

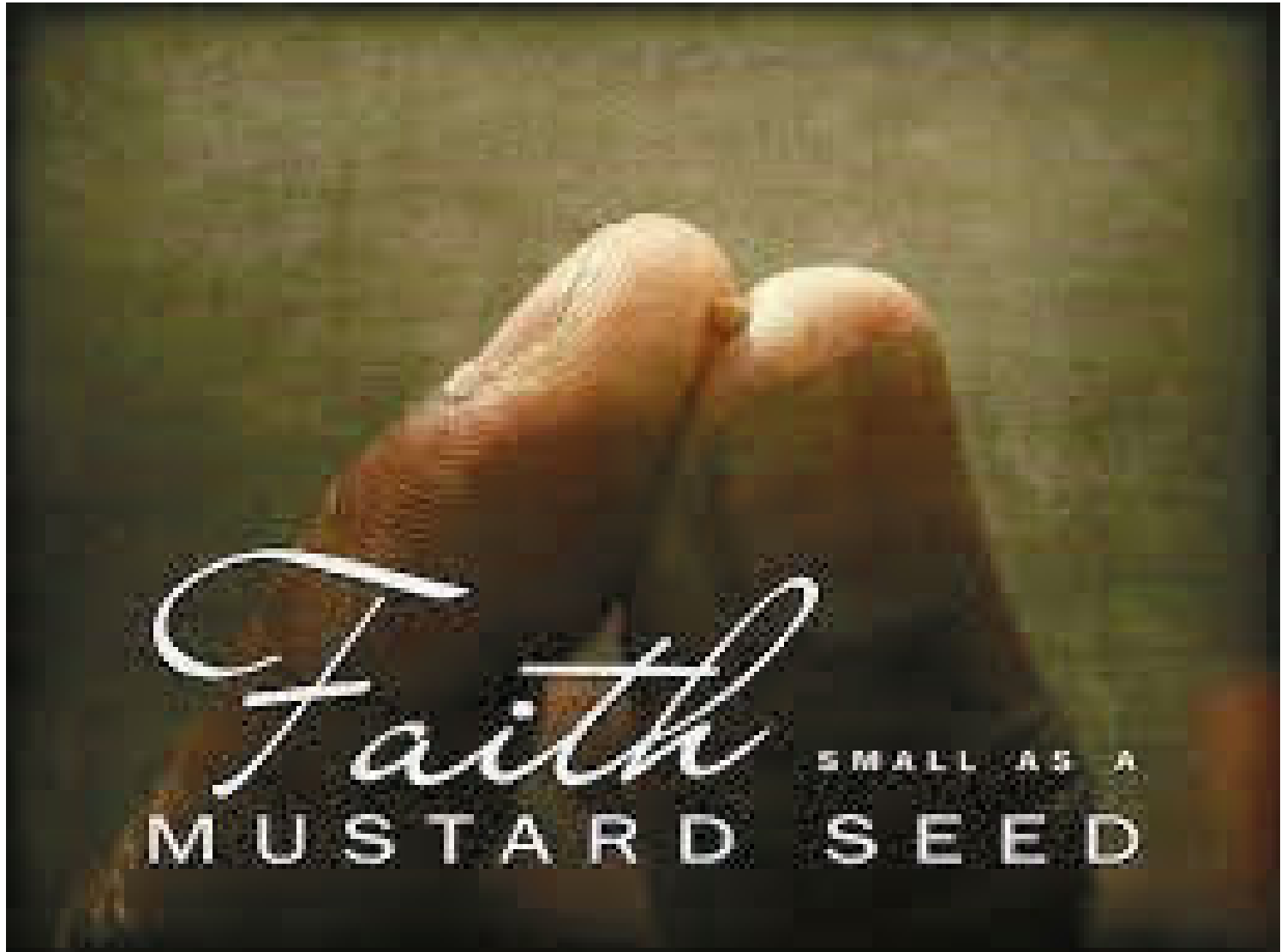

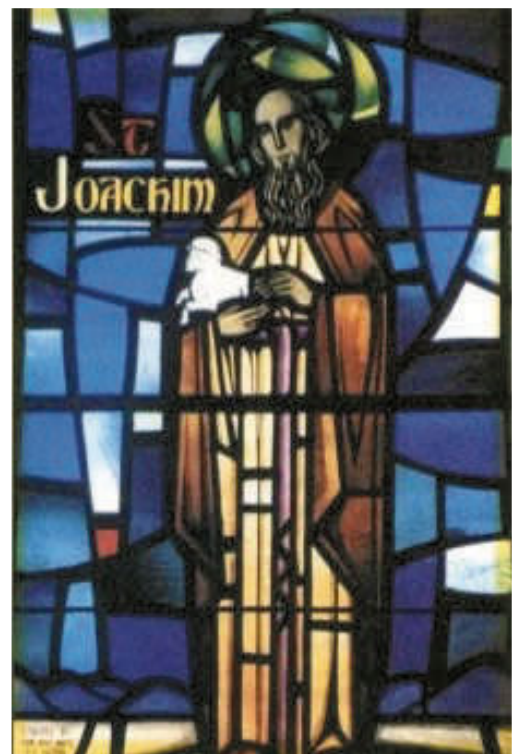

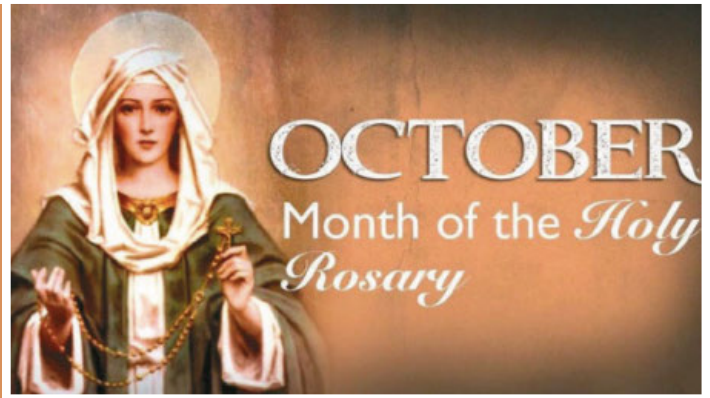

VATICAN CORNER

Every night from Oct. 2 thru Oct. 16, 2022, between 9 p.m. and 11 p.m., visitors to the Vatican will be able to see an 8-minute-long video projected onto the face of St. Peter's Basilica. It will tell the story of St. Peter, the Church's first pope. This is one of several initiatives the Vatican has been working



on in preparation for the 2025 Jubilee Year. Every 25 years the Jubilee is held as a celebration and a time of forgiveness and reconciliation. The Vatican is expecting 30 million people to come during the Jubilee Year to this place of St. Peter's tomb. The video will welcome everyone by projecting Renaissance artworks of St. Peter which are located in the Vatican Museums and in the Basilica. Cardinal Mauro Gambetti, the archpriest of the Basilica said "We think that people will be guided by the example of Peter to encounter the Lord and their brothers and sisters, to live their experience as pilgrims, and to leave renewed.

People wonder how the center of the Catholic Church ended up in Rome rather than in the Holy Land. Jerusalem after the crucifixion was torn in two and the followers of Christ believed that their fledgling Church became the New Israel. After the death of Jesus, the Old Testament prophesies about Jerusalem were finally understood as a reference to God's people rather than the actual city of Jerusalem. That meant that the religious center of Christ's followers could be located somewhere better for the new struggling Church. But it