

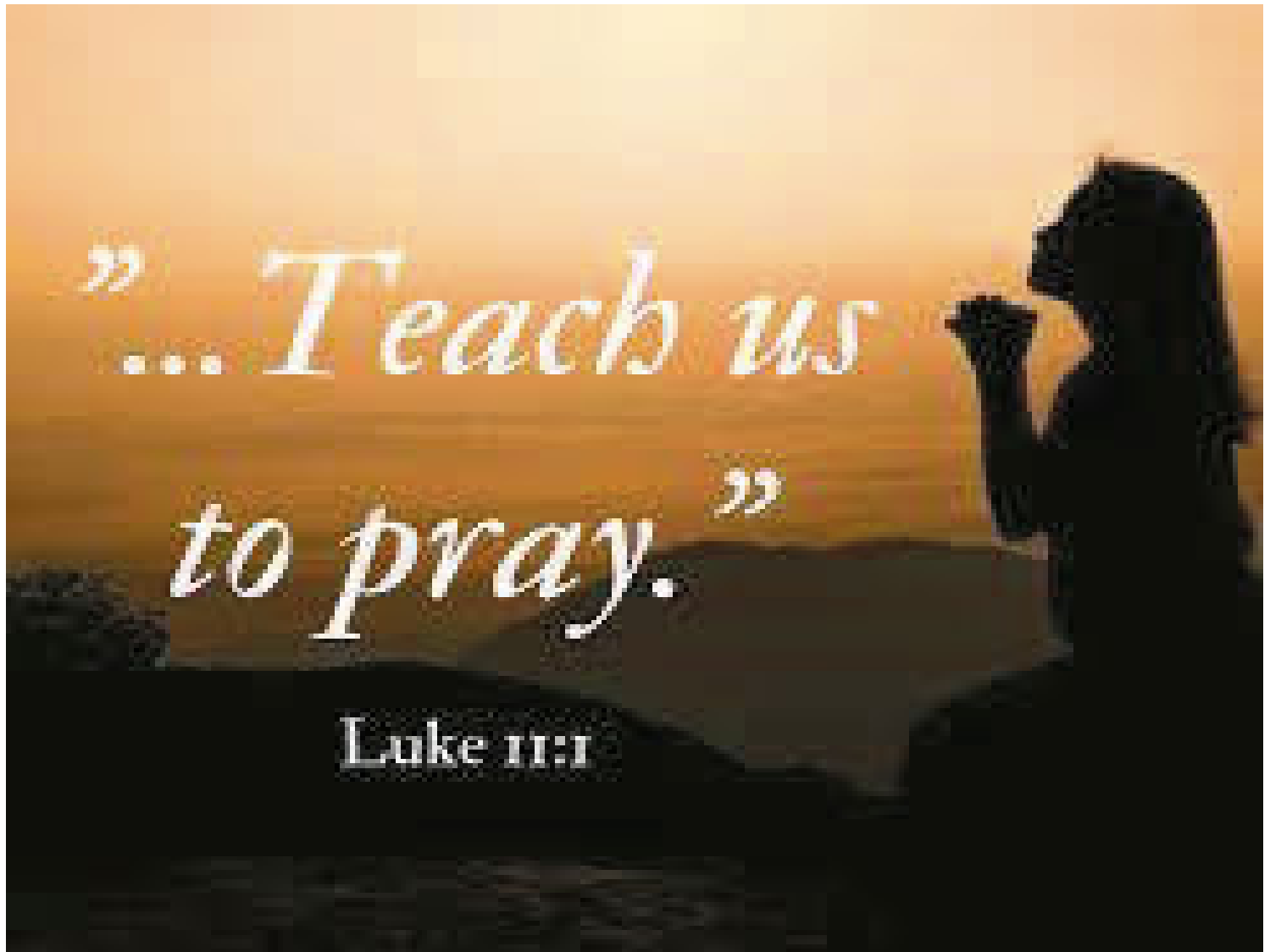

Mission Appeal Weekend *This Weekend — July 23-24, 2022*

Today we will hear from Rev. Fr. M.S. Selva Raj from the Diocese of Kumbakoman, India. He will tell us more about his Diocese and the needs of that Diocese.

Many times we wonder if we donate, what will they be able to buy with what I can donate? Rev. Selva has shared with us some of the things that they can buy with our donations.

