

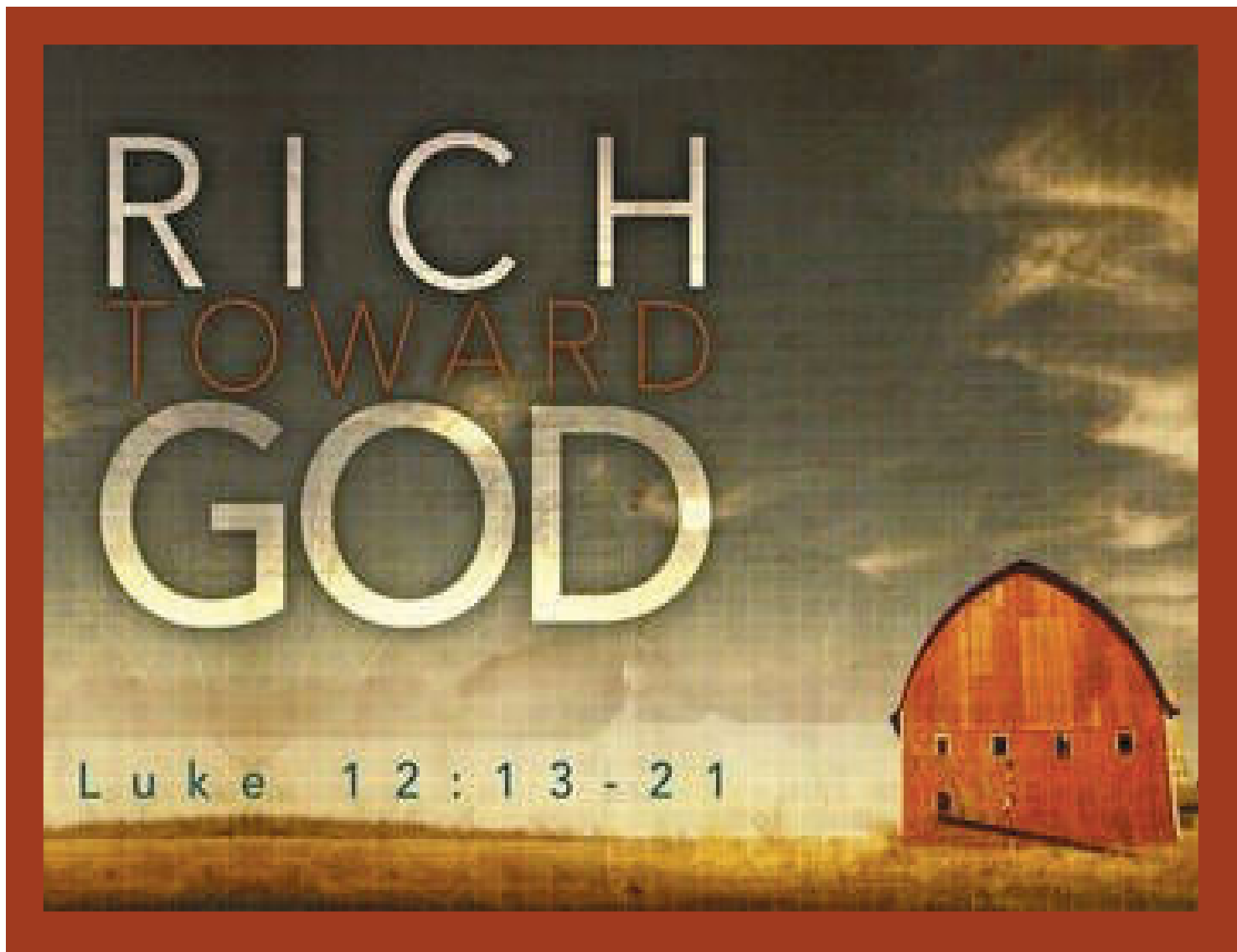

I once knew a godly woman who had truly tasted the bitterness of this earthly life. This woman knew pain. She knew sacrifice. She knew hard labor and loss, including the death of a cherished child. She worked each day at a low-paying job, waiting patiently for her 65th birthday, when she could retire and devote herself full-time to her grandchildren. She crossed off the dwindling days on her calendar like a first grader waiting for Christmas.

Ninety-eight days before she was set to retire, she died suddenly. Her name was erased from the schedule at work and penciled over with that of her replacement hire.

All things are vanity.

I think we all know someone like this, don't we? If the details aren't exactly the same, the outline of the story is: someone labors "with wisdom and knowledge and skill," in the words of Ecclesiastes. And what profit comes to him? Sorrow and grief all his days. The proverbial barn filled with harvest and left to rot.

But I'll let you in on a secret: this isn't a sad story. I've only told you part of it.

This woman heard, daily, the voice of God, and against it she never hardened her heart, whatever news it brought her. This woman loved as hard as she worked. Every action was a form of evangelization. To talk to her was to feel the embrace of Christ.

As much as she waited for that retirement that never came, it was never the harvest in her barn. This is what it means to be a true steward: to seek what is above.

Pero te contaré un secreto: esta no es una historia triste. Solo te he contado una parte.

