

How to make a good Confession. part three ~ Steps in the Rite of Reconciliation

1. Begin by making the Sign of the Cross and greeting the priest. "Bless me Father, for I have sinned."
2. Then continue: " My last confession was..."(weeks, month, or years)
3. Confess your sins to the priest. He will help you make a good confession. If you are unsure of how to confess or you feel uneasy, ask him to help you. Answer his questions without hiding anything out of fear or shame. Place your trust in God, a merciful Father who wants to forgive you.
4. Following your confession of sins, say: I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest will assign you a penance and offer advice to help you vbe a better Catholic. The penance imposed will take into account your personal situation and support your spiritual good. It may be a prayer, an offering, works of mercy, service, or sacrifice; but it joins us in some way to Christ and to the cross.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing sorrow for your sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then will absolve you from your sins by saying the prayer of Absolution, to which you make the Sign of the Cross and respond, "Amen".
8. The priest will offer some proclamation of praise, such as Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, to which you respond, "His mercy endures forever."
9. Then the priest will dismiss you. Because sin often harms others you must make satisfaction for your sins by completing your assigned penance.



The humility required in confessing and completing penance helps us to submit again to God's will and follow Him more closely. Confession is a blessing, offering peace, a clear mind, and a hopeful heart.

Cómo hacer una buena confesión. tercera parte

~ Pasos en el Rito de la Reconciliación

1. Comience haciendo la Señal de la Cruz y saludando al sacerdote.
"Bendígame Padre, porque he pecado."
2. Luego continúe: "Mi última confesión fue..." (semanas, meses o años)
3. Confiesa tus pecados al sacerdote. Él te ayudará a hacer una buena confesión. Si no está seguro de cómo confesarse o se siente incómodo, pídale que lo ayude. Responda a sus preguntas sin esconder nada por miedo o vergüenza. Deposite su confianza en Dios, Padre misericordioso que nos quiere perdonar.
4. Después de tu confesión de pecados, di: Lo siento por estos y todos mis pecados".
5. El sacerdote te asignará una penitencia y te ofrecerá consejos para ayudarte a ser un mejor católico. La penitencia impuesta tendrá en cuenta su situación personal y apoyará su bien espiritual. Puede ser una oración, una ofrenda, obras de misericordia, servicio o sacrificio; pero nos une de alguna manera a Cristo ya la cruz.
6. Diga un Acto de Contrición, expresando dolor por sus pecados.
7. El sacerdote, actuando en la persona de Cristo, os absuelve entonces de nuestros pecados rezando la oración de la Absolución, a la que se hace la Señal de la cruz y se responde: "Amén".
8. El sacerdote ofrecerá algún pregón de alabanza, como Dad gracias al Señor, porque es bueno, a lo que responderás: "Para siempre es su misericordia".
9. Entonces el sacerdote te despedirá. Debido a que el pecado a menudo daña a otros, debes hacer satisfacción por tus pecados completando la penitencia asignada.

La humildad necesaria para confesarse y hacer penitencia nos ayuda a someternos nuevamente a la voluntad de Dios y a seguirlo más de cerca. La confesión es una bendición, que ofrece paz, una mente clara y un corazón lleno de esperanza.

VATICAN CORNER

The Vatican Museums

are ranked the fourth most-visited art museums in the world, with No. 1: the Louvre in Paris, No. 2 the National Museum of China in Beijing, and No. 3 the Tate Modern in London. It is said that the Vatican Museums house the most important and largest art collection in the world. The 70,000 pieces of artwork were gathered by the Popes over the centuries and 20,000 of them are on display in 54 galleries, with some works being priceless masterpieces that are internationally recognized. There are

800 Museum employees. Normally, 6 million people a year come to visit the four miles of exhibits, however because of the pandemic and the months of closure, the year 2020 had just 1.3 million visitors and 2021 had only 613,000. Behind the scenes at the Museums there are many people working to monitor the daily flow of visitors and to maintain the security of the facilities. A control room with 40 screens shows video surveillance of the public areas and the warehouses, and there are computer displays of data from metal detectors, turn-style counters, and alarms. At 7:00 AM before the Museums open, the Gendarmeria (Vatican police) hand over the supervision of the telecameras to the Museum control room employees. One of their important jobs in the last years is to try to regulate the flow of tourists to prevent crowding. If the control room observes someone sick or the guards report a medical problem, they can have a doctor to the site within 5 minutes. There is much collaboration between the Museum's Technical Services Department, the Vatican's Telecommunications Department and the Gendarmeria. The use of computers and fiber optic cable for managing the Museums has become very important, but there is still no substitute for the guards in their blue uniforms. There are 240 guards with 18 department heads and 3 deputy chiefs. The guards are an essential point of reference for tourists, and especially for the elderly, expectant mothers, children, and the disable. The guards perform tasks like ticket and Covid-pass control, guard the works of art, first aid interventions and security. Other Museum workers such as the cleaning staff and the food service employees all do their part to make the Museums well run and enjoyable visit. Remember to wear comfortable shoes because you could be there for hours or days. It is a paradox that because of the tragedy of the pandemic, the Museums finds themselves often without crowds, and therefore it is one of the best times ever to visit the Museums.