didn't mean that there is no historical or spiritual importance to Jerusalem, nor did it deny the Lord's eternal promise to the Jewish people. There was great persecution put on the followers of Christ in Jerusalem. But if there had not been persecution, it is questionable how far the Gospel would have traveled. The persecutions forced the apostles outward into other lands. Jesus wanted the Gospel preached through the entire world. He had said "make disciples of all peoples" (Mat 28:19), and the best way to accomplish this was to go to the communication center of the world which at the time was Rome. Also Jerusalem was a city in a constant state of turmoil, and has been conquered many times. It came under Islamic rule for centuries after the time of Christ. If the center of the Church had not moved away and instead been under Islamic rule, it probably would not have survived. Rome too was a place of persecution which lasted until the 4th century. Under Roman law the worship of any gods other than the Roman ones was considered atheism. St. Peter being the leader of the new Church was a wanted man as were all Christian leaders. Rome was also subject to attacks by invaders. In 410, 455, and 546 AD Rome was attacked by Germanic tribes, and again in 1527 by the Holy Roman Emperor Charles V., but it was nothing compared to the constant turmoil of Jerusalem. Catholics believe God knew exactly what he was doing when he moved the seat of the Church to Rome and away from the middle east during the first generation after Christ.

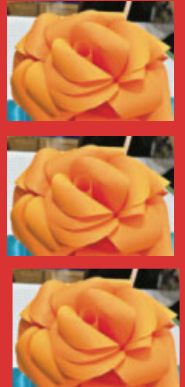

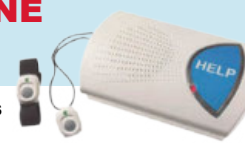
