## VATICAN CORNER

A little known but once highly influential fifth-century theologian is someone Pope Francis often references in his speeches, documents and interviews. He is the French monk – St. Vincent of Lérins who is known more for his writings than for himself. He was an officer in the army who became disgusted with the vanity and folly of military life, and took shelter in religion. He retreated from the crowds and retired on the small remote Mediterranean island of Lérins, off the French Riviera, where he attended solely to the study of God in order to know him. One of the Pope’s favorite quotes of St. Vincent is “That Christian doctrine should follow the true and legitimate rule of progress, so doctrine may be consolidated by years, enlarged by time, refined by age.” Pope Francis has explained that what this quote means is that the teaching of the Church, its scripture and sacred traditions can develop and grow in the expression and awareness of the faith and in morals “while always remaining faithful to its roots.” As explained by U.S. Monsignor and professor emeritus of theology -Thomas G. Guarino, he said like all popes, Pope Francis has the difficult task of protecting Church doctrine and keeping it in full accord with the Gospel, while encouraging legitimate growth and progress. Pope Francis speaking on this difficult balancing act, warned against a perverted sense of tradition, an insidious sin he calls “backwardism.” Francis said “People who look to the past do not go forward with the Church; they lack the root of tradition, which provides life-giving nourishment for growth and development.” He said Tradition properly understood is “the root of inspiration for the Church to go forward, not backward. Tradition “is always open, like the roots of the tree, and that is how the tree grows.” An example of this growing of doctrine was in Vatican II, where the council did not change anything in the traditional teaching about the infallibility of the pope, but added teaching about the infallibility of the college of bishops when teaching together with the pope. This was real progress while maintaining prior teaching. In St. Vincent’s writings he placed great emphasis on the body of bishops throughout the world and particularly when they gather together in a council or synod. Pope Francis has taken that emphasis to new heights with his promotion of synodality, the listening to the entire church. Monsignor Guarino says that Pope Francis seems to rely on this fifth-century monk, not only to guide proper doctrinal development but to help church members navigate the world, steering far from the two extremes of an errant, unecclisial drive for change on the one side and a dead nostalgia for fruitless tradition on the other side. Guarino said that St. Vincent of Lérins is probably the most thoughtful of all the ancient Christian writers when it comes to growth, development and progress. *Source: catholicnewsworld.com, catholicnewsagency.com, cruxnow.com*

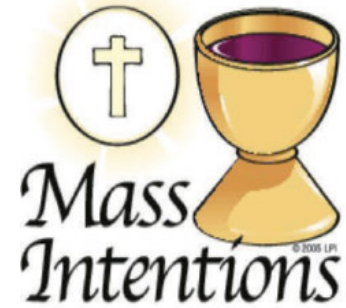
