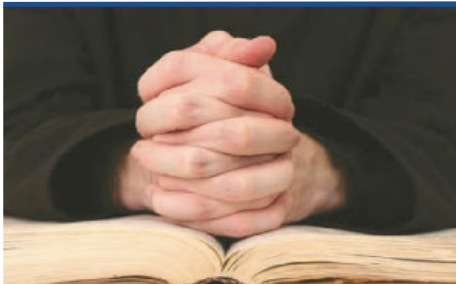

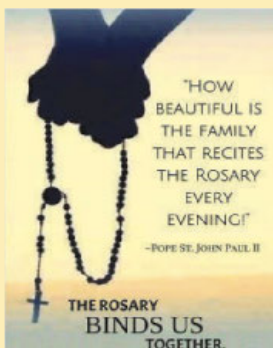
VATICAN CORNER

Just how did the Vatican with its small size of only 109 acres be encircled by another country (Italy) and become the smallest country in the world. In the Ancient Roman times, the Vatican Hill and the valley below were used partly as a burial ground and partly as a place for chariot races and other competitions. In the 4th century the Roman Emperor Constantine built a basilica over what is believed to be the tomb of Saint Peter, the first pope. Pilgrims began coming to Rome and people started donating lands to the Church, making it eventually the owner of a very large land area. After the 5th century the popes lived in the Lateran Palace located outside Rome, and only for special functions would they stay in buildings near the basilica. In the 8th century donations from the rulers of the Carolingian empire helped solidify papal power and the Papal States were born. From the year 756 to 1870 much of central Italy was known as the Papal States and it was under the direct sovereign rule of the pope. The Papal States co-existed along with the Holy Roman Empire, a complex of lands in western and central Europe. At times the Papal States and the Holy Roman Empire took territory from each other, and even went to war. In 846 Saracen pirates trying to attack Rome, found its walls impenetrable, but found St. Peter's Basilica had no protect whatsoever and Saint Peter's tomb was destroyed along with other parts of the basilica with many valuable items stolen. Soon thereafter, Pope Leo IV had defensive walls built around the basilica, creating the 2-mile-long 39-foot high Leonine Wall. Parts of this wall can still be seen today. In 1309 the Papal court moved to Avignon (then the kingdom of Aries), now in France, due to a disagreement that arose after French king Philip IV went behind everyone's backs and elected a French pope. Seven successive popes resided in Avignon until in 1376 Pope Gregory XI moved the court back to Rome. The long abandonment had left Rome and St. Peter's Basilica in ruin. In the mid-1400s, Pope Nicholas V decided to live permanently inside Vatican City. He had the old Apostolic Palace destroyed and start a series of building projects that began to create the Vatican City that we see today. Pope Julius II decided to build a new more beautiful structure around St. Peter's tomb rather than try and preserve the original 1200 year old basilica. Subsequent popes consulted many architects but eventually the new basilica was entrusted to Michelangelo in the mid-1500s. In 1527, troops loyal to the Holy Roman Emperor - Charles V mutinied over unpaid wages and savagely attacked Rome and took it over. Pope Clement VII eventually paid a large ransom and gave up some Papal territories to the Holy Roman Empire. To avoid further conflict with Charles V, Pope Clement VII did what Charles V wanted and refused to grant England's King Henry VIII an annulment of his marriage to Charles V's aunt, Catherine of Aragon. This caused King Henry to break with Rome, leading to the English Reformation. In response to the rise of Protestant ideas both in England and Germany, the Catholic Church promoted Counter – Reformation which led to annexing Rome's Jews to the Ghetto, the Spanish Inquisition and other severe measures throughout the lands still controlled by the Church. *To be continued ... 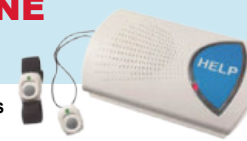