This is what he has told us:

- ~~ \$20 will feed a poor child or an orphan for a month
- ~~ \$500 will educate a physically challenged child (annual donation)
- ~~ \$600 will pay the bill for healthcare and family maintenance for a leprosy patient for one year
- ~~ \$50 will enable a single mother or widow to feed a family of three for one month
- ~~ \$900 will provide a grocery store, and employment to feed a family of 10 with elderly parents or grandparents
- ~~ \$100 for monthly pay for a catechist
- ~~ \$250 will provide four goats to maintain a family of four
- ~~ \$700 will fix the roof of a poor man's hut
- ~~ \$800 will provide a cow to feed an entire family of five or more
- ~~ \$1000 for treatment and rehabilitation of a leper
- ~~ \$2000 to sponsor a seminarian for a year
- ~~ \$6000 for a home for a family
- ~~ \$25000 will build a mission chapel

- ~~ \$900 proporcionará una tienda de comestibles y empleo para alimentar a una familia de 10 con padres o abuelos ancianos
- ~~ \$100 de pago mensual para un catequista
- ~~ \$250 proporcionarán cuatro cabras para mantener una familia de cuatro
- ~~ \$700 arreglarán el techo de la choza de un hombre pobre
- ~~ \$800 proporcionarán una vaca para alimentar a toda una familia de cinco o más
- ~~ \$1000 para el tratamiento y rehabilitación de un leproso
- ~~ \$2000 para patrocinar a un seminarista por un año
- ~~ \$6000 para una casa para una familia
- ~~ \$25000 construirá una capilla de misión

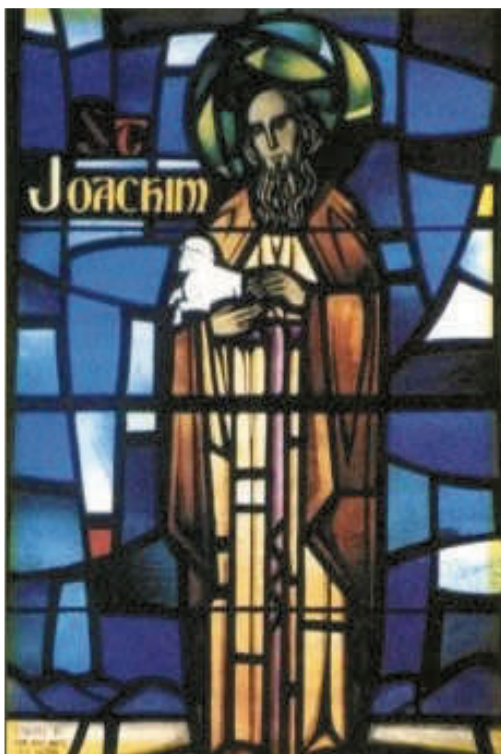

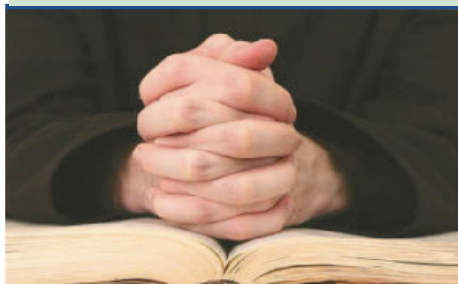

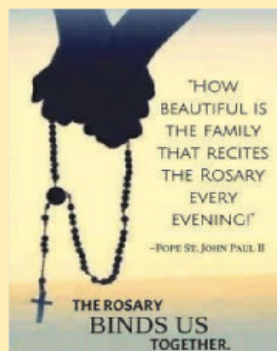
VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis has been



