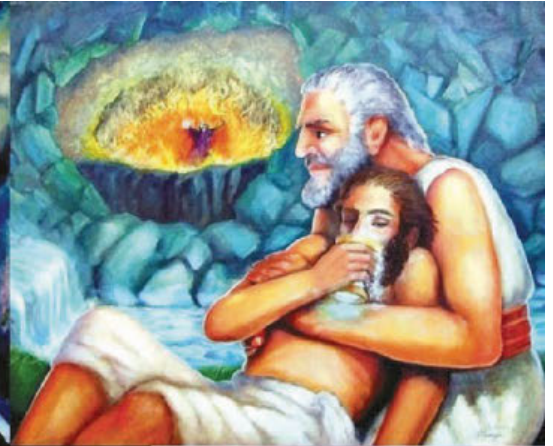

## Common Mistakes Catholics Make during Mass

*Continued from last week ...*

**4. Genuflecting with the left knee—**During the passion of Christ, the Roman soldiers knelt with their left knee to Jesus, but they were actually mocking Him. Catholics genuflect, that is kneel with their right knee as a sign of respect to the Holy Eucharist. Some Catholics often make the mistake of genuflecting with their left knee which is totally wrong.

**5. One hour fasting before receiving the Holy communion—**before, the Church required fasting for 24 hours before receiving the Holy Communion. But this change was introduced in the 2nd Vatican Council—that is 1 hour fasting before receiving the Holy Communion. Elderly or senior Catholics are exempt from this.

**6. Meeting the Priest for blessing immediately after the Mass —**The priest has already pronounced the words of blessing in the Mass at the concluding Rite just before the end of the Mass. So there is no need meeting him for personal blessings after he has recessed out of the Church. Except when you have religious articles to be blessed, you may simply go directly at the entrance of the sacristy and let the ministers/volunteers know that you have religious articles to be blessed.

**7. Leaving the Church before the Priest —** It is appropriate for you to wait for the priest to completely recess out of the Church before you can follow suite; but unfortunately, many Catholics leave the Mass immediately after the post communion prayer; and some immediately after receiving the Holy Communion and still some immediately after the Mass while the priest is yet to leave.

**Let us be Catholics in practice not just by mere words.**

## Errores comunes que cometen los católicos durante la misa

*Continuación de la semana pasada...*

**4. Hacer una genuflexión con la rodilla izquierda—**Durante la pasión de Cristo, los soldados romanos se arrodillaron con la rodilla izquierda ante Jesús, pero en realidad se estaban burlando de Él. Los católicos hacen genuflexión, es decir, se arrodillan con la rodilla derecha en señal de respeto a la Sagrada Eucaristía. Algunos católicos a menudo cometen el error de hacer una genuflexión con la rodilla izquierda, lo cual es totalmente incorrecto.

**5. Una hora de ayuno antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión—**antes, la Iglesia requería un ayuno de 24 horas antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Pero este cambio se introdujo en el Concilio Vaticano II, es decir, 1 hora de ayuno antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Los ancianos o católicos mayores están exentos de esto.

**6. Reunión con el Sacerdote para la bendición inmediatamente después de la Misa:** el sacerdote ya ha pronunciado las palabras de bendición en la Misa en el Rito de clausura justo antes del final de la Misa. Por lo tanto, no es necesario reunirse con él para recibir bendiciones personales después de que haya terminado, fuera de la Iglesia. Excepto cuando tenga artículos religiosos para ser bendecidos, simplemente puede ir directamente a la entrada de la sacristía e informar a los ministros/voluntarios que tiene artículos religiosos para ser bendecidos.

**7. Salir de la Iglesia antes que el Sacerdote:** es apropiado que espere a que el sacerdote se retire por completo de la Iglesia antes de que pueda seguir ustedes; pero desafortunadamente, muchos católicos abandonan la misa inmediatamente después de la oración posterior a la comunión; algunos inmediatamente después de recibir la Sagrada Comunión y otros inmediatamente después de la Misa mientras el sacerdote aún no se ha ido.

