Mission Appeal Weekend Next Weekend — July 23-24, 2022

Rev. Fr. M.S. Selva Raj from the Diocese of Kumbakoman, India will be at all masses next weekend. The Diocese was started in 1899 in Tamil, Nadu, India with a Catholic population of 213,000 (6% of the population). There are 94 Parishes and 610 missions served by 224 diocesan and 79 religious priests, with 620 nuns, 12 trained catechists and 330 untrained lay catechists and two social workers.

Some of their more pressing needs are:

- ~ Establish 8 new parishes with a new church and a rectory.
- ~ Improve the Facilities of the 136 Catholic Schools and 22 orphanages and provide projectors, videos, books and other religious education materials.
- ~ Assisting 480 nuns and 4955 Catholic Teachers in charge of education, medical and social ministries throughout the region.
- ~ work with hospital for lepers, children of HIV patients, aid for hearing impaired children.
- ~ Education for more young men in the Seminary. On average 120 young men and women go from this Diocese to other missions and religious orders.
- ~ education of 4800 poor or orphan children, and giving them free room and board to keep them from being child labor victims.

80% of all the above is funded through Mission Appeal Programs like the one being held at our church next weekend.

Fr. Selva Raj will be at all masses next weekend giving us more information about their needs. Next week this bulletin spot will have specific information about what your individual donations can buy for them.

We will have envelopes available at the doors of the church next weekend. Please be sure and pick up an envelope for your donation.

Fin de semana llamado a la misión Próximo fin de semana: 23 y 24 de julio de 2022

Rev. Padre. EM. Selva Raj de la Diócesis de Kumbakoman, India estará en todas las misas el próximo fin de semana. La Diócesis se inició en 1899 en Tamil, Nadu, India, con una población católica de 213.000 (el 6% de la población). Hay 94 parroquias y 610 misiones atendidas por 224 sacerdotes diocesanos y 79 religiosos, con 620 monjas, 12 catequistas capacitados y 330 catequistas laicos no capacitados y dos trabajadores sociales.

Algunas de sus necesidades más apremiantes son:

- ~ Establecer 8 nuevas parroquias con una nueva iglesia y una rectoría.
- ~ Mejorar las Instalaciones de las 136 Escuelas Católicas y 22 orfanatos y proporcionar proyectores, videos, libros y otros materiales de educación religiosa.
- ~ Asistir a 480 monjas y 4955 Maestros Católicos a cargo de los ministerios de educación, medicina y sociales en toda la región.
- ~ trabajo con hospital para leprosos, hijos de pacientes con VIH, ayuda para niños con discapacidad auditiva.
- ~ Educación para más jóvenes en el Seminario. En promedio 120 hombres y mujeres jóvenes van de esta diócesis a otras misiones y órdenes religiosas.
- ~ educación de 4800 niños pobres o huérfanos, y alojamiento y comida gratis para evitar que sean víctimas del trabajo infantil.

El 80% de todo lo anterior se financia a través de los Programas de Campaña Misionera como el que se llevará a cabo en nuestra iglesia el próximo fin de semana.

Padre Selva Raj estará en todas las misas el próximo fin de semana brindándonos más información sobre sus necesidades. La próxima semana, este espacio de boletín tendrá información específica sobre lo que sus donaci ones individuales pueden comprar para ellos.






VATICAN CORNER ...continued So how did the world end up with Vatican City, the

smallest country, which you can walk around its perimeter in about 40 minutes? Well the army of Italy and King Victor Emmanuel III had forced the pope and his army into the Vatican and then for 59 years from 1870 to 1929 five popes remained voluntarily secluded in the Vatican and refused to legitimize the Italian government or its rights to the Papal States, which covered an area of approximately 3 million people. Benito Mussolini, prime minister for King Emmanuel III recognized that 97% of Italy was Catholic and the majority of the Italians wanted peace with the Church. He decided it made sense to find a way to rule in harmony with the Church. After two and a half years of negotiations, Mussolini and Pope Pius XI signed the Lateran Treaty and Lateran Pacts named after the



Lateran Palace where the signing took place. Among the agreements, the Holy See acknowledged the legitimacy of the Italian government and its right to the Papal States, with Rome as the capital of Italy. The Vatican was financially compensated with the equivalent of about \$92 million dollar. Vatican City was created and designated a sovereign nation, independent from Italy, with the pope the head of state. Catholicism became the religion of Italy; marriage laws were placed under the rule of the Church, and Catholic religious training was included in every school. Italy agreed to build and fund a train station, a telephone and telegraph office, a radio station and a post office for Vatican City. Certain buildings outside the Vatican walls that were traditionally part of the Church were returned to the Church. As a precondition to the agreement the destruction of the Catholic Italian Popular Party was required. Pope Pius XI disliked political Catholicism because he could not control it and he believed that democracy would be brought into the Church. The end of the Catholic Italian Popular Party caused Catholic to move to the Fascist Party, and as a result, the collapse of democracy in Italy. As part of the Treaty, the Catholic clergy was not to take part in any Italian politics and each bishop would have to take a vow so stating. The nomination of new bishops was to be reviewed by the Italian government. Mussolini and others were convinced that by the Lateran Treaty isolating the pope's rule to Vatican City and its 109 acres, it would greatly reduce the pope's influence on political issues. But instead the pope today is considered both a world leader with considerable influence and a spiritual leader of Roman Catholics encompassing over a billion people. He is hugely popular and widely influential among Catholics and non-Catholics. The Vatican has been able to promote its doctrines all over the world, influencing international bodies such as the United Nations and it has participated in many world conferences on social and economic issues, conflict negotiations and treaties. Even though there have been revisions to the original Lateran Pacts, they remain in effect even today. An Italian comedienne discovered in 2008 that her joke about the Pope was an offence covered under the Lateran Pacts. It could have brought her five years in prison for public insults against the pope, but in the end she was forgiven.