Esta mujer escuchaba, diariamente, la voz de Dios, y contra ella nunca endureció su corazón, cualquiera que fuera la noticia que le traía. Esta mujer amaba tanto como trabajaba. Cada acción era una forma de evangelización. Hablar con ella era sentir el abrazo de Cristo.

Por más que esperó ese retiro que nunca llegó, nunca fue la cosecha en su granero.

Esto es lo que significa ser un verdadero corresponsable: buscar lo que está arriba.

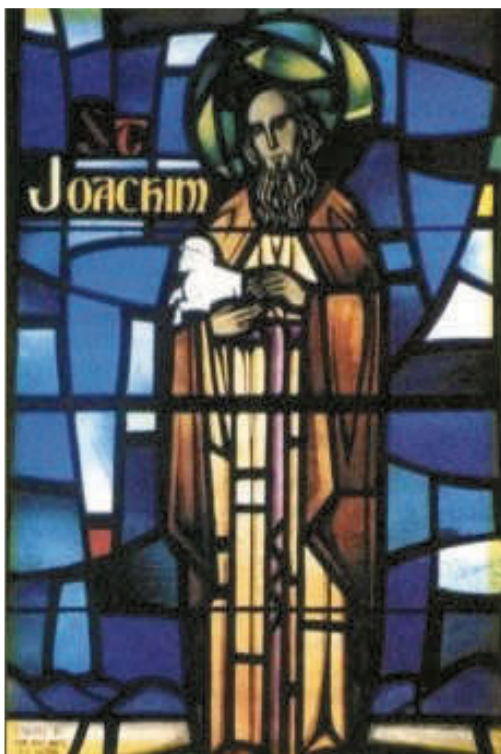

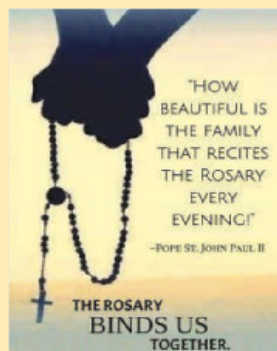
VATICAN CORNER

... continued Pope Francis said he was misunderstood in his May 2022 interview about the war in Ukraine. He said some people said “The Pope does not condemn Putin (Russia’s President)! His full statement had been “The reality is that the state of war is something much more universal, more serious, and here there are no good guys and bad guys. We are all involved and that is what we have to learn.” In a July 4th interview with Reuters, Pope Francis dismissed reports that he plans to resign soon, saying he is going to visit Canada this month and hopes to go to Moscow and Kyiv after that. “The first thing is to go to Russia to try to help in some way” to serve the cause of peace. He also denied rumors that he has cancer. He joked and said his doctors “didn’t tell me anything about it.”



For the first time he gave details about his knee injury. He said he suffered “a small fracture” in the knee when he took a misstep while his ligament was inflamed. Francis said “I am slowly getting better” and the fracture is knitting, helped by laser and magnet therapy. Pope Francis had decided to cancel his planned trip to the Democratic Republic of Congo and South Sudan on doctor’s orders that he rest his knee 20 more days. The cancelled trip caused him “much suffering” he said, because he wanted to promote peace in both countries. Asked about the U.S. Supreme Court’s ruling overturning the Roe v. Wade ruling which established a woman’s right to have an abortion, he said he respected the decision but did not have enough information to speak about it from a judicial point of view. But he strongly condemned abortion, comparing it to “hiring a hit man.” The Catholic Church teaches that life begins at the moment of conception. In an interview which aired in the U.S. on July 11, 2022, Francis spoke to Univision reporters from the Spanish-language network. He was asked his opinion of President Joe Biden’s continuing support for abortion. The Pope said “I leave it to his conscience and that he speaks to his bishop, his pastor, his parish priest about that inconsistency.” But he repeated what he had said before about bishops declaring a politician unfit to receive Communion, he said bishops must focus on the pastoral care of their people rather than on public condemnation.” Regarding preventing mass shootings, he said the solution cannot be achieved by “looking at the effects; we must look at the causes...why are there young people who are so unsatisfied that they can feel fulfilled only by destroying?” Pope Francis said that before his election in 2013, he had made plans to retire as archbishop of Buenos Aires at the end of the year. He had already chosen a room at a retirement home for priests about five blocks from his boyhood parish. He planned to hear confessions and visit the sick and “be at the service of people where needed. If I survive, I would like something like that, but it would be in Rome, not his native Argentina.” The interviewer reminded Francis that he had been wrong when he said he expected to have a short pontificate, the Pope replied, “The same thing used to happen to me whenever I bought a lottery ticket!”

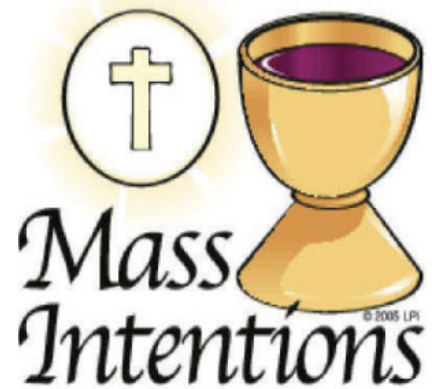

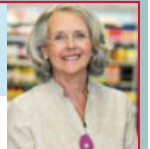