**Seamos católicos en la práctica, no sólo de palabra.**

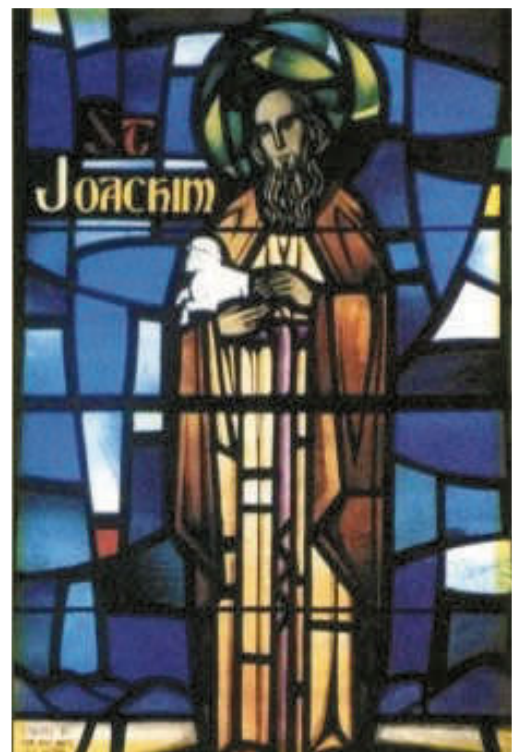

# VOTE “NO” ON PROPOSITION 1

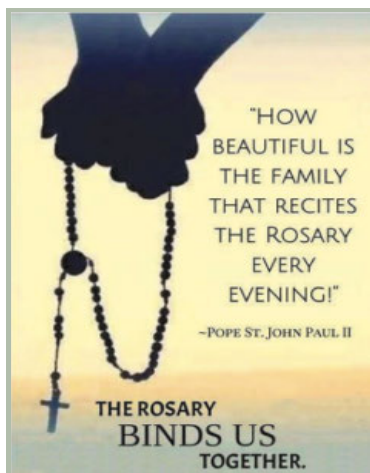
## VATICAN CORNER

Polish Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, the Papal Almoner, who is responsible for performing works of mercy on behalf of the Pope, is on his fourth trip to deliver aid to Ukraine. A statement released on Sept. 9, 2022 said he would be visiting the cities of Odesa, Zhytomyr, Kharkiv and other locations, but specifics of how and when he would be traveling was not given out probably for security reasons. The statement said he would be visiting “various communities of faithful, priests, and religious, and their bishops, who for more than 200 days continue to remain in the places of their ministry despite the dangers of war.”



The war has brought death and destruction to Ukraine, a nation of 41 million people, with more than a quarter of them forced to become refugees in other countries, or are displaced within their own country. The Cardinal’s purpose is “to be with the people who are suffering, praying and comforting each of them, showing with his presence that they are not alone in this situation that is only bringing destruction and death.” He will also be delivering food and supplies through Caritas offices. The Cardinal drove more than 2,000 miles from the Vatican to eastern Ukraine in his minibus to deliver the humanitarian aid. On Saturday September 17, 2022, the Cardinal with the help of a Catholic Bishop, a Protestant Bishop, and a Ukrainian soldier loaded up the minibus and drove to the frontlines of the war, an area he said “no one besides soldiers enter anymore” because of the heavy firing. It was near the city of Zaporizhzhia, that has the largest nuclear power plant in Europe. The plant had been off-line for almost a week as a precaution due to the heavy fighting, but was back in operation when Cardinal Krajewski was there. The goal was to bring supplies of food and other aid to people trapped in the no-man’s land at the front lines. However, they drove into a zone controlled by Russian soldiers and came under fire from light weapons. The minibus was hit with bullets. The Cardinal and the others ran for cover and were not hurt. After the incident he said “For the first time in my life I didn’t know where to run ... because it’s not enough to run. You have to know where to go.” Afterward, he and the others continued their deliveries in the minibus. Rosaries that had been blessed by the Pope were also items given out. The people receiving would put them around their necks. That Saturday Sept. 17th was the ninth anniversary of when Pope Francis chose him as the Papal Almoner and when his episcopal ordination as a bishop took place in at St. Peter’s Basilica, with Pope Francis presence. For the Papal Almoner it was quite a special day. After being shot at, he said “we can only pray and repeat: ‘Jesus, I trust in you.’”

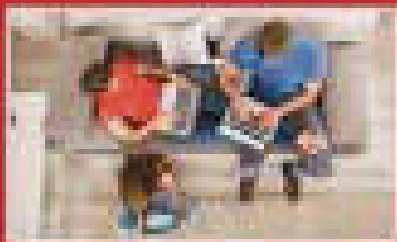
## A PRAYER FOR PRIESTS

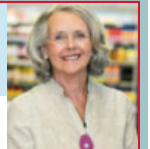
