# Proper Way of Receiving Holy Communion

- 1. Observe 1 HOUR FASTING before the time of Holy Mass.
- 2. When leaving your pew/seat, you do so reverently with your hands folded/crossed and you approach the altar in silence., reflecting on Whom you are about to receive, never greeting anyone along the way.
- As you come to the Priest/.Minister, bow slightly then you receive the Body of Christ in one of the two ways
- A). Create a cross with your hands held at chest level with one hand under the other—The Priest/ Minister will hold the Body of Christ in front of you and say "The Body of Christ:" you reply with "Amen" They will place Jesus on the cross you have made with your hands,. You step slightly to the side, If wearing a mask, remove your mask from one side/ear, then take that hand to pick up the Body of Christ to place in your mouth, then replace your mask and return to your seat. If not wearing a mask you still step to the side to receive the Body of Christ. You should not start walking until you have placed the Body of Christ in your mouth.
- B) To receive the Body of Christ in your mouth, we request that you go only to the Priest and to be last in his line. When approaching the Priest you keep your hands crossed/folded —The Priest will hold the Body of Christ in front of you and say "The Body of Christ: you reply with "Amen" then immediately open your mouth wide and stick your tongue out far enough to create a plate for him to place the Body of Christ on, far enough out so the Body of Christ will not fall off your tongue.
- 4. You return to your place with your hands folded and in silence, You do not acknowledge or greet anyone as you return to your seat. When you arrive at your place, this is a time for you to pray and to reflect and thank Jesus for coming into your life through the Holy Eucharist.

### Forma correcta de recibir la Sagrada Comunión

- 1. Observe 1 HORA DE AYUNO antes de la hora de la Santa Misa.
- 2. Al dejar su banco/asiento, hàgalo con reverencia con las manos cruzadas y se acerca al altar en silencio, reflexionando sobre a quién está a punto de recibir, sin saludar nunca a nadie en el camino.
- 3. Cuando se acerque al Sacerdote/Ministro, inclínese levemente y luego reciba el Cuerpo de Cristo en una de las dos maneras
- A). Cree una cruz con las manos a la altura del pecho con una mano debajo de la otra: el sacerdote/ministro sostendrá el Cuerpo de Cristo frente a usted y dirá "El Cuerpo de Cristo": usted responde con "Amén" Colocarán a Jesús en la cruz que has hecho con tus manos,. Da un paso ligeramente hacia un lado. Si usa una máscara, quítese el cubrebocas de un lado/oreja, luego tome esa mano para levantar el Cuerpo de Cristo y colocarlo en su boca, luego vuelva a colocar el cubrebocas y regrese a su asiento. Si no usa un cubrebocas, todavía se hace a un lado para recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo. No debe comenzar a caminar hasta que haya colocado el Cuerpo de Cristo en su boca.
- B) Para recibir el Cuerpo de Cristo en su boca, le pedimos que vaya solo al Sacerdote y sea el último en su línea. Cuando se acerque al Sacerdote, mantenga las manos en signo de oracion. Sacerdote sostendrá el Cuerpo de Cristo frente a usted y dirá "El Cuerpo de Cristo: responda con "Amén", luego inmediatamente abra bien la boca y saque la lengua. lo suficiente para crear un plato para que él coloque el Cuerpo de Cristo, lo suficientemente lejos para que el Cuerpo de Cristo no se te caiga de la lengua.
- 4. Regrese a su lugar con las manos cruzadas y en silencio, no salude a nadie cuando regresa a su asiento. Cuando llegue a su lugar, este es un momento para que ore y reflexione y agradezca a Jesús por llegar a su vida a través de la Sagrada Eucaristía.





### **VATICAN CORNER**

In the vear

1294 after two years of stalemate over trying to elect a new pope, the cardinals agreed on an 80 year old Benedictine monk/hermit living in a remote mountainous cave. Bishops took him the news but he did not want to accept, and tried to flee. On August 29, 1294 he was crowned Pope Celestine V in the city of L'Aquila about 70 miles northeast of Rome. More than 200,000 people attending his crowning which included kings and nobles. His first action as pope was to declare that anyone having confessed their sins



and sincerely repented them and visited the Basilica of Santa Maria di Collemaggio in L'Aquila between sunsets on August 28th thru 29th (the feast of the St. John the Baptist) would receive a plenary indulgence. It is a grace granted by the Church through Jesus, Mary and the saints to remove punishment for sins. At the time it was unheard of to make such a grant without being tied to Church payment. That is why the Celestinian Forgiveness as it eventually was called is the first jubilee. Pope Celestine V turned out to be a poor leader, he resigned after only 5 month, was put in prison by his successor Pope Boniface VIII for fear that he could become an antipope for his opponents. Celestine died in prison after ten months, was canonized and buried in that Basilica. On August 28, 2022, Pope Francis traveled to L'Aquila by helicopter and participated in the centuries-old tradition of the Celestinian Forgiveness. Pope Francis said in his homily at the Basilica "To be forgiven is to experience here and now what comes closest to the resurrection. Forgiveness is passing from death to life, from the experience of anguish and guilt to that of freedom and joy. May this church always be a place where we can be reconciled, and experience that grace that puts us back on our feet and gives us another chance." Francis visited the city's cathedral which is being reconstructed after an earthquake in 2009 when more than 300 people died. He wore a hardhat and greeted the family members of the earthquake victims from his wheelchair. He held an outdoor Mass and prayed for peace. Francis said he wanted L'Aquila to become a "capital of forgiveness, peace and reconciliation. Speaking of Pope Celestine V he praised his humility and courage. He said "Indeed, there is no other way to accomplish God's will than by assuming the strength of the humble, there is no other way. Precisely because they are so, the humble appear weak and losers in the eyes of men, but in reality they are the true winners, for they are the only ones who trust completely in the Lord and know his will." Pope Francis opened the Holy Door in the basilica, the first pope to do so in 728 years. He was wheeled through the basilica to the tomb of Pope Celestine V, and he said a silent prayer there before his papal predecessor who was declared a saint in 1313. Francis said "humility causes us to look away from ourselves and turn our gaze to God, the One who can do everything and also obtains for us what we cannot have on our own. 'Everything is possible for those who believe (Mark 9:23)." Source: catholicnewagency.com