interviewed several times in 2022 and has said some interesting and profound things. In his first television talk show appearance on February 6, 2022, on the Italian show *Che Tempo Che Fa*, he told host Fabio Fazio that he did not feel that he was holy enough to live in the Apostolic Palace. He said “that’s one of the reasons why I chose not to live in the papal apartment, because the popes who were there before were saints, and I couldn’t have done it. I’m not that holy. I need human relationships – that’s why I live in the hotel, Santa Marta, where there are people who talk to everyone, you find friends. It’s an easier life for me.” Speaking about the production and sale of weapons, he said “think that in a year without making weapons, you could give food and education to the whole world for free. We see how economies are mobilized and what is most important today is war: ideological warfare, of power, trade warfare, and lots of arms factories. War is always destruction.” Francis was asked why the innocent suffer. He said that he was himself scandalized in the face of children’s suffering. “Why do children suffer?” I find no explanation for this. I have faith, I try to love God who is my Father, but I ask myself: ‘But why do children suffer?’ ... Hatred, destruction are in the hands of another who sowed evil in the world through envy,” adding that God allowed his own Son to be killed” ... “Why do children suffer? I find only one way: to suffer with them. And for me Dostoevsky was a great teacher in this.” Francis was referring to the Russian author of “*Crime and Punishment*” and “*The Brothers Karamazov*,” both books often acclaimed as supreme achievements in world literature. In an interview on June 20, 2022 by Bernarda Llorente, the president of *Télam*, the Argentine news agency, he was asked if he felt he had changed during his papacy. The Pope said he was told by several people “that things that were dormant in my personality came to the surface: that I became more merciful.” He said “in my life I had rigid periods, when I demanded too much. Then I realized that this is not the way to go, that you have to know how to lead. It means having that paternity that God has” with his children. As a bishop, I was a little more benevolent, but when I was a Jesuit (priest), I was very severe.” Pope Francis said he is not worried about whether his words will change people, but he is more concerned “about speaking out and helping people change themselves.” He did acknowledge that at times he is misunderstood or his words or actions are taken out of context. Francis gave as an example a statement he made during a May meeting with editors of Jesuit magazines in which he said he was against turning discussions about the war in Ukraine “into a distinction between good guys and bad guys.” Some people he said “took that statement alone and said, “The pope does not condemn Putin (Russia’s President!)” *to be continued ... 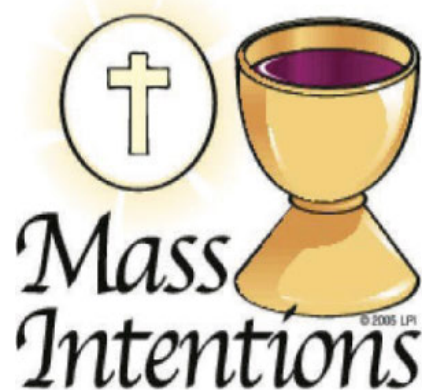

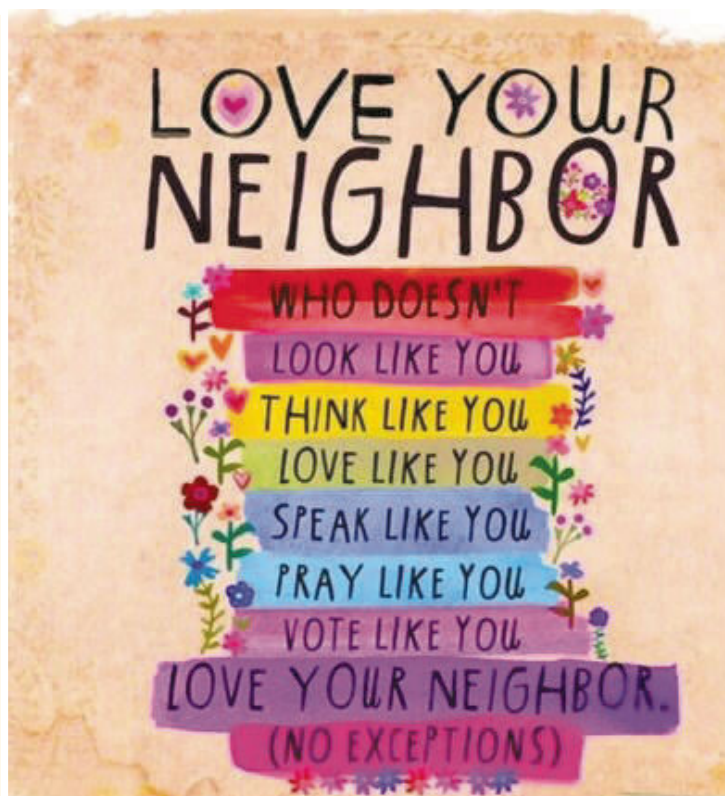

St. Joachim & St Anne ~ Feast Day July 26th

St. Joachim is the father of the Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus.

St. Joachim and his wife, St. Anne, prayed fervently for many years that they would be blessed with a child in spite of their advancing age.

According to tradition, an angel appeared to St. Joachim in a vision one day when he was away from home. The angel promised that the holy couple's prayers would be answered. When St. Joachim returned home, his wife told him that an angel had also appeared to her to bestow the same good news.

St. Joachim is the patron saint of fathers, grandfathers, grandparents, linen traders, cabinet makers and married couples. He is often pictured in art as an older man with St. Anne and the Virgin Mary at his side. He also is often shown holding a scroll or book to represent linen makers or with doves to represent peace. His name in Hebrew means "God prepares."
